GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 104TH SEASON OF MEN'S BASKETBALL...

The 2012-13 season represents the 104th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1366-945, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 900-543. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in the league. The program has made 22 MIAC playoff appearances, including 12 consecutively, and also has participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times.

LIVE ACTION... All Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball games will be broadcast live on KNUJ Radio AM 860 and KRDS 95.5 with Tom Wheeler handling the play-by-play broadcast. MEET THE GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF...

Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 23rd season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 20 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 423 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history. His .695 winning percentage ranks sixth on the all-time list.

Assistant coach Josh Drinkall begins his sixth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, Drinkall has coached two MIAC All-Defensive players in his first five years. Prior to coming to Gustavus, Drinkall worked as an assistant coach for six seasons at Winona State University where he was a part of the 2006 NCAA Division II National Championship and a second place finish in 2007.

Jeff Fish begins his fourth season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

from a team that finished 20-8 (16-4 MIAC) last season, Gustavus will look to a core group of seniors to lead the way in the 2012-13 year. That core group of seniors includes three of the top five scorers from last year's team in Ben Biewen (Sr., Edina, Minn.), Jim Hill (Sr., Edina, Minn.), and Blake Shay (Sr., Lakeville, Minn.). Reed Sallstrom (Sr., Winthrop, Minn.) will also add experience as a returning senior.

Outside of the four seniors, the Gusties return just 20 points and 192 minutes of play from last year's squad. Lone junior Jordan Dick (Jr., Wabasha, Minn.) will look to add production to the Gustie lineup, while Isaac Tapp (So., Stewartville, Minn.) will serve as the team's primary ball handler after playing in eight games last season. Sophomores Martin Feddersen (So., Winona, Minn.), Brian Jacobs (So., Lake Crystal, Minn.), and Jed Kreuser (So., Jordan, Minn.) are all expect to contribut in their second season. Newcomers Matt Humphries (So., Maple Grove, Minn.), Dane Schmid (So., Mahtomedi, Minn.), Sergio Najera (Fr., New Prague, Minn.), Connor Perry (Fr., Hibbing, Minn.), Chad Poppen (Fr., St. Peter, Minn.), and Brody Ziegler (Fr., Mankato, Minn.) will also look to make an impact in their first collegiate varsity season.

LAST TIME OUT... The Gusties are coming off a 74-54 victory over Carleton on Wenesday night. Gustavus built a 17-point lead in the first half thanks in large part to 65.5-percent shooting from the field. Jim Hill poured in 15 points in the opening frame to lead the Gusties.


However, Carleton clawed its way back in the second 20 minutes. An 11-0 run brought the Knights within seven with the score 59-52 with 6:02 to play. From there, the Gusties ran away with a 15-2 run to close the game and escape with the 20-point victory.

Jim Hill led the Gusties in scoring with 19 points on 8-for-16 shooting from the field including a 3-for-6 mark from three-point range. Ben Biewen came next with 15 points on 6-for-8 shooting from the floor and 2-for-4 from deep. He also added a team-high four assists and four steals. Isaac Tapp was the third Gustie in double figures with 11 points. Tapp cashed in on 5-of-8 field goal attempts and dished out three assists.

ABOUT THE AUGGIES... After beginning the year 9-0, Augsburg has tallied a record of 3-2 in its last five games. A 94-52 loss to conference-leading St. Thomas on Jan.

5th gave the Auggies their first loss of the year. Since then, Augsburg has come back to win three of its last four with wins over Saint John's (77-65), St. Olaf (90-82) and Macalester (61-51). The only loss during that stretch came to Carleton in a 75-71 defeat at Si Melby Hall in Minneapolis.

The Auggies are led in scoring by four players who average double-figures. Dan Kornbaum leads the way, averaging 18.3 points per contest while Brett Rasmussen averages 11.4 points and Tyler Schmidt pours in 11.3 per game. Parker Hines follows, averaging 10.6 points per game.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK... Augsburg is led by two newcomers to the MIAC. Junior Dan Kornbaum came to Augsburg via the University of Minnesota, Duluth. After playing two seasons at the Division II level, Kornbaum is enjoying his first season in Division III, averaging 18.3 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Likewise, Brett Rasmussen, the second leading scorer for the Auggies, is also a new face in the MIAC. Rasmussen, a freshman from Lakeville, Minn., is second on the team in scoring (11.4 pts/game) and also second on the team in rebounding (5.8 reb/game).

PAYBACK... The Gusties let one slip by when the two squads met earlier this season on Nov. 28th in St. Peter, setting up an opportunity for revenge. Augsburg emerged victorious with an 81-73 win, which, at the time, gave Gustavus its second consecutive loss and sent the Gusties below .500 for the first time since the 2008-09 season, when they finished 13-14 on the season.

GIVE ME A BREAK!... After starting the season 2-5, the Gustie men were in need of a break following a 69-66 loss to Buena Vista on Saturday, Dec. 8th. The players got some much-needed time off before returning to campus on Dec. 26th to prepare for two games in Eau Claire, Wis. in late December. Since the break, the Gusties have come roaring back, winning five of their last six games. The only loss in that stretch came to conference-leader and newly-No. 1 St. Thomas.

ON THIS DATE... The last time Gustavus played on Jan. 16th, the Gusties came away with a 74-58 victory over Concordia in St. Peter. Tyler Grey led the way with 17 points on 7-for-7 shooting from the field with three triples. Seth Anderson netted 12 points and also added four rebounds and four assists, while Jim Hill chipped in 11 points on 5-for-10 shooting from the floor.

Mark Hanson is entering his 23rd season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

Last season, Hanson led the Gusties to their first MIAC Championship since the 2004-05 season, sharing the 2011-12 title with St. Thomas. Gustavus went 20-8 overall and 16-4 in the MIAC. The Black and Gold went on to defeat Saint John's 64-52 at home in the semifinals of the MIAC Playoffs before falling 66-62 in overtime to St. Thomas in the MIAC Playoff Championship held in St. Paul. The Gusties earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the 2005 season, drawing Wheaton College in the first round. Gustavus' season ended in the first round with a 68-60 loss to the Thunder in River Falls, Wis.



In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 422-185 overall record at Gustavus, including a 319-121 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 19 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has

coached 27 players who have garnered 47 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, is married to Deb Johnson. Mark and Deb have two children, Hans and Annika, and live in St. Peter.

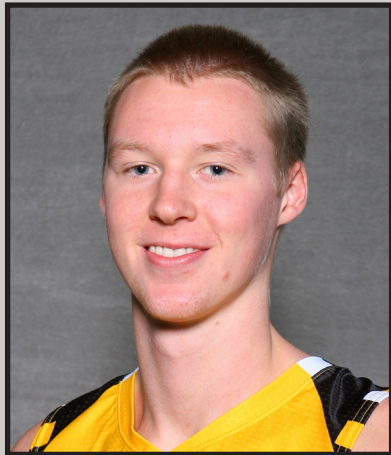
