The winner of Friday night's opening round game will take on No. 1 seed St. Thomas on Saturday, Feb. 23 at 7:30 p.m. at the St. Thomas Ice Arena located in Mendota Heights. In the other semifinal game set for 7:00 p.m., No. 2 seed Saint John's will battle No. 3 seed Concordia at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud.

**GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 71ST SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY...** The Gustavus men's hockey team is currently in its 71st season. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 831-610-64 overall and 551-321-41 in the MIAC. Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

**GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF...** Head Coach Brett Petersen is entering his 13th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 180-140-28 record in his 12-plus seasons at Gustavus. His 178 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10. Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey standout David Martinson begins his first season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate and one of the most decorated hockey players to don a three crowned sweater, Martinson is a native of St. Louis Park, Minn. After being named the MIAC Player of the Year and earning All-America honors twice during his playing career, Martinson continued his education at the Bowling Green State University where he served as a graduate assistant for the men's hockey team. David received his masters of education in sport administration in August.

**AROUND THE GLOBE...** Gustavus' 2012-13 roster features 28 players from five different states and four different countries other than the United States of America. Within the U.S., Minnesota (18), California (2), Nevada (1), Massachusetts (1), and Colorado (1) are represented by 23 players. Outside the U.S., two Canadian provinces, British of Columbia (2) and Ontario (1), are represented by three players, while Scandinavian countries Norway and Sweden each have one rep. This year's club also features 23 players with junior hockey experience prior to coming to Gustavus.

**CALLING ALL CAPTAINS...** In the 70 year history of Gustavus men's hockey, only 83 players have earned the right to wear a "C" on their chest for the Black and Gold. Seniors Dane Erickson (Woodbury, Minn.) and Tim LaBombard (Bloomington, Minn.) will serve as captains of this year's team, becoming the 84th and 85th in the history of the program. Fellow seniors Andrew Peterson (Reno, Nev.) and Ryan Johnson (Blaine, Minn.) will also serve as assistant captains.

**TICKET INFORMATION...** For Friday's first round men's hockey playoff game, the rate is \$7 for adult and \$3 for any student (5 years old and younger are free). There is no senior discount. MIAC Passes will be honored. No other passes are to be accepted.

MIAC PLAYOFF INFORMATION... The five-team MIAC Playoffs will open Friday with a first-round game. No. 4 Gustavus will host No. 5 St. Olaf in St.

Peter Friday at 7:05 p.m. in the lone quarterfinal matchup. The two semifinal games will both be held Saturday, Feb. 23, with top-seeded St. Thomas hosting the No. 4/5 winner in Mendota Heights in one semifinal, and No. 2 Saint John's hosting No. 3 Concordia in St. Cloud in the other.

The championship game will be held Saturday, March 1, on the home ice of the highest remaining seed. The time for the title game will be announced when the site is known. The winner of the 2013 MIAC Men's Hockey Playoffs will receive the conference's automatic bid to the 2013 NCAA Division III Men's Hockey Tournament.

**THE SERIES...** The Gustavus and St. Olaf men's hockey teams will be meeting for the 91st time this weekend. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 60-25-5. The two teams will have a great deal of recent familiarity with one another after going head-to-head in the final home-and-home series of the regular season. The Gusties earned the sweep over the Oles with a 4-1 win in St. Peter and a 2-0 victory in Northfield. Gustavus has won three straight games and are unbeaten in the last five contests of the series.

**ABOUT THE OLES...** The St. Olaf men's hockey team enters the MIAC Playoffs as the fifth seed after an up-and-down second half of the season. The Oles went 5-2-1 through January and the first game of February to led the league with an MIAC record of 9-3-0 after 75-percent of the conference season. After a 4-1 win over Augsburg on Feb. 1, St. Olaf dropped five straight games to finish 9-7-0 in league play.

Over their last five games, the Oles have scored a total of four goals and are allowing an average of 3.2 goals per game. They are being outshot by an average of 31.4-to-26.8 shots per game within that time-span.

Through the regular season, St. Olaf's offense was led by a top line trio made up of all juniors that combined for 65 points on the year. Jeff Harris leads the group with 24 points off 16 goals and eight assists, ranking him fourth in the league in overall scoring. Within conference play, Jeff Harris' 18 points and 12 goals led the league. Dan Checka is next in line with 21 points (8G, 13A), while Kevin Harris has 20 points (6G, 14A). The line was responsible for 41-percent of the team's scoring against MIAC opponents this year.

