ABOUT TODAY'S MATCH

The Gustavus Adolphus College men's soccer team will play host to Viterbo University to kick off its 2013 campaign on Saturday night at the Gustie Soccer Field. Where Gustavus will embark on a new season, Viterbo already has one match in the books and is entering tonight's contest at 0-1-0 following a 4-1 loss at the hands of Roosevelt University.

2012 SEASON SUMMARY

The Gustavus men's soccer team reemerged on the national stage after claiming MIAC regular season and playoff titles in 2012. Gustavus earned 25 points after going 8-1-1 in league play to share the league title with Carleton. After defeating St. Thomas 1-0 in the opening round of the MIAC Playoffs, Gustavus secured a place in the NCAA Tournament with a 7-6 penalty kick shootout victory after playing Carleton to a 0-0 tie in the MIAC Playoff Championship. In their first NCAA Tournament showing since 2007, the Gusties saw their run come to an end against UW-Platteville in the first round. After 110 minutes of scoreless soccer, the Pioneers bested the Gusties 3-2 in the penalty shootout.

SERIES HISTORY

Tonight's match will be the 13th meeting between Gustavus and Viterbo on the soccer pitch. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 10-2. The last time the two clubs met was also a season-opening affair on Sept. 1, 2004 in La Crosse, Wis. The Gusties cruised to a 5-0 win in the match after getting five goals from five different players. Senior Taylor Stein led Gustavus with a goal and two assists.

NEWS AND NOTES

Ylonen Back In Net...The goalkeeping duties will once again fall on junior Brett Ylonen (Lake Elmo, Minn.). Ylonen is coming off a sophomore season that saw him earn a spot on the D3soccer.com All-America Third Team. He was also named to the NSCAA All-Region First Team and All-Conference Team. Ylonen went 14-2-3 overall and 8-1-1 in the MIAC last season after starting in 18-of-20 matches and logging 1,746:56 minutes in net. He allowed a total of eight goals (4th/MIAC) and carried GAA of 0.41 (1st/MIAC). Brett posted a league-best save percentage of .896, which also ranked fourth in NCAA Division III.

All-Region/All-Conference Returners...Juniors Zach Brown (Eau Claire, Wis.) and David Lilly (Maple Grove, Minn.) return to Middleton's lineup after both earning All-Region and All-Conference honors last season. Brown led Gustavus in scoring for the second straight season in 2012, scoring 31 points off 14 goals and three assists. His 31 points ranked fourth in the MIAC while his 14 goals ranked second. The forward striker also scored a league-best seven game-winning goals, five of which came against MIAC opponents. The quarterback of the midfield, David Lilly ranked third on the team in scoring with one goal and nine assists for 11 points. His nine assists ranked third in the MIAC and 33rd in the nation, while five of his dimes were on game-winning goals.

By the numbers...

- 10:** The number of wins Head Coach Mike Middleton needs to reach 200 career victories at the NCAA level. Middleton holds an all-time record of 190-62-22 and is 39-9-9 in his first three seasons at Gustavus.
- .768:** The home game winning percentage of the Gustavus men's soccer team in the past three seasons. The Gusties are 20-5-3 in St. Peter during Middleton's tenure.
- 0.51:** The goals against average of Gustavus the past two seasons. The Gusties allowed a combined 20 goals in 2011 and 2012. Last season, Gustavus ranked ninth in the country in goals against average at 0.54.

MIDDLETON ON FRIDAY'S MATCH

Viterbo should be a good test this early in the year. It's great to be at home and a later kick-off should see a slight drop in the temperature. The lads do not take to any messing around - they want to play the top teams from the get go and compare themselves to the very best. I think this speaks absolute volumes for them. Performing at the highest level is key, especially when you are playing the right way. No huff and puff and smack it into corners here. I'm sure they'd want me to schedule Manchester United if we could - and we'd try to outplay them. So, we are all pretty enthusiastic and keen to get going. This should be a lot of fun!
