GAME NOTES

GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 16TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S HOCKEY ...

The Gustavus women's hockey team is currently in its 16th season. Founded in 1997, the Gusties have attained an all-time record of 327-87-23, which stands second winningest program in all of NCAA Division III women's hockey. The Gustie women have won 11 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) titles in the 14 years of women's hockey in the conference. Those 11 titles rank first in front of St. Thomas, Augsburg, and Saint Mary's, who all have two championships apiece.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF... Head Coach Mike Carroll has entered his 14th season at the helm of the women's hockey program. At Gustavus, Carroll has amassed an overall record of 292-68-22, and an MIAC mark of 206-21-4. Under Carroll's direction, the Gusties have won 10 regular season and playoff MIAC championships and have reached the NCAA Tournament 10 consecutive times. He has been named the MIAC Coach of the Year five seasons. A native of Edina, Minn., Carroll graduated from Mankato State with a degree in municipal recreation in 1982 after participating in hockey and baseball in his time as a Maverick. Prior to coming to Gustavus, Carroll was the Mankato West High School boy's hockey coach from 1991 to 1999.

A former Gustavus women's hockey standout and three-time All-American, Kirstin Peterson `11 is in her second season as an assistant coach for the Three Crowns. While earning All-Conference honors in all four seasons, Peterson racked up 75 career points (16G, 59A), which ranks third all-time among Gustavus defenders. Following her graduation with a degree in health fitness in 2011, Peterson also worked as the director of club sports at Gustavus Adolphus.

Now in his 12th season as an assistant coach for the Gustie women, Steve Carroll will look to bring along a trio of first-year goalies. Carroll brings over 25 years of experience working with goalies, and is regarded as one of the top goalie instructors in the midwest. A native of Edina, Minn., Steve has his own goalie school and each year coaches hundreds of boys and girls of all skill levels.

LETTERWINNERS & NEWCOMERS... After losing nine key letterwinners from a squad that went 24-4-2 last season on its way to an MIAC regular season and playoff title, the Gusties will look to 17 returning players who lettered last season. All five seniors on this year's squad have lettered each of their first three years, which brings valuable experience the the 2012-13 Gusties. They will be joined by newcomers Keri Pickel (Jr., Rochester, Minn.), Allison Eder-Zdechlik (Fy., Stillwater, Minn.), Lindsey Hibbard (Fy., Princeton, Minn.), Tara Hoverstad (Fy., Coon Rapids, Minn.), Colleen Jacoby (Fy., Muskegon, Mich.), Emily Reibert (Fy., Inver Grove Heights, Minn.), and Brianna Seebold (Fy., Detroit Lakes, Minn.).

AROUND THE NATION... The 2012-13 Gustavus women's hockey roster features 24 players that reside in four different states. With 21 players from Minnesota, just three players make their home in states across the boarder. The three Gusties who are not Minnesota natives include Meagan Wanecke from Delafield, Wis., Emily Raber from Buena Park, Calif., and Colleen Jacoby from Muskegon, Mich.

CALLING ALL CAPTAINS... In the 16-year history of the program, 30 women's hockey players have earned the honor of being a captain.

GAME NOTES

This year's captains, Jenna Christensen and Lindsey Hjelm, take the reigns after serving as assistant captains last season. They are just the second tandem to serve back-to-back seasons as captains together. The only other twosome to do so was Mollie Carroll `12 and Kirstin Peterson`11 who served together in the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons.

LAST WEEKEND... The Gusties captured a 3-1 non-conference win over Bethel last weekend on Saturday afternoon at Don Roberts Ice Rink. Although the two squads are members of the same conference, Saturday's match-up was considered a non-conference game because the two teams had already met twice earlier in November.

Leah Johnson got the scoring going just 3:52 into the opening period. Johnson threw a wrister on net from the top of the right circle that found its way through traffic and into the net to put the Gusties on the scoreboard 1-0. Later in the first period, Carolyn Draayer put away a rebound opportunity to extend the Gustavus lead to 2-0 heading into the first intermission.

The second period brought a third Gustavus goal, this time produced by Jenna Christensen. Christensen's first goal of the season came at the 7:59 mark. With :45 seconds remaining in the second, Bethel's Biz Huss was able to find the back of the net to narrow the Gustie lead to 3-1, but it was as close as the Royals would get as Gustavus held on for the threegoal victory.

ABOUT THE FALCONS... UW-River Falls enters this week's series as the No. 6 team in the country, according to the latest USCHO.com Women's Division III Hockey Poll. The Falcons boast an overall record of 7-2-2 after playing a schedule that includes two wins over Adrian and one win over UW-Superior, who are now No. 10 and No. 8, respectively. UW-River Falls is currently riding a two-game winning-streak.

The Falcons are led by first-year Chloe Kinsel. In her first collegiate season, Kinsel has racked up eight goals and six assists for a total of 14 points. She is averaging 1.27 points per game, which ranks 14th in the nation overall, and fifth among rookies. Not far behind her is Katie Batters. Batters has recorded six goals and five assists for 11 points. Her average of 1.10 points per game ranks 24th in the country.

