

Game Notes

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL EMBARKS ON NEW SEASON... On what is the 40th anniversary of Title IX, women's basketball at Gustavus has been around since the turn of the 20th century. On February 14, 1903, it was women who played the first intercollegiate basketball game at Gustavus. On that date, Gustavus took on Mankato Normal at the local Opera House, falling by the score of 16-2. Since that time, the Gustavus women's basketball team has compiled a record of 602-413 overall and 430-234 in the MIAC. The Gusties have won two MIAC Championships, while Laurie Kelly is the 10th head coach in the history of the program.

LAST TIME OUT... The Gustavus women's basketball team suffered a 93-56 loss to Minnesota State University, Mankato in its last outing on Monday night at the Taylor Center. MSU's athleticism and three-point shooting prowess proved to be too much for a Gustavus team that at times looked fatigued due to playing its third game in four days. With a 38-28 halftime lead, the Mavericks went 8-for-11 from three-point range in the second half, cruising to their third win after a 65.4-percent shooting performance from beyond the arc.

As a team, Gustavus shot 50-percent (21-42) from the field, 22.2-percent (2-9) from three-point range, and 75-percent (12-16)

from the free throw line. Julia Dysthe led the Gusties in scoring with 14 points (5-11), while Britta Rinke scored 13 points (5-7) off the bench.

THE SERIES... Wednesday night's contest between Gustavus and Augsburg will be the 62nd meeting between the two schools in women's basketball. Gustavus holds the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 50-11. The Gusties are currently riding a ninegame winning-streak against the Auggies. Their last loss in the series came on Dec. 1, 2007 by way of a 57-54 defeat in Minneapolis.

MIAC OPENERS... The Gusties have enjoyed a great deal of success in MIAC openers over the past 20 seasons. In the opening game of the conference season since the 1992-93 campaign, Gustavus holds a record of 19-1. It has been more than a decade since the Gusties have dropped their conference-opener, falling to Bethel 51-44 on Dec. 7, 1996 at Gus Young Court. The Black and Gold last met Augsburg in the league-opener on Dec. 3, 2003, defeating the Auggies 67-57 at Si Melby Hall.

ABOUT THE AUGGIES... After its opening two games of the season, the Augsburg women's basketball team is currently the highest scoring team in the conference

with a 73.5 points per game average. The Auggies are shooting 41.9-percent from the field and are averaging the fewest turnovers in the league at 12 per game.

Anne Skriba and Abbey Luger lead the Auggies in scoring thus far. Skriba averages 17.5 points per game and is shooting 60-percent from the field, while Luger averages 13 points and is shooting 42.3-percent.

ROTHENBUEHLER CRASHES THE GLASS... Gustavus senior Abby Rothenbuehler is currently the league's leading rebounder after the first three games of the season. Rothenbuehler is averaging 9.7 rebounds per game and has been a basket away from a double-double twice. The local product from North Mankato was the MIAC's leading scorer last season with a 7.8 rebounds per game average after bringing down a total of 211 boards.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL... Laurie Kelly's squad will need to take care of the ball on Wednesday against one of the MIAC's top turnover forcing teams in Augsburg. Gustavus committed a season-high 30 turnovers on Monday night against MSU and is currently averaging 21.3 turnovers per game. Augsburg's defense is averaging 25 take-aways per game, ranking second in the MIAC.

Laurie Kelly is currently in her first season as the head coach of the Gustavus women's basketball team. Kelly, a 1993 graduate of the University of St. Thomas with a major in speech communications, replaces Mickey Haller, who resigned in March of 2012 after serving as the head coach for 12 years. Kelly comes to Gustavus from Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, where she has directed the Division I Lumberjacks for the past nine seasons.

A Rochester, Minnesota, native, Kelly made a quick ascent through the Division II and I coaching ranks after a record setting Division III playing career at the University of St. Thomas in the early `90s. In the past nine years at Northern Arizona, she has compiled the most wins in the program's history (117), while



also directing the team to its first-ever Big Sky Conference tournament title and NCAA tournament bid in the 2005-06 season. During Kelly's tenure, the Lumberjacks advanced to the Big Sky tournament six times with two appearances in the championship game (2006, 2007), and her teams have registered two of the three 20-win seasons in the program's history.

In addition to quality on the floor, her squads have also been strong in the classroom, with four players earning CoSIDA Academic All-District honors including one Academic All-American. The Lumberjacks were recognized in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Academic Honor Roll six times, with two Top Ten national rankings.

Prior to her position at Northern Arizona, Kelly coached at Binghamton University in New York and built the Bearcats into one of the top Division II programs in the country before helping the institution transition to a Division I program in 2001-02. In that first year of Division I competition, Kelly directed the team to a 19-9 record and a second-place finish in the America East Conference. During her five years at Binghamton, Kelly compiled a record of 94-22, including a mark of 75-13 in the program's final three years at the Division II level, and her squads won New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) titles in 1999 and 2000 and Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference (ECAC) titles in 2000 and 2001. She was named ECAC Coach of the Year in 2000 and New York State Coach of the Year in 2002. Kelly started her collegiate coaching career as the graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato from 1996 to 1998. While she was at Minnesota State, Mankato she earned a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in sports administration.

Before her success in the coaching ranks, Laurie Trow Kelly was a standout player at the University of St. Thomas from 1989 to 1993 and is recognized by many as one of the greatest players in NCAA Division III history. A gifted athlete, the 6-1 Kelly scored 2,607 points and pulled down 1,204 rebounds in four years, earning Kodak All-America honors three consecutive seasons. In her senior season (1992-93), Kelly was voted National Player of the Year by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association after averaging more than 26 points per game. She set 22 conference and 24 school records, was conference MVP three times and was also named Midwest Sports Channel NCAA Division III Women's Athlete of the Year. In January of 2006, Kelly was one of five players selected to the NCAA Division III 25th Anniversary Team.

Laurie Kelly is the ninth head coach in the 44-year history of the Gustavus women's basketball program. The Gusties have compiled an all-time record of 603-411 (.594), winning two Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championships and making five NCAA tournament appearances.

In addition to her coaching duties, Kelly will serve as the coordinator of the Gustavus Health Promotion program (GHP). The Gustavus Health Promotion program offers employees at Gustavus a variety of educational opportunities, assessment tools, and physical activity experiences so that they can achieve and maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Kelly lives in St. Peter with and her husband, Matt, and their two daughters, Morgan (9) and Madison (7).
