AND HERE WE GO... The Gustavus men's hockey team will begin its 2012-13 campaign at the MIAC Showcase held October 26-28 at Fogerty Arena in Blaine, Minn. 
GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 71ST SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY...

The Gustavus men's hockey team is set to drop the puck in its 71st season this weekend at the MIAC Showcase. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 816-603-61 overall and 542-316-39 in the MIAC. Gustavus first recognized a team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in hockey and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the fieldhouse, that Gustavus would record its first victory.

HEAD COACH BRETT PETERSEN... Head Coach Brett Petersen is entering his 13th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 165-133-25 record in his 12 seasons at Gustavus. His 165 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10. Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

LAST SEASON AT A GLANCE... The 2011-12 Gustavus men's hockey team finished 17-7-5 overall and 8-5-3 in the MIAC. After finishing second in the conference standings, Gustavus made a run through the MIAC Playoffs that was capped off with a 4-2 victory over St. Olaf in front of a capacity crowd in Don Roberts Ice Rink for

the MIAC Playoff Championships. With the win over the Oles, the Gusties earned their sixth ever berth into the NCAA Tournament. In the NCAA Playoffs, Gustavus defeated Milwaukee School of Engineering 3-1 in the opening round before falling to eventual NCAA Champion St. Norbert 4-1 in the quarterfinals.

SEASON OPENERS... Under the direction of Brett Petersen, the Gustavus men's hockey team has compiled a 5-6-1 record in season-openers. The Gustavus men's hockey team is 10-8-3 in it's previous 21 season openers. The Gusties went 5-5 in the 2000's and 5-3-2 in the 1990's. Friday night's game against Hamline will be the first ever meeting between the two programs in the season-opening tilt.

AROUND THE GLOBE... Gustavus' 2012-13 roster features 28 players from five different states and four different countries other than the United States of America. Within the U.S., Minnesota (18), California (2), Nevada (1), Massachusetts (1), and Colorado (1) are represented by 23 players. Outside the U.S., two Canadian provinces, British of Columbia (2) and Ontario (1), are represented by three players, while Scandinavian countries Norway and Sweden each have one rep. This year's club also features 23 players with junior hockey experience prior to coming to Gustavus.

REPLACING RINGO... Although the Gustavus men's hockey team lost just one player due to graduation last year, that player happened to be a difference maker that made his presence felt on every shift for 115 consecutive games over his four-year career. Replacing AHCA First Team All-American and MIAC Player of the Year Ross Ring-Jarvi is certainly a focus of this year's team. A four-time All-MIAC performer, Ringo led the team in scoring last season with 33 points (11G, 22A). He ended his career with 130 points (46G, 84A), finishing 16th on Gustavus' all-time scorers list.

LETTERWINNERS & NEWCOMERS... The Gustavus men's hockey team will have no excuses when it comes to experience this season, as coach Petersen returns 23 letterwinners from last year's team to the ice. Gustavus also welcomes five new players into the program, including freshman Darren Lapic (New Prague, Minn.), sophomores Tyler Lapic (New Prague, Minn.), Keith Tessin (Longmont, Colo.), and Patrick Sullivan (So., Kelowna, B.C.), and senior Brenden Baker (Edina, Minn.).

CALLING ALL CAPTAINS... In the 70 year history of Gustavus men's hockey, only 83 players have earned the right to wear a "C" on their chest for the Black and Gold. Seniors Dane Erickson (Woodbury, Minn.) and Tim LaBombard (Bloomington, Minn.) have been named captains of this year's team, becoming the 84th and 85th in the history of the program. Fellow seniors Andrew Peterson (Reno, Nev.) and Ryan Johnson (Blaine, Minn.) have also been selected as assistant captains. Together the group has played in a total of 249 collegiate games over their careers.

RETURNING FIRE POWER... Take away Ross Ring Jarvi's 33 points last season and Gustavus returns 85-percent of its scoring to the ice for 2012-13. Gustavus scored an average of 3.03 goals per game last season, ranking second in the MIAC. Gustavus brings back two of its top three scorers from last season in Zach May (Jr., Prior Lake, Minn.) and Ryan Johnson (Sr., Blaine, Minn.). May finished second on the team in scoring with 23 points off of ten goals and 13 assists.

Johnson came on strong at the end the season, posting seven points (4G, 3A) over the last seven games to finish with 20 points (10G, 10A).

SNIPER ALERT... The Gusties also return their leading goal scorer from a year ago in junior Adam Smyth (Burnsville, Minn.). Smyth led the team with 14 goals, putting him in a tie for first in the MIAC. He scored three power play goals, two game-winners, and two short-handed goals. Smyth also scored four goals against Lawrence University in a 5-3 win on Dec. 10. He finished the year with a team-high 100 shots (3.70 spg) and a .140 shooting percentage.

ALL-ROOKIE RETURNERS... Gustavus sophomores Andy Pearson (Burnsville, Minn.) and John McLean (Eagan, Minn.) will look to build on their outstanding freshmen campaigns that saw them both earn a spot on the 2011-12 MIAC All-Rookie Team. Pearson appeared in 28-of-29 games, scoring 19 points (5G, 14A) to end up fourth on the team in scoring. His totals ranked him third in the league in rookie scoring. McLean turned in one of the most successful rookie seasons by a Gustavus freshman goaltender in recent history. He finished 15-5-2 overall with a .923 save percentage (14th/NCAA) and a 2.16 goals against average (15th/NCAA). Only one other freshman goaltender in the country had more saves than McLean last season.

TOUGH ON D... Returning to defense that allowed just 2.31 goals per game last season, ranking eighth in NCAA Division III, are Andrew Peterson, Tim LaBombard, Ilya Kravtchouk (Jr., Pacific Palisades, Calif.), Alex Gallen (Jr., Hingham, Mass.), Sam Smith (So., Vancouver, B.C.), and Nate Paulsen (So., La Habra, Calif.). LaBombard was the team's top scoring defenseman last season with 12 points (2G, 10A), while Kravtchouk and Peterson led the team in plus/minus with ratings of +13 and +11, respectively. Edina native Brenden Baker will also make a significant impact on the blue line after spending the past three seasons at Division I Holy Cross where he played in 70 games and scored a total of 18 points (4G, 14A)

Brett Petersen is entering his 13th season as the head coach of the Gustavus men's hockey team. Last season, coach Petersen directed the Gusties to an overall record of 17-7-5 and a second place finish in the MIAC with a record of 8-5-3. After qualifying for the MIAC Playoffs for the 11th consecutive season, the Gusties defeated Saint John's 3-1 in the semifinals before taking down St. Olaf 4-2 in front of a sellout Don Roberts Ice Rink in the MIAC Playoff Championship. By virtue of an MIAC Playoff Championship, the Gusties earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in school history. The Black and Gold topped Milwaukee School of Engineering by the score of 3-1 at home in the opening round, yet fell 4-1 to eventual National Champion St. Nortbert College 4-1 in Green Bay, Wis. in the quarterfinals.



In his 12-year tenure behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 165-133-25 overall record. His 165 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 15 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, seven All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.
