**THE MATCH-UP...** The Gustavus men's hockey team is ready to face the University of St. Thomas in a away/home series this weekend.

The Gusties enter the weekend at an even 2-2-2 overall and 1-1-0 in the MIAC after splitting with Bethel last weekend. St. Thomas is off to a fast start in the 2011-12 season, coming into the weekend at 3-1-1 overall and 2-0-0 in the MIAC after earning a sweep over Saint John's in its conference-opening series last weekend.

Even though the 2011-12 season is barely underway, important points are on the line once again this weekend with rivals Gustavus and St. Thomas squaring off. The shield of Gustavus meets the shield of St. Thomas as the Gusties try to pick off the MIAC's current leader this weekend.

**MEET THE GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF...** Head Coach Brett Petersen is in his 12th season as the head coach of the Gustavus men's hockey team. Petersen entered the season with a 148-126-20 record in his 11 seasons at Gustavus. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Petersen is assisted by Jared Phillips and Aaron Hoiland. Jared Phillips, a 2003 graduate of Gustavus, is in his third season as the full-time assistant coach with the men's hockey program. Phillips, a Bemidji, Minnesota native was a two-year letterwinner for the Gustie hockey team as a goaltender from 2001 to 2003. He completed his master's degree in applied kinesiology with an emphasis in sports management at the University of Minnesota in the summer of 2009. Jared also serves as the Athletic Department's Compliance Coordinator.

Aaron Hoiland joins the Gustavus men's hockey program for his sixth season as a volunteer assistant coach. Originally from Anoka, Hoiland is a 1992 graduate of Forest Lake High School. After graduating from St. Thomas, Hoiland earned his Master of Arts degree in English from Stephen F. Austin State University in 2003.

**MEET THE ST. THOMAS COACHING STAFF...** Jeff Boeser has been a staple within the St. Thomas hockey program for more than three decades. Boeser, who is in his second season at the head of the Tommie hockey team, took over for 23-year head coach Terry Skrypek in 2010. In his first season as head coach, Boeser led the Tommies to a 14-10-2 record finishing second in the conference with a 9-5-2 record against conference foes. Boeser is a 1975 graduate of St. Thomas.

Assisting Boeser is Eric Wenkus (St. Thomas '03), Jacques Vezino (UW-River Falls '03), Tony Lawrence (St. Thomas '02), Parker Burgess (St. Thomas '10).

**ABOUT ST. THOMAS...** The first place Tommies enter this weekend's series scoring an average of 3.00 (3rd/MIAC) goals per game and allowing an average of 2.40 (3rd/MIAC) goals per game.

St. Thomas is currently the top-ranked special teams squad in the league at 56.1-percent (23-41). The Tommies have struggled on the power play yet have been outstanding on the penalty kill. They are 16.7-percent (3-18) with a man

advantage and have killed 20-of-23 (87%) penalties.

Doing the majority of the goal scoring for the purple so far this season has been junior Travis Baker and senior Rob Phillipp. The pair has accounted for seven of St. Thomas' 15 goals. Baker has four goals and two assists to lead the team with six points, while Phillipp has three goals and two assists for five points. Two of Phillip's goals have come on the power play.

Doing the majority of the goaltending thus far has been junior Tyrone Simcoe. Simcoe picked up a pair of wins in the sweep over Saint John's last weekend, improving to 2-1-1 on the year. He allowed seven goals and made 57 saves in the series against the Johnnies. The senior netminder enters the weekend with a goals against average of 2.46 and a save percentage of .921 in 244:05 minutes.

**AROUND THE GLOBE...**The 2011-12 Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team features 22 players who previously played junior hockey on 14 different teams. Coach Brett Petersen's squad features players from six states; Minnesota (19), California (2), Texas (1), New Hampshire (1), Nevada (1), Oklahoma (1), and three countries outside the U.S. in Canada, Norway, and Sweden.

**LAST WEEKEND...**Staying true to the recent series history between Gustavus and Bethel, the two teams split last weekend and each picked up two points.

On Friday night in St. Peter, Bethel grabbed a 1-0 lead after Bethel scored at the 9:45 mark of the first period. The Gusties responded with a four unanswered goals to earn the 4-1 victory.

Jack Walsh scored at 11:49 of the first period to tie the game at 1-1. Sam Smith put the Gusties up 2-1 in the second period (7:31) with a goal, and Ryan Johnson and Andy Pearson added third period goals at the 1:16 and 7:11 marks, respectively to bring the game to a final at 4-1.

After a scoreless first period on Saturday night in Blaine, Bethel used three-straight goals in the second and third periods to take a 3-0 lead by the 9:31 mark of the final frame. Ross Ring-Jarvi cut the lead to 3-1 at 11:02 and Adam Smyth made it a one goal game with seven minutes to play.

The Gusties were unable to get the equalizer in the remaining minutes and Bethel picked up two points with a 3-2 win.

**THE SERIES...**It doesn't get much tighter than the all-time series between Gustavus and St. Thomas in men's hockey. The Tommies hold the advantage in the history of the match-up with a record of 59-58-8.

The two squads split last season with Gustavus winning 5-3 on Friday night in St. Peter, and St. Thomas earning a 2-1 overtime victory on Saturday night in Mendota Heights.

**FIRST GOAL...**After scoring the first goal of the game in their first four contests of the season, Gustavus failed to get on the scoreboard first in either game against Bethel last weekend. Gustavus is 1-1-2 when it scores first this season.

**FAB FROSH...**Gustavus rookies Jack Walsh, Sam Smith, and Andy Pearson made a good first impression on the student-body by each scoring a goal in the home-opener against Bethel on Friday night. The goals by Walsh and Smith were the first of their collegiate careers as the trio combined for six points over the weekend. Walsh led the group with three points (1G, 2A) in the series.

**VENNE SEEING THE PUCK...**Gustavus goaltender Tyler Venne enters the weekend ranked second in the MIAC in goals against average at 1.89 and third in save percentage at .929.

At 1-0-2, Venne is the seventh-ranked netminder in NCAA Division III according to USCHO.com. His .929 save percentage is currently the ninth-best in the nation.

**TOUGH D...**The Gusties are currently giving up a league-best 2.17 goals per game. Gustavus' team goals against average ranks eighth in the nation.

**JOHNSON ON THE DOTS...**Junior forward Ryan Johnson went 24-12 (66.7%) on faceoffs last weekend against Bethel, continuing his early-season success on the dots. Johnson is 44-19 for a win-percentage of .698 so far this season. As a team, Gustavus is winning faceoffs at a 53.7-percent rate this season.
