GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 71ST SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY... The Gustavus men's hockey team is currently in its 71st season. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 822-608-62 overall and 544-320-39 in the MIAC. Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF... Head Coach Brett Petersen is entering his 13th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 169-138-26 record in his 12 seasons at Gustavus. His 165 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10. Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey standout David Martinson begins his first season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate and one of the most decorated hockey players to don a three crowned sweater. Martinson is a native of St. Louis Park, Minn. After being named the MIAC Player of the Year and earning All-America honors twice during his playing career, Martinson continued his education at the Bowling Green State University where he served as a graduate assistant for the men's hockey team. David received his masters of education in sport administration in August.

AROUND THE GLOBE... Gustavus' 2012-13 roster features 28 players from five different states and four different countries other than the United States of America, Within the U.S., Minnesota (18), California (2), Nevada (1), Massachusetts (1), and Colorado (1) are represented by 23 players. Outside the U.S., two Canadian provinces, British of Columbia (2) and Ontario (1), are represented by three players. while Scandinavian countries Norway and Sweden each have one rep. This year's club also features 23 players with junior hockey experience prior to coming to

CALLING ALL CAPTAINS... In the 70 year history of Gustavus men's hockey, only 83 players have earned the right to wear a "C" on their chest for the Black and Gold. Seniors Dane Erickson (Woodbury, Minn.) and Tim LaBombard (Bloomington, Minn.) will serve as captains of this year's team, becoming the 84th and 85th in the history of the program. Fellow seniors Andrew Peterson (Reno, Nev.) and Ryan Johnson (Blaine, Minn.) will also serve as assistant captains.

THE SERIES... Gustavus and Lawrence will meet for the fourth time in men's hockey on Friday night at Don Roberts Ice Rink. The Gusties have won all three games of the all-time series. At last the two squads met on Dec. 10 last year in Appleton, Gustavus came away with a 5-3 win thanks in large part to a four-goal performance by Adam Smyth.

The Gusties will take on UW-Superior for the 13th time on Saturday night. The Yellowjackets control the all-time series with a mark of 8-3-1. After a stretch where Gustavus lost six of seven contests to UW-Superior in the 2000's, the Gusties have come out victorious in their last two bouts of the matchup. In their meeting last season, Adam Smyth scored the eventual game-winner in the second period to allow the Black and Gold a 2-1 win.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND... The Gustavus men's hockey team earned its first MIAC points of the season last weekend by sweeping Augsburg in an away/home series. The Gusties cruised to a 5-0 win on Friday night in Minneapolis, then earned the four-point sweep with a 3-2 overtime victory on Saturday night in St. Peter.

On Friday night at Ed Saugestad Rink, Gustavus used its most productive first

period of the season to jump out to a 3-0 lead. Darren Lapic, Tyler Lapic, and Ryan Johnson all scored in the opening frame. The Gusties added an Ilya Kravtchouk goal in the second and a Dane Erickson goal in the third to pick up their first conference win of the year. Goaltender Tyler Venne picked up his first shutout of the season in the win, making a total of 30 saves.

The Gusties found themselves in a back-and-forth dogfight at home on Saturday. After Augsburg opened the scoring with a goal early in the second period, Gustavus' Tyler Schwartz responded :16 seconds later with the equalizer to knot the game at 1-1. Andy Pearson put the Gusties on top 2-1 at 12:59 of the third period, and the Auggies answered right back with a goal less than a minute later to even the score at 2-2 and send the game to overtime.

In Gustavus' second overtime test of the year, it took 4:31 of the extra session for Jack Walsh to knock in the game-winning goal on a rebound. Patrick Sullivan earned the victory between the pipes after recording 37 saves.

ABOUT LAWRENCE... The Lawrence University men's hockey team got back into the win column last weekend by earning a sweep over MCHA opponent Finlandia at home in Appleton. The Vikings won 6-3 on Friday night before completing the sweep with a 5-2 win on Saturday.

With Finlandia leading 3-2 halfway through the second period, Lawrence closed the game with four unanswered goals in the final 27 minutes to pick up the win and snap a four-game losing-streak. Phil Bushbacher scored two goals and added two assists in the game, while Logan Lemirande had a five point night with a goal and four assists. Lawrence outshot the Lions 48-22, as Peter Emery picked up the win in nets after a 19-save effort.

With a 2-1 lead heading into the third period, the Vikings exploded for three goals within the first ten minutes of the frame, holding on for the three-goal win to earn the sweep. Four different Lawrence players hit the scoresheet with two points on the night, as Emery earned the victory in goal after stopping 28-of-30 shots.

Lawrence boasts a scoring attack that features five players with double-figure points on the year. Lemirande is the squad's leading scorer with 15 points (3G, 12), while Brad Scurfield (8G, 5A) and Bushbacher (7G, 6A) both have 13. The Vikings are averaging 4.30 goals per game and have the best combined special teams percentage in the MCHA at 54.2.

