ABOUT GUSTAVUS ADOLPHUS COLLEGE



For 150 years, Gustavus Adolphus College has been educating tomorrow's leaders to reason and act responsibly through its educational quality, accessible facilities, spiritual identity, and economic value.

Quality is a word that finds its way into many colleges' vocabularies. At Gustavus, quality is evident in its students, faculty, facilities, and programs, leading to recognition by a host of impartial critics. Forbes.com ranked Gustavus among the top 100 institutions in the country in its 2010 college report based upon several factors, including the average amount of student debt and the four-year graduation rate. The College is also included in other national guides and rankings, for example the Fiske Guide, *U.S. News & World Report's* Best College Guide, and the Princeton Review, which in addition has ranked the Gustavus Dining Service among the best in the nation in each of the past two years.

Gustavus students typically rank in the top third of their high school graduating class, and over 32 percent rank in the upper 10

percent of their class. Continuing their achievement at Gustavus, students find a challenging academic atmosphere where professors—97 percent of tenured faculty members have earned the highest degree in their field—teach all classes (there are no graduate assistants) and serve as academic advisers. Collaborative learning is the norm, with exceptionally motivated students invited to conduct research independently or with a professor.

Top quality facilities complement educational quality. *The National Review College Guide* declares the two Gustavus science facilities to be "the envy of other small schools in its class," while Schaefer Fine Arts Center houses the Anderson Theatre, acoustically perfect Björling Recital Hall, Kresge Dance Studio, a MIDI computerized composition lab, and plenty of practice rooms. The Bernadotte Library provides ample study space and access to literally millions of volumes through its holdings, the MnPALS system, and LEXIS-NEXIS. Computer facilities are vital no matter what a student's major, and Gustavus provides direct network access from more than 400 public-access terminals, with all individual student residential rooms hardwired for full Ethernet connectivity.

Founded by Swedish Lutheran immigrants, Gustavus has maintained its sense of spiritual identity through a daily service held in Christ Chapel (which many students choose to attend) and a one-course religion component built into the liberal arts core academic requirements. A Gustavus education challenges students to examine, develop, and strengthen their own spiritual and moral values, which for many students translates directly into service to others.

A number of factors combine to make Gustavus an outstanding economic value. Most importantly, Gustavus students graduate on time, with a four-year graduation rate of more than four times the national average. Moreover, Gustavus offers comprehensive financial assistance programs, including merit-based and need-based grants and scholarships.

KING GUSTAV II ADOLF: THE NAMESAKE OF GUSTAVUS ADOLPHUS COLLEGE

Founded in 1862 by Swedish immigrants, Gustavus Adolphus College bears the name of the famous Swedish king Gustav II Adolf (1594–1632). Known as the "Warrior King," Gustav ascended the throne at the tender age of seventeen and reigned from 1611 to 1632. In that short time span, he became more popular and powerful than any Swedish monarch before him. King Gustav was known as a friend of the people and a strong proponent of education. He died in battle at Lutzen, Germany, as he led his troops in the Thirty Years War, fighting for his faith and securing the future of Protestantism.

2011 HEAD COACH

HEAD COACH PETER HAUGEN



Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis, Minn. and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, begins his third season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus College football program. In his first two seasons, Haugen has led the Gusties to a record of 8-12 overall and 6-10 in the MIAC.

Prior to Gustavus, Haugen has been the head football coach, teacher, and assistant principal at Minneapolis Washburn High School for the past 18 years.

During his 15 years as the head coach at Washburn High School, Haugen compiled an overall record of 111-44, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In 2008, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players to 110 players. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football

Conference this past year and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at Bethel College, his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned All-Conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Peter, and his wife, Brenda live in St. Peter with their three children, Zeke (13), Zoe (10), and Zetta (5).

Corey Shea steps into a new role as the defensive coordinator and linebackers coach for the upcoming season. Shea, who enters his fifth season with the Gustavus football coaching staff, served as the defensive line coach

and recruiting coordinator prior to taking over defensive coordinator responsibilities.

