



## **GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 104TH SEASON OF MEN'S**

**BASKETBALL...** The 2012-13 season represents the 104th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1366-945, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 900-543. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in the league. The program has made 22 MIAC playoff appearances, including 12 consecutively, and also has participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times.

**LIVE ACTION...** All Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball games will be broadcast live on KNUJ Radio AM 860 and KRDS 95.5 with Tom Wheeler handling the play-by-play broadcast. Fans can also access live video of all home games through the Gustavus athletics website and the following link http://client. stretchinternet.com/client/gac.portal#.

**MEET THE GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF...** Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 23rd season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 20 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 423 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history. His .695 winning percentage ranks sixth on the all-time list.

Assistant coach Josh Drinkall begins his sixth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, Drinkall has coached two MIAC All-Defensive players in his first five years. Prior to coming to Gustavus, Drinkall worked as an assistant coach for six seasons at Winona State University where he was a part of the 2006 NCAA Division II National Championship and a second place finish in 2007.

Jeff Fish begins his fourth season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

**LAST TIME THEY MET...** The last time these two teams met, Bethel traveled to St. Peter and snuck out with a narrow onepoint victory earlier this season on Dec. 5th. With the Royals leading by four points with 1:09 to play and the score 60-56, Jim Hill knocked down a triple that cut the lead to one point with :48 seconds to go.

On the ensuing possession, Taylor Hall was fouled and missed

the free throw, giving the Gusties a chance to win. Hill had a look from the elbow, but could not convert and the Royals escaped with the 60-59 win.

**LAST TIME OUT...** The Gusties saw their three-game win-streak snapped when they suffered a 70-66 loss to St. Olaf on Monday night. Gustavus was able to build a 10-point lead midway through the first half, but an 11-6 run to close out the half for St. Olaf cut the lead to five headed in to halftime. That run was capped off by a Sterling Nielsen three-pointer from 30 feet out that beat the buzzer and brought the score to 35-30.

After Gustavus scored the opening basket of the second half, St. Olaf fired back with a 9-2 run that tied the game at 39-39. The two squads went back-and-forth for the remainder of the half until a reverse layup from Nathan Kuck put the Oles on top with 3:32 remaining. That proved to be the last lead change of the game as the Oles went on to make their last five free throws to seal the four-point victory.

Four Gusties scored in double-figures on the night. Jim Hill (Sr., Edina, Minn.) led the way with 15 points on 4-for-9 shooting from the field and a perfect 7-for-7 from the line. He also added 10 rebounds to register his second double-double of the season. Isaac Tapp and Ben Biewen (Sr., Edina, Minn.) came next with 12 points each and Brody Ziegler came off the bench to chip in a career-high 10 points. He also grabbed six rebounds.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS...** Bethel enters Wednesday's contest much like Gustavus. After winning three straight, the Royals fell to Augsburg on Monday night in Minneapolis by the final score of 69-65. Taylor Hall was the only Royal to score in double-figures on the night. Hall finished with 27 points on 11-for-21 shooting from the floor and also added nine rebounds.

Hall's offensive production on Monday night has become commonplace in the 2012-13 season. The senior averages 21.5 points and 9.9 rebounds per game, leading the MIAC in both categories. His 57.4-percent shooting percentage also ranks 8th in the league, one spot behind his teammate Kyle Zimmerman, who shoots the rock at a 57.6-percent clip. He is second on the team in scoring (13.6 ppg) and rebounding (7.7 rbg) after missing three games due to injury.

As a team, the Royals rely on a defense that leads the league in opponent field goal percentage (43.3-percent), blocked shots (4.1 bpg) and defensive rebounding (24.9 drpg). Offensively, Bethel is averaging 72.4 points (4th/MIAC) and 15.6 assists per game (2nd/MIAC).

## **Game Notes**

**MIRROR, MIRROR, ON THE WALL...** Gustavus and Bethel enter Wednesday night's contest mirror images of each other after both teams saw their three-game winning streaks snapped with four-point losses Monday night. Wednesday's match-up aims to determine who is the fairest team of all.

**THE TURNOVER GAME...** Taking care of the basketball is a key in any game, but seemingly even more important for a Gustie team that commits the second least turnovers in the MIAC. Gustavus coughed the ball up 13 times in Monday night's loss, which led to 13 St. Olaf points. Conversely, the Oles turned the ball over just nine times, giving them the advantage in the turnover game. When that happens, the Gusties are 1-6 this season compared to an 8-1 mark when they hold the advantage in the turnover category.

**FAMILY AFFAIR...** Senior Ben Biewen has grown up with the Gustavus tradition. His grandfather, Bob Erdman, served as head coach for the Gustie basketball program from 1981-86. Biewen's father, Paul, played for the Black and Gold in the late 70's and graduated in 1980. Now the third generation in the Gustavus basketball program, Ben continues his family's tradition of donning the three crowns and looks to cap off his career with a fourth straight trip to the MIAC Playoffs following the conclusion of the regular season.

**ON THIS DATE...** The Gusties last played on Jan. 23rd in 2010 when they traveled to Moorhead for a showdown with Concordia. Gustavus came out on top in that game with a 79-72 victory. The Gusties had five Gusties finish with double-figures in the scoring category, led by Jesse Van Sickle with 21.

## BY THE NUMBERS...

**.585 - Isaac Tapp's shooting percentage in 2013.** Sophomore Isaac Tapp has been on a roll since the holiday break. The six-feet, two-inch guard from Stewartville, Minn. has shot 58.5-percent (31-53) from the floor in the new year, and had not shot below 50-percent in a game until Monday night when he went 5-for-11 from the field.

16 - The number of games Jim Hill or Ben Biewen have led the Gusties in scoring. Combined, the senior tandem of Hill and Biewen have led the team in scoring in all 16 games. Each player has been the top scorer in eight games this season.

**.769 - Head coach Mark Hanson's winning percentage against Bethel.** In his 22-plus seasons at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program, Hanson has amassed a record of 40-12 against the Royals for a winning percentage of .769.

Mark Hanson is entering his 23rd season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

Last season, Hanson led the Gusties to their first MIAC Championship since the 2004-05 season, sharing the 2011-12 title with St. Thomas. Gustavus went 20-8 overall and 16-4 in the MIAC. The Black and Gold went on to defeat Saint John's 64-52 at home in the semifinals of the MIAC Playoffs before falling 66-62 in overtime to St. Thomas in the MIAC Playoff Championship held in St. Paul. The Gusties earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the 2005 season, drawing Wheaton College in the first round. Gustavus' season ended in the first round with a 68-60 loss to the Thunder in





River Falls, Wis.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 422-185 overall record at Gustavus, including a 319-121

record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 19 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occassions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has

coached 27 players who have garnered 47 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, is married to Deb Johnson. Mark and Deb have two children, Hans and Annika, and live in St. Peter.
