SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus men's soccer team will travel to Arden Hills, Minn. on Tuesday afternoon for an MIAC match against the Royals of Bethel University set to begin at 3:30 p.m. Gustavus comes into the match coming off a 2-0 win over Augsburg in its last outing on Saturday in St. Peter. Bethel was also in action on Saturday and suffered a 1-0 loss to Hamline in St. Paul. Gustavus enters the week with an overall record of 11-2-1 and an MIAC mark of 8-0-0, while Bethel heads in at 5-12-0 overall and 2-7-0 in the MIAC.

LAST TIME OUT

The Gustavus men's soccer team used a strong second half to propel itself to a 2-0 victory over Augsburg on Saturday at the Gustie Soccer Field. After a scoreless first half, Charlie Adams (So., Stillwater, Minn.) connected with Patrick Roth (Fr., Stillwater, Minn.) to break the scoreless tie with a goal in the 72nd minute. Roth later returned the favor less than ten minutes later, connecting with Adams who scored an insurance goal in the 78th minute. Gustavus outshot the Auggies 12-7, as Brett Ylonen earned his third straight shutout victory after making five saves.

SERIES HISTORY

Tuesday's match will be the 49th meeting between Gustavus and Bethel on the soccer pitch. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 29-11-8. In last season's meeting in St. Peter, Gustavus used goals by Zach Brown (Jr., Eau Claire, Wis.) and Charlie Adams to come away with a 2-0 victory. Since falling 1-0 to Bethel in 2004, the Gusties have rattled off eight straight wins in the series.

NEWS AND NOTES

HISTORIC START - With Saturday's win over Augsburg, Gustavus's already historic start to its conference schedule became even more historic. Since the inception of MIAC men's soccer in 1968, just one Gustavus team before this season has come out of its first eight league games with an unblemished record. Gustavus's 1970 team is the only squad in program history to win the first eight games of their MIAC schedule. The 1970 Gusties went a perfect 10-0-0 in league play to win the school's second MIAC title.

SO LONG OCTOBER - After Tuesday's match against Bethel, the Gustavus men's soccer team will wave good bye to October. During the tenure head coach Mike Middleton, the Gusties have been brilliant in October - and this year has been no different. Gustavus is currently 5-0-0 inside the month and is averaging two goals per match. Defensively, the Gusties have shut out three teams and have allowed just two goals all month. Since 2010, Gustavus is a combined 24-2-4 (.933) in the October.

SECOND HALF SURGES - Whether it's the depth of its bench, or the team's conditioning, Gustavus has proven to be a second half team this season. Saturday's win over Augsburg was the fourth match in a row that the Gusties struck the game-winning goal in the second half. Zach Brown scored the game-winner in the 70th minute in a 2-1 win against St. Olaf, and later scored two second half goals in the 61st and 82 minutes to give the Gusties a 2-0 win over Macalester. Konnor Tranor netted the game-winner in the 85th minute in a 1-0 victory against St. Thomas, and Patrick Roth and Charlie Adams both scored in last Saturday's two-goal win over the Auggies.

MIDDLETON ON THE MATCH

This will be a tough challenge for the lads. Bethel has a good young coach and has had several excellent results this year. They lost narrowly to nationally-ranked Wartburg College and have been in some tightly-contested games within our league. Last game they lost a close one to Hamline, who is a much-improved team from last year. The Royals have played a tough non-conference schedule and their record doesn't necessarily display their true competitiveness this season.

Playing away from home is never easy and this will not be an exception. Two years ago we came out on top in a fiercely fought contest, and last year at home, Bethel certainly gave us a game. On the positive side, the lads are playing well at the moment. Hopefully, we can come out on the front-foot for this game. This is a 3:30 p.m. kick-off due to the time of year and with the season being so short, we have to seize every opportunity and enjoy the moment. This is now the business end of the season, with something tangible to play for. This is what we have worked so hard towards and we are really looking forward to the game.