Originally from Bismarck, N.D., Shea has six years of coaching experience in NCAA Division II as well as two years of experience as a student coach at William Penn University. He completed a bachelor's degree in physical education at William Penn in 2001 and received his master's degree in athletic administration from South Dakota State University in 2003. Corey also serves as the team's travel coordinator.

From 2001-02, Shea was also running backs coach at South Dakota State before moving on to Minnesota State University-Mankato where he served as wide receivers coach in 2003 and running backs coach in 2004. During his time at these two schools, Shea coached two candidates for NCAA Division II Player of the Year, Josh Ranek (SDSU) and Sean Treasure (MSU-Mankato). From 2005-06, Shea was quarterbacks coach at Wayne State College in Wayne, Nebraska.

Ryan Galindo enters his third season with the Gustavus Adolphus football program. Galindo will serve as the co-offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach this season. In addition to his on the field

responsibilities, Galindo will begin his first year as the team's recruiting coordinator.

Before becoming a member of the Gustavus staff, he served as the offensive coordinator at Washburn High School in Minneapolis. Galindo, a Minneapolis native, graduated from the University of St. Thomas in 2003 with a major in K-12 physical education teaching. While at St. Thomas, he was

a four-year letterwinner as a wide receiver on the football team. During his tenure at Washburn, where he coached wide receivers for two years and was the offensive coordinator for three years, Galindo helped build a high-powered offense on teams that posted undefeated records in Minneapolis City Conference play each year he was on the staff. He taught special education in the Minneapolis Public Schools for five years. In 2007, he obtained a special education teaching licensure and took advanced course work in emotional and behavioral disorders at the University of St. Thomas. Ryan lives in Minneapolis.

served as a graduate assistant at St. Cloud State University for two years. A 2005 graduate of St. Cloud State with a major in Mass Communications, Cosgrove was a standout defensive end for the Huskie football squad, earning All-Conference honors three times and being named to the National Football Coaches Association All-America Team in 2005. He was also named the North Central Conference Defensive Lineman of the Year his senior season.

In addition to being the co-offensive coordinator and offensive line coach for the Gusties, Cosgrove also serves as the video coordinator. Charlie lives in St. Peter and is currently finishing his Master's in Sports Management.

Jeremy Sather enters his first season as the defensive backs coach for the Gustavus football team. Sather, a native of Willmar, Minn. and a 2001 graduate of Willmar High School, attended Bethel University and earned

a Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education in 2005. While at Bethel, Sather was a four-year letterwinner and a three-year starter as a standout cornerback on the Royal football team. He recorded 15 interceptions and 145.5 tackles in 36 games over his career, earning All-Conference honors in 2004.

Following his collegiate playing career, Jeremy coached at Mandarin High School in Jacksonville, Fla. in 2005 before returning to Minnesota to take a job as a physical education teacher/football coach at Cedar Mountain-Comfrey High School in 2006. Sather served as the defensive coordinator for the Cougars in 2006 before taking over as head coach from 2007 to 2010. In 2008, he began attending graduate school at Southwest Minnesota Sate University, earning a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership in 2010. In addition to coaching the defensive backs, Sather will serve as the strength and conditioning coordinator for the team. Jeremy lives in Redwood Falls, Minn. with his wife Christine. DENNIS BALDUS, Defensive Line
Dennis Baldus begins his fifth season
with the Gustie football staff this year as
the defensive line coach. Baldus, a 1971
Gustavus graduate with majors in health
and physical education, was a lineman
for the Golden Gustie football squad
from 1967-1970. After graduating, Baldus
went on to receive his master's degree
in physical education from St. Cloud

State University and then spent the next 16 years teaching and coaching at Hawley High School and Watertown High School.

As head coach at Watertown, he garnered the Wright County Conference Football Coach of the Year award six times. In 1987 Baldus became athletic director and head football coach at Albert Lea High School before being hired in 1991 as a principal in the Chaska Independent School District. Coach Baldus was an administrator in the Chaska ISD up until his retirement in the spring of 2010. He lives in Victoria, Minn. with his wife, Wanda.