The Oles will have to determine which goaltender to go with this weekend for junior Henrik Wood and sophomore Steve Papciak have seen equal time over the past three weeks. Papciak got the call against the Gusties last weekend, allowing a total of five goals and making 63 saves. Her enters the post-season at 2-7-1 with an .898 save percentage and a 3.09 goals against average. Wood comes in at 8-6-1 with a .924 save percentage and a 2.30 goals against average.

**SENIORS SPOTLIGHT...** The Gustavus Adolphus senior class played its final regular season game on Saturday at St. Olaf. In their 100 regular season contests, the seniors on this year's squad have compiled a record of 61-27-12 for a winning percentage of .670. The group is 6-4-0 in their playoff careers while also boasting an impressive 6-1-0 post-season record at Don Roberts Ice Rink.

#### GAME NOTES

**PLAYOFF HISTORY...** The Gustavus men's hockey team is making its 22nd appearance in the MIAC Playoffs since the initiation of the tournament in the 1986-87 season. Making their 12th straight appearance in the post-season, the Gusties are 16-21-1 all-time in MIAC Tournament play.

Friday night's game will be just the fourth meeting between Gustavus and St. Olaf in the MIAC Tournament. The Oles hold the advantage in the series with a record of 2-1. Gustavus picked up its first playoff victory against St. Olaf last season in what was a memorable MIAC Championship game. In front of the largest hockey crowd ever assembled at Don Roberts Ice Rink, Gustavus used a three-goal first period to come away with a 4-2 victory and earn the MIAC's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

**ON THE RUN...** Riding a six-game winning-streak and an 8-1-2 record since Christmas, the Gustie skaters are peaking at the right time, entering the MIAC Playoffs as one of the hottest team in the league. In the second half of the season, Gustavus is scoring an average of 3.7 goals and allowing an average of 2.1 goals per game. Over their current six-game win-streak, the Gusties are scoring 4.3 goals while giving up an average of 1.6. They are also averaging 33.8 shots within the run - over four more shots than their season average.

TOP LINES ON FIRE... Much of Gustavus' recent success has had to do with the scoring output of its top two lines over the last three weekends. The Jack Walsh (7G, 1A), Tyler Lapic (2G, 6A), and Corey Leivermann (1G, 6A) line has combined for 23 points on 10 goals and 13 assists, while the Adam Smyth (4G, 4A), Ryan Johnson (4G, 2A), and Andy Pearson (2G, 6A) line has combined for 22 points on 10 goals and 12 assists. Walsh, Lapic and Leivermann have all been on fire over the run as each of them comes into Friday's bout in the midst of a team-best six-game point-streak.

**VENNE HEATING UP...** After fellow netminders John McLean and Patrick Sullivan were sidelined with injuries before the holidays, senior Tyler Venne has had to take over the roll of "The Man" in net over the second half of the season. Venne has answered the call, suffering just one loss and riding a career-best six-game winning-streak into Friday's game. Within the streak, Venne holds a goals against average of 1.67 and a .937 save percentage. Overall this season, he carries a goals against average of 2.34 and a save percentage of .913.

IT'S HOW YOU FINISH... After a slow start in conference play in which the Gusties went 2-4-0 during the first half of the year, the team has turned things around after the halfway point and are now 8-1-2 overall since the holiday break. During coach Petersen's time at the head of the Gustavus men's hockey program, the Gusties have compiled a record of 95-76-18 in the second portion of the season. Over the prior four seasons, Gustavus holds a .636 (41-21-5) winning percentage after Christmas.

Brett Petersen is in his 13th season as the head coach of the Gustavus men's hockey team. Last season, coach Petersen directed the Gusties to an overall record of 17-7-5 and a second place finish in the MIAC with a record of 8-5-3. After qualifying for the MIAC Playoffs for the 11th consecutive season, the Gusties defeated Saint John's 3-1 in the semifinals before taking down St. Olaf 4-2 in front of a sellout Don Roberts Ice Rink in the MIAC Playoff Championship. By virtue of an MIAC Playoff Championship, the Gusties earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in school history. The Black and Gold topped Milwaukee School of Engineering by the score of 3-1 at home in the opening round, yet fell 4-1 to eventual National Champion St. Nortbert College 4-1 in Green Bay, Wis. in the quarterfinals.



Entering his 13th year behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 165-133-25 overall record. His 165 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 15 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, seven All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.
