THE MATCHUP: The 13th-ranked Golden Gusties get back into their MIAC schedule with an away/home series this weekend against the top scoring team in the MIAC, the Augsburg Auggies. Gustavus enters the weekend looking to get back on track after a pair of disappointing losses to St. Olaf and UW-Stout, while Augsburg comes in a winner in six of its last seven games.

The Gusties are currently tied with Hamline for second place in the MIAC standings with seven points. Augsburg ranks sixth in the MIAC with four points.

Gustavus and Augsburg met earlier this season at the MIAC Showcase in the opening game of the 2010-11 campaign on Oct. 29, 2010 in Blaine, Minn. Gustavus came away with a 2-1 victory in a penalty ridden contest despite being outshot 34-24 in the game.

ABOUT AUGSBURG: Just like Gustavus, Augsburg was in non-conference action last weekend against UW-Stout and St. Olaf. The Auggies fell 4-2 to the Blue Devils on Friday night in Menomonie, yet bounced back with a 3-2 overtime win against St. Olaf on Saturday night in Northfield. Following a two goal first period by the Oles, Augsburg responded with a pair of goals late in the third, tying the game at 2-2 and sending it into OT. Augsburg's Mario Mjellell netted the game-winner 1:40 into the extra period to give the Auggies the win.

Augsburg enters the weekend with an 8-4-1 overall record and a 2-2-0 MIAC record. The Auggies were swept by St. Thomas in their opening conference series of the season, but bounced back by taking two from Saint John's Dec. 3-4.

Augsburg's Joel Sauer is currently the top scorer in the MIAC with 21 points (8G, 13A). Sauer has scored a point in every game but two this season, and has notched a goal in four of Augsburg's last five games. Just two points behind Sauer sits Nick Guran with 19 points (11G, 8A). Guran's 11 goals rank him second in the conference behind Bethel's Jack Paul (13).

Justin Lochner, at 4-4-1 this season, has done the majority of the goaltending, yet backup Jon Zitir has been a proven backup with a 4-0-0 record thus far. Lochner has a goals against average of 2.13 and a save percentage of .922, while Zitir has a 1.62 GAA and a .941 save percentage.

Augsburg enters the weekend as the top squad in the MIAC on special teams. The Auggies are 15-for-59 (25.9%) on the power play and have killed 48-of-53 (90.6%) penalties. In 13 contests this season, Augsburg is scoring 3.38 goals per game, while allowing just 2.15 GPG.

AUGSBURG COACHING STAFF: The Auggies are coached by Chris Brown (UW-River Falls '94) who is currently in his fifth season at the helm of the Augsburg Hockey Program. In his collegiate coaching career, Brown has earned conference coach of the year honors three times, including being named Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year at Augsburg in 2006-07. He has also been a finalist for the American Hockey Coaches Association's Division III National Coach of the Year award three times. He has a 96-99-15 career coaching record.

Brown is assisted by Bruce Johnson (Augsburg '68), Mike LaValle (Lakewood CC), Peter Samargia (Augsburg '03), and Chris Johnson.

GUSTAVUS' LAST ACTION: Gustavus will look to get back on track after a disappointing weekend to start the new year. Slow starts were the theme of the weekend as the Gusties got behind 4-0 against St. Olaf and 5-0 against UW-Stout.

On Friday night in Don Roberts Ice Rink, Gustavus allowed four unanswered St. Olaf goals in the first two periods. The Gusties cut the lead to 4-3 on a Illya Kravtchouk goal with :34 seconds left, but it was too little too late as the Gusties couldn't get a look at the equalizer in the remaining seconds.

There would be no comeback Saturday night as the Blue Devils jumped all over Gustavus and never looked back, scoring five even-strength goals in the first 34 minutes. Dane Erickson scored the lone Gustavus goal with less than a minute to play in the second period. The Gusties were outshot 38-30 in the game. It was the first time they were outshot since Nov. 20, 2010 against Bethel.

AROUND THE GLOBE: The 2010-11 Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team features 16 players who previously played junior hockey on 13 different teams. Coach Brett Petersen's squad features players from five states and three countries outside the U.S. in Sweden, Norway, and Canada.

FAMILY MATTERS: Gustavus' 2010-11 roster features players who have had family members previously play a sport for the Gusties: Alec Ackmann, Dane Erickson, Zach May, Andrew Peterson, and Mitch Carlson.

Alec Ackmann's brother Jared Ackmann '10 played hockey from 2006-10, Dane Erickson's father John Erickson played hockey for Coach Don Roberts from 1978-81, Zach May's grandfather Bob Swiggum played football and baseball from 1957-60, Andrew Peterson's father Donald Scott Peterson played hockey in 1966, and Mitch Carlson's aunt Cindy Carlson played softball for the Gusties from 1977-1980.

RANK AND FILE: After last weekend's losses, the Gustavus men's hockey team fell eight spots to 13th in the most recent USCHO.com DIII Men's Poll.

JOSH. 0: Gustavus senior Goaltender Josh Swartout has been a staple between the pipes for four years. Swartout has a career record of 40-19-4 and is one of only five goalies in Gustavus history to join the 40 win club. He currently holds a win percentage of .634. Adam Micheletti '72 is the top Gustavus goaltender in history with a career record of 53-14-0 (.790) and save percentage of .916.

Swartout enters the weekend with an unblemished 6-0-0 record against Augsburg. He has a 2.16 GAA and a .956 save percentage against the Auggies.

TOP GUN: Gustavus rookie Gustav "Goose" Bengtson is currently tied with fellow freshman Adam Smyth for the MIAC lead in freshman scoring with 12 points. Bengtson's point streak ended at six games last weekend, yet the Gusties are still 5-0-1 when Goose scores a goal.

STAYING OUT OF THE BOX: The Gusties have been the most disciplined team in the MIAC in terms of penalties so far. Gustavus has registered a league-low 159 penalty minutes for an average of 10.6 per game.

TEST TIME: The Gustavus men's hockey team will surely be tested this weekend, as they face the one of the top special teams squads in the country. The Auggies rank 11th on the power play (25.9) and third in the penalty kill (90.6).

ROUGH WEEKEND: The Gustavus men's hockey team suffered two losses in one weekend for the first time since 2009. Back on Jan. 9, 2009 Gustavus fell 5-4 in overtime to UW-Superior, and on Jan. 10, the Gusties fell 5-0 to St. Scholastica.

FAST START: In six conference games, the Gusties lead the MIAC with 20 goals for an average of 3.33 per game. Gustavus has made it a point to come out strong against MIAC foes thus far, outscoring their opponents 9-3 in the first period.

TRACKING RINGO: Gustavus junior forward Ross Ring-Jarvi is currently nearing his 90th career point at Gustavus. Ring Jarvi has played in 69 straight games, scoring 30 goals and recording 52 assists for a total of 82 points. The last player to score 90 career points was David Martinson '10.

CENTURY MARK: Gustavus seniors Brad Wieck and Mitch Carlson are just four and five games, respectively, away from their 100th game played at Gustavus. In their careers, Wieck has 57 points (24G, 33A) and Carlson has 45 (16G, 29A).

THIS WEEK IN THE MIAC: The weekend of Jan.14-15 shapes up to be a big one across the league with eight of the nine teams getting back into MIAC play.