Alex Hass returns to the Gustavus football staff for his second season as tight ends coach. A 2000 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Alex received a bachelor's degree in psychology. He was a three-year starter at tight end on the Gopher football team, earning honorable mention All-Conference honors his senior year. Hass also played professional football with the St. Louis Rams. The St. Peter, Minn. native

is currently the Senior Marketing and Product Development Specialist at AgStar Financial Services. Alex lives in St. Peter with his wife Jill, and their daughter Olivia, and son Tayton.



MARC BACHMAN, Defensive Line
Marc Bachman will begin his second
season with the Gustie football program
after coaching at St. Peter High School
for the past 18 years. A 1988 graduate
of Gustavus with majors in history and

Bachman will coach the defensive line
this season. A Fairmont, Minn. native,
Bachman was a two-year letterwinner

as a running back for the Gusties and a member of the 1987 MIAC Championship team. He is currently the operations and maintenance supervisor for the St. Peter High School District. Marc lives in St. Peter with his wife Wendy ('87) and their four children, Beau ('14), Alina, Chloe, and Avery.



BRIAN WILLE, Wide Receivers
Brian Wille returns to the Gustavus
football program as the wide receivers
coach this season. Brian, a 2011
graduate of Gustavus with a bachelor's
degree in Secondary Education Social
Studies Teaching, hung up the pads
after his sophomore year to become a
student assistant for the Gusties from
2008 to 2010. As a student assistant,

Wille coached on the offensive side of the ball and was the offensive coordinator for the Gustavus football junior varsity during the 2009 and 2010 seasons. The Truman, Minn. native and graduate of Truman High School will student-teach this fall at St. Peter High School, earning his teaching license in Social Studies Secondary Education in November. Brian currently lives in Mankato, Minn.



MIKE MAY, Offensive Line
Mike May enters his first season as an
assistant coach for the Gusties and will
assist coach Cosgrove with the offensive
line. May, a 2006 graduate of Le SueurHenderson High School, played football
at Gustavus from 2006 to 2009, earning
two letters and playing in 25 games over
his career wearing the black and gold.
The Le Sueur, Minn. native earned a

Bachelor's degree in Physical Education and Health Education from Gustavus in 2010. He is an assistant coach for the Le Sueur-Henderson wrestling team, and was an assistant coach for the Giants football team in 2010. Mike lives in St. Peter and is currently attending Minnesota State University, Mankato where he is working towards his teaching license in Physical Education and Health Education.

2011 SEASON PREVIEW



After back-to-back 4-6 seasons, the Gustavus football team looks for a turnaround year in 2011. With a total of 33 letterwinners returning, 17 on offense and 16 on defense, Head Coach Peter Haugen has confidence in his squad's mix of upperclassmen leadership and young talent. The Gusties finished sixth in the MIAC last season with a record of 3-5.

Senior defensive back Brad Kruckeberg (Ellendale, Minn.) and junior offensive lineman Lyle Opdahl (Young America, Minn.) are Gustavus' returning All-Conference performers from a year ago, as both players took home All-MIAC Second Team honors. Opdahl will miss the early months of the season after suffering a lower body injury earlier this spring.

The Gustavus defense brings back six starters from last year's team. The biggest question mark for the defense will be the linebacker position due to the vacancy left by the graduation of staples Dustin Kammerer, Paul Stommes, Jade Kotila, and Zach Lundquist. The Gustie defense makes the transition to a four-man front in the 2011 season, as Junior Alec Saunders (Willmar, Minn.) will be the signal caller in his first full-time season at middle linebacker. Joining Saunders at outside backer will be junior Zach Stackhouse (Houston, Minn.) and sophomore Joe Haas (Mission, Kan.). Both Stackhouse and Haas saw limited playing time last season, as they will be backed up by senior Nick Alverson (Cottage Grove, Minn.) and freshman Anthony Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.)

Where the linebacking corp lacks experience, the defense line consists of a group of battle-tested veterans. The depth at defensive tackle consists of top returning seniors Tom Einberger (West St. Paul, Minn.) and Colby Peterson (Paynesville, Minn.), junior Cory Colvard (Centerville, Minn.), and sophomore Donte Green (Minneapolis, Minn.). At defensive end are seniors Todd Kremmin (Cottage Grove, Minn.), Dane Mellgren (Cologne, Minn.), and Matt Miller (Cleveland, Minn.). The defense allowed 149.2 yards per game on the ground last year, ranking sixth in the MIAC.