As a team, UW-River Falls ranks sixth in the country in scoring. The Falcons produce 4.18 goals per game. Compared to giving up 1.73 goals per game, UW-River Falls boasts a winning margin of 2.45, good enough to rank fifth in Division III.

NO STRANGERS... Gustavus and UW-River Falls meet for the 10th and 11th times in the past five years this week. Although the two teams belong to different conferences, they have become familiar with one another, averaging two meetings per year in that span. In each of the past four years, the Gusties and Falcons have met in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Gustavus posts a 3-1-0 record in those four meetings.

GUSTIES IN THE POLLS... The Gusties are ranked in the top ten for the seventh time this season according to the USCHO.com poll. The last time Gustavus fell outside of the top ten was the week of Jan. 11th, 2010. This week is the fourth consecutive week the Gustie women have ranked in at No. 2.

GAME NOTES

FAMILIAR TERRITORY... Each team enters this week's top-ten showdown battle-tested against top competition. Against opponents who were ranked in the USCHO.com top-ten at the time, the Falcons are 2-2-0 with a win against both UW-Superior and UW-Stevens Point. The Gusties enter this week 5-0-0 against top-ranked teams. The Gusties defeated UW-Superior before sweeping Bethel and St. Thomas.

BLUELINERS TOP IN THE NATION... Due to an experienced core group of blueliners, the Gustie defense has allowed five goals in seven games this season to give Gustavus a goals against average of 0.75. That mark ranks first in the nation in front of Elmira, who maintains a goals against average of 0.85.

STILL STANDING... The Gusties are one of two unbeaten teams in all of NCAA Division III women's hockey. Due to a 10-0-1 record for Plattsburgh, Gustavus stands alone as the only team in the nation with an unblemished record at 8-0-0. Plattsburgh and Gustavus rank No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, in this week's USCHO.com poll.

BEST ON BEST... With the sixth-ranked offense in the country, UW-River Falls will have its hands full trying to crack a Gustie defense that ranks first in the nation, giving up just 0.75 goals per game. Similarly, the Falcons outscore their opponents by an average of 2.45 goals per game while the Gusties outscore their opponents by a margin of 2.25 goals.

ON THIS DATE... The last time Gustavus played on December 12th, it was 2009 when it traveled to Northfield for a conference battle with St. Olaf. The Gusties came out with a 3-1 victory. Gustavus last played on December 14th in 2007. The result was a 2-1 win over UW-Superior at Don Roberts Ice Rink.

STRONG START... Gustavus is off to a 8-0-0 start this season. It is just the second time in program history that the Gusties have started the year with eight straight wins, the other being last season. However, last season, the streak was broken by UW-River Falls when the two squads tied on Dec. 6th. If the Gusties can pull out a win on Wednesday, it would be the first time in school history the Gustie women have begun the year winning nine straight games.

BY THE NUMBERS...

50 - The number of consecutive weeks the Gusties have been ranked in the USCHO.com top-ten. Gustavus' streak of being ranked in the top-ten reached the half-century mark on Monday when it was named a top-ten team for the 50th consecutive week.

1.00 - The number of points first-year Allison Eder-Zdechlik is averaging per game. Eder-Zdechlik has scored nine points in nine games, which ranks ninth in the nation among rookies.

Mike Carroll is entering his 14th season as the women's head hockey coach at Gustavus. Within his tenure behind the Gustie bench, Carroll has turned Gustavus women's hockey into one of the most successful programs in NCAA Division III women's hockey. He has compiled an overall record of 287-68-22 in 13 seasons and has the most coaching victories in the history of the program.

Last season Carroll directed the Gusties to a record of 24-4-2 overall and a first place finish in the MIAC with a conference record of 16-1-1. The Gusties won the MIAC Championship for the eighth consecutive season and were also the MIAC Playoff

Champions for the ninth straight year. The Gusties advanced to the NCAA National Tournament for the 10th time in 12 years, falling to Norwich University 4-3 in the semifinals before dropping its third place game to Plattsburgh State by the score of 4-3.

Carroll has directed the Gusties to 10 MIAC regular season titles (2000-01, 2001-02, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12) and has been named the MIAC Coach of the Year five times (2001-02, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2010-11). In addition to coaching 27 players who have earned All-Conference honors 51 times, he has coached four MIAC Players-of-the-Year in Sarah Garrison, Andrea Peterson, Stefanie Ubl, and Allie Schwab. Carroll has worked with 12 players who have earned AHCA All-America distinction 17 times and two American Hockey Coaches Association Players-of-the-Year, including four-time MIAC Player-of-the-Year and four-time All-American Andrea Peterson.

Prior to coming to Gustavus, Carroll served as the head boys' hockey coach at Mankato West High School from 1991 to 1999.

Carroll's college coaching resume included a stint as head men's hockey

coach at Fergus Falls Community College from 1986 to 1987 as well as a season as the assistant men's coach at the University of St. Thomas in 1983.

Carroll, an Edina, Minnesota native, competed in hockey and baseball at Mankato State. After graduating with a degree in municipal recreation in 1982, Carroll played professional baseball in the Montreal Expos organization for two years.

In addition to his hockey coaching duties at Gustavus, Carroll is also the head coach of the Golden Gustie baseball team. Mike and his wife, Terri, live in Mankato and have two sons, Matt and Mike.






