Gustavus Embarks On 104th Season Of Men's Basketball... The 2012-13 season represents the 104th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1366-945, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 900-543. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in the league. The program has made 22 MIAC playoff appearances, including 12 consecutively, and also has participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times.

Live Action - All Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball games will be broadcast live on KNUJ Radio AM 860 and KRDS 95.5 with Tom Wheeler handling the play-by-play broadcast. Fans can also access live video of all home games through the Gustavus athletics website and the following link http://client.stretchinternet.com/client/gac. portal#.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff - Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 23rd season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 20 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 423 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history. His .695 winning percentage ranks sixth on the all-time list.

Assistant coach Josh Drinkall begins his sixth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, Drinkall has coached two MIAC All-Defensive players in his first five years. Prior to coming to Gustavus, Drinkall worked as an assistant coach for six seasons at Winona State University where he was a part of the 2006 NCAA Division II National Championship and a second place finish in 2007.

Jeff Fish begins his fourth season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Returners and Newcomers - Following the graduation of seven seniors and 65-percent of its offense from a team that finished 20-8 (16-4 MIAC) last season, Gustavus will look to a core group of seniors to lead the way. That core group of seniors includes three of the top five scorers

from last year's team in Ben Biewen (Sr., Edina, Minn.), Jim Hill (Sr., Edina, Minn.), and Blake Shay (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.). Reed Sallstrom (Sr., Winthrop, Minn.) will also add experience as a returning senior.

Outside of the four seniors, the Gusties return just 20 points and 192 minutes of play from last year's squad. Lone junior Jordan Dick (Jr., Wabasha, Minn.) will look to add production to the Gustie lineup, while Isaac Tapp (So., Stewartville, Minn.) will serve as the team's primary ball handler after playing in eight games last season. Sophomores Martin Feddersen (So., Winona, Minn.), Brian Jacobs (So., Lake Crystal, Minn.), and Jed Kreuser (So., Jordan, Minn.) are all expect to contribut in their second season. Newcomers Matt Humphries (So., Maple Grove, Minn.), Dane Schmid (So., Mahtomedi, Minn.), Sergio Najera (Fr., New Prague, Minn.), Connor Perry (Fr., Hibbing, Minn.), Chad Poppen (Fr., St. Peter, Minn.), and Brody Ziegler (Fr., Mankato, Minn.) will also look to make an impact in their first collegiate varsity season.


Last Week - After beginning the year 1-0 for the fourth consecutive season, the Gusties ran into a bump in the road last Tuesday when they lost to UW-Stout 59-55 in Menomonie, Wis. After trailing for most of the game, Gustavus was able to even the score at 51-51 with 3:20 to play, but it was all the Gustie men could muster, as the Blue Devils pulled away with an 8-4 run to finish the game and hold on to the four-point victory.

After trailing by four at the intermission, the Gusties came out firing in the early minutes of the second half. Back-toback three-pointers by Ben Biewen tied the game up at 28-28 with 16:46 left in the second before UW-Stout used a 17-6 run to push the lead to 11 with 7:28 to play. Gustavus countered with a 17-6 run of its own over the next 4:27 to tie the score at 51-51 on a jumper by Jim Hill with 3:20 left in regulation. From there, UW-Stout closed the game out with an 8-4 run to seal the victory.

Hill and Biewen led the way for the Gusties in the loss. Hill finished one rebound shy of his second double-double after notching 21 points and nine rebounds. He went 7-for-13 from the field as well as a perfect 7-for-7 at the free throw line. Biewen followed Hill with 18 points of his own on 6-for-7 shooting including 2-for-3 from downtown and a perfect 4-for-4 from the charity stripe.

About The Auggies - Augsburg enters Wednesday's battle with a 3-0 record on the season. Led by 6-foot, 8-inch transfer Dan Kornbaum, the Auggies are off to their fourth

consecutive 3-0 start. Kornbaum is averaging 20.3 points and 7.7 rebounds per game, good enough to rank him fourth and second, respectively, in the MIAC. Teammate Parker Hines averages 15.3 points and 5.0 assists per game, while Tyler Schmidt rounds out the trio of double-figure scorers with 13.0 points per game.

Head coach Aaron Griess is in his eighth season at the helm of the Augsburg men's basketball program. After spending five seasons at Chaminade University in Honolulu, Hawaii, Griess returned to the mainland in 2005 to take over for the Auggies. Griess has compiled a 94-89 record in his seven seasons, including a 68-72 mark in the MIAC, and has taken the Auggies to the MIAC playoffs three times.

Dynamic Duo - The senior tandem from Edina, Minn. of Ben Biewen and Jim Hill have found their groove on the court thus far in the young season. Biewen, who's previous career high for points scored in a game was 18, is averaging 18.5 points per game to go along with 5.5 rebounds per game and 4.5 assists per game. Hill, on the other hand, leads the team in points per game (19.5) and rebounds per game (6.5). Combined, the two are shooting a staggering .692 from the field, and .889 from the free throw line. The duo ranks sixth (Hill) and seventh (Biewen) in scoring average, and first (Biewen) and fourth (Hill) in field goal percentage in the MIAC.

Smarty Marty - In his first season seeing significant floor time, sophomore Martin Feddersen (Winona, Minn.) has already made his impact felt on the defensive end. With four steals in a season-opening win over Bethany Lutheran and three steals against UW-Stout last week, Feddersen has accumulated seven steals for an average of 3.5 per game, which leads the MIAC.

Gustavus In MIAC Openers - Over the past 25 years, the Gusties have amassed a record of 20-5 in their first MIAC game of the season. In that 25-year stretch, Gustavus has squared off against Augsburg five times, in which the Gustie men are 4-1.

On This Date - The last time Gustavus played on November 28th, the Gusties suffered a 68-57 loss at the hands of Minnesota State, Moorhead. The past five times the Gusties have played on November 28th, they are 2-3, with the last win coming in 2005 when they defeated Bethany Lutheran 110-64 on Gus Young Court.

Mark Hanson is entering his 23rd season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

Last season, Hanson led the Gusties to their first MIAC Championship since the 2004-05 season, sharing the 2011-12 title with St. Thomas. Gustavus went 20-8 overall and 16-4 in the MIAC. The Black and Gold went on to defeat Saint John's 64-52 at home in the semifinals of the MIAC Playoffs before falling 66-62 in overtime to St. Thomas in the MIAC Playoff Championship held in St. Paul. The Gusties earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the 2005 season, drawing Wheaton College in the first round. Gustavus' season ended in the first round with a 68-60 loss to the Thunder in





River Falls, Wis.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 422-185 overall record at Gustavus, including a 319-121

record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 19 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occassions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has

coached 27 players who have garnered 47 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, is married to Deb Johnson. Mark and Deb have two children, Hans and Annika, and live in St. Peter.