The secondary, which ranked third in the MIAC in pass defense last season after allowing 170.6 yards per game, also features a solid group of returners.

2011 SEASON PREVIEW

Brad Kruckeberg, who finished first in the MIAC in both interceptions (6) and passes defended (12) last season, will reprise his role at free safety for his senior year. Kruckeberg will be complimented at strong safety by sophomore Beau Bachmann (St. Peter, Minn.) and senior Mitch Kleinschrodt (Alden, Minn.). At the corners are returning senior starters Dan Opitz (Burnsville, Minn.) and Jason Cook (Lakefield, Minn.). Optiz had 30 tackles and one interception last season, while Cook had 29 tackles and three picks.

Gustavus ranked fourth in the league in total defense last season, allowing 319.8 yards per game, while giving up an average of 20.0 points per game.

A total of ten familiar faces return to the starting offensive lineup, including a complete core of skill players. Gustavus ranked eighth in the league in total offense (311.7 ypg), running for an average of 153.8 yards per game and throwing for an average of 157.9 yards per game.

Senior Logan Becker (Easton, Minn.) returns as the full-time signal caller for the second straight season. Becker proved to be both a threat through the air and on the ground last season. He was 159-for-268 for 1529 yards with 12 touchdowns and 12 interceptions. Becker was also the team's second leading rusher with 586 yards on 144 carries for an average of 41.7 yards per game.

The trio of senior Elliot Herdina (Blooming Prairie, Minn.), and juniors Andre Creighton (St. Paul, Minn.) and Muresuk Mena (Inver Grove Heights, Minn.) at wide receiver boasts speed and quickness, allowing for a variety of options in the passing game. Mena led the Gusties in catches last season with 59, compiling 354 yards, averaging 35.4 yards per game and scoring three touchdowns. Creighton made 17 catches for 233 yards (23.3 ypg) and two touchdowns. Herdina will look to get back on track after missing seven games due to injury last season. He led the team in receiving as a sophomore with 46 catches for 555 yards and seven touchdowns.

Sophomore Jeffrey Dubose (St. Paul, Minn.) returns as the number one running back after having a breakout year in his rookie season. Dubose ran 147 times for 721 yards last season, averaging 4.9 yards per carry and 72.1 yards per game. Sophomore transfer from MSU-Mankato Philip Butler (St. Paul, Minn.) will also see action as the second running

back after turning heads with a solid training camp.

The offensive line features the return of four of its five starters from a year ago. Senior Robbie Porter (Lakeville, Minn.) returns at center with senior Ryan Steele (Maple Grove, Minn.) and junior Brian Grundmeyer (Inver Grove Heights, Minn.) making up the guard combo. Sophomore Lance Erickson (Pelican Rapids, Minn.), who worked into a starting role late last season, will return at right tackle, while left tackle will be filled by the combination of sophomores Pat Tracy (St. Louis Park, Minn.) and Alex Brodjeski (Savage, Minn.)

Seniors Darin Wagner (Hayfield, Minn.) and Cody Williams (Welcome, Minn.) round out the offense at tight end. Wagner brought in 12 catches for 132 yards and one touchdown last season, while Williams had two catches for 10 yards.

Junior Tom Heupenbecker (Verona, Wis.) will anchor the kicking game as both the place kicker and punter. Huepenbecker was 3-for-7 on field goal attempts and 20-for-25 on extra point tries last season. The Gusties ranked seventh in the MIAC in punting last year with a net average of 28.9 yards per punt. The team ranked second in the league in punt return average at 11.9 yards per return, as Brad Kruckeberg had 10 returns for 98 yards (9.8 avg/ret.).

The Gustavus football team will open the 2011 season on the road against Wartburg College on Saturday, Sept. 10 at 7:00 p.m. in Waverly, Iowa. Wartburg defeated the Gusties 27-6 on Hollingsworth Field in last season's opener, going on to a 10-1 overall record and making the NCAA Playoffs after winning the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) with an 8-0 mark.