Emery has done the majority of netminding thus far, entering the weekend at 2-4-0 with 376:20 minutes logged. He carries a goals against average of 3.19 and a save percentage of .893. Defensively, Lawrence is allowing four goals per game.

ABOUT UW-SUPERIOR... The UW-Superior men's hockey team was in NCHA action last weekend in a road series against UW-River Falls. The Yellowjackets earned three points over the weekend with a 1-1 tie on Friday night and a 3-2 win on Saturday.

Facing a 1-0 deficit heading into the final period in the series-opener, UW-Superior's Kevin Clark was able to tie the game at 1-1 with a goal at the 8:14 mark. Despite the Yellowjackets outshooting the Falcons 5-1 in overtime, niether side could find the game-winner. Yellowjacket goalie Drew Strandberg was test 18 times in the game, turning away 17 shots.

In Saturday's series-finale, Pat Dalbec put UWS up 1-0 with a power play goal in the second period. After UW-River Falls tied the game at 1-1 in the eighth minute of the third period, the Yellowjackets answered with goals by Brad Phenow and Andy Singerhouse, respectively, in the heart of the period to go up 3-1. The Falcons cut the lead to one (3-2) with less than six minutes to play, but Strandberg shut the door on any comeback hopes. The UW-Superior goalie earned his sixth win of the year after making 15 saves in the contest.

GAME NOTES

Pat Dalbec, Jeff Forsythe, and Joey Massingham lead the Yellowjackets in scoring through 11 games. Dalbec has a balanced 15 points on seven goals and eight assists, while Forsythe has scored 12 points (2G, 10A) and Massingham has scored 10 (4G, 6A). The Yellowjackets average 3.18 goals per game offensively, and have allowed an average of 2.64 goals on defense.

UW-Superior has found a way to win close games through the first portion of the season. They are currently 3-0 in one goal games and 5-0 in games decided by two goals. Drew Strandberg has tallied 485:50 minutes in net and holds a 6-1-1 record entering the weekend. He has a save percentage of .881 and a goals against average of 2.35.

GRUELING NOVEMBER... The Gusties wrapped up their most grueling month of the season last weekend with a 5-0 win over Augsburg on Nov. 30. Gustavus played nine games over the month of November, compiling a record of 3-5-1. To go along with then No. 1 St. Norbert and No. 12 St. Thomas, Gustavus also took on its third ranked team in No. 8 Amherst in Massachusetts.

RYAN JOHNSON NAMED ATHLETE OF THE MONTH... Senior forward Ryan Johnson was recently named the November Student-Athlete of the Month by the Gustavus Sports Information Department. Johnson turned in his most productive month as a Gustie, tallying a total of nine points on four goals and five assists inside November. Against St. Norbert, the senior scored the unassisted gamewinning goal at the 14:24 mark of the third period to allow Gustavus the upset over the defending NCAA Champion. The Blaine native finished the second portion of the month strong with a four-game point-streak that included three goals and four assists. He capped November with a pair of multiple point games, scoring a goal and adding an assist in a 4-2 win over Williams, and scoring another goal to go along with two assists in a 5-0 win over Augsburg.

POWER PLAY STRUGGLES... The Gustie men's hockey team will look to get its struggling power play on track before heading into the holiday break after this weekend. Since Nov. 9, Gustavus has been blanked on its last 23 power play opportunities. The Gusties are just 4-for-43 (.093) on the man-advantage this year, ranking them eighth in the MIAC.

VS. THE MCHA.... The Gustavus skaters will do battle against a representative of the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association on Friday against Lawrence. The Gusties have won the past nine contests with MCHA opponents with their last loss coming against Marian 4-0 on Jan. 5, 2008. Brett Petersen holds a record of 12-7-1 against current MCHA foes during his tenure at Gustavus.

VS. THE NCHA... The Gusties will also take on a of member of the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association this weekend when they face UW-Superior. Gustavus is 1-1-0 on the year against NCHA members after early season matchups against UW-Stevens Point and St. Norbert. The Gusties fell to UW-Stevens Point 3-2, yet defeated St. Norbert 2-1. Coach Petersen has compiled a record of 31-33-4 against the NCHA in his 12 plus year career behind the Gustavus bench.

Brett Petersen is entering his 13th season as the head coach of the Gustavus men's hockey team. Last season, coach Petersen directed the Gusties to an overall record of 17-7-5 and a second place finish in the MIAC with a record of 8-5-3. After qualifying for the MIAC Playoffs for the 11th consecutive season, the Gusties defeated Saint John's 3-1 in the semifinals before taking down St. Olaf 4-2 in front of a sellout Don Roberts Ice Rink in the MIAC Playoff Championship. By virtue of an MIAC Playoff Championship, the Gusties earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in school history. The Black and Gold topped Milwaukee School of Engineering by the score of 3-1 at home in the opening round, yet fell 4-1 to eventual National Champion St. Nortbert College 4-1 in Green Bay, Wis. in the quarterfinals.



Entering his 13th year behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 165-133-25 overall record. His 165 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 15 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, seven All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.
