Setting The Scene... The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will travel to Morris, Minn., on Saturday, Nov. 23rd for a non-conference match up with the University of Minnesota-Morris. The Gusties enter the contest winners in each of their first three games this season, the latest of which was an 80-63 victory over Bethany Lutheran on Tuesday, Nov. 19th. The Cougars come into Saturday with a record of 2-1 on the year after two straight wins over Trinity Bible College (84-63) and Saint John's University (96-87). Saturday's opening tip is set for 3:00 p.m., following the women's game.

Series Snapshot... Saturday afternoon's contest marks just the seventh meeting between Gustavus and UM-Morris on the hardwood. With a record of 3-3 for each team, the alltime series is even. However, the Gusties have won each of the last two meetings by considerable margins, winning 91-66 and 91-58 in 2005 and 2006, respectively.

Last Time They Met... The last time these two teams met was in 2006 when the Gusties came away with a 91-58 win in St. Peter. The Gusties jumped out to a 16-point halftime lead and would never look back in the 33-point win. Gustavus placed five players in double-figure scoring, led by Trevor Wittwer with 14 points. Andrew Olson, Phil Sowden, and Jesse Van Sickle pitched in 12 points each, while Kane Sivesind notched a doubledouble with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 105th Season... The 2013-14 season represents the 105th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1380-95, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 910-552. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and also has participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season, which was also Gustavus's last MIAC title.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ... KNUJ AM 860 out of New Ulm, Minnesota will once again broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games. The voice of the Golden Gusties Tom Wheeler will handle the playby-play duties for the eighth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the KNUJ broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860 and KRDS 95.5 or on the Internet through the Gustavus Athletics website. Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff... Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 24th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 20 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 437 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history. His .695 winning percentage ranks sixth on the all-time list.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood begins his first season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for Head Coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. After graduation, Justin made his way to the east coast, where

he worked for Jostens and volunteered as both a high school and college coach in Boston, Mass.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruting, Jeff Fish begins his fifth season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Captains Log: 2013-14... As is tradition, captains are selected every year to serve as leaders of their team. This year, three players were given the honor of serving as captain. The Gusties named senior Jordan Dick and juniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position. Tapp and Feddersen are the first juniors to do so in the last five years.

Fountain Of Youth... With just one senior and three juniors who see significant playing time, numerous sophomores and freshmen will be asked to contribute throughout the course of the 2013-14 season. The Gusties return nine letterwinners after losing six from a year ago. However, those six letterwinners lost accounted for over 65 percent of Gustavus's scoring last year, meaning the Gusties will lean on their youth to produce. Isaac Tapp and Jordan Dick are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 7.7 and 7.4 points per game, respectively.

Home Grown... The 2013-14 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 15 players and all but one are natives of Minnesota. The lone player to hail from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes is sophomore post Scott Mulder, who comes to St. Peter from Sioux Falls, South Dakota. Mulder is one of just eight players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

Last Time Out... In their last game, the Gusties came away with an 80-63 victory over Bethany Lutheran College on Tuesday, Nov. 19th, in Mankato. Gustavus opened the contest with a 17-4 run and would never look back on the way to the 17-point victory. For the game, the Gusties shot 58.2 percent (32-55) from the floor, including a 52.9 percent (9-17) mark from three point range.

Brody Ziegler was the game's leading scorer with a career-high 20 points on 8 of 11 shooting. Jordan Dick followed with 14 points, including four three-pointers. Chris Narum registered a career-high 13 points off the bench with four treys of his own. Martin Feddersen, although only scoring three points on the night, registered a game-high nine assists to go along with a team-high five rebounds.

About The Cougars... UM-Morris is coming in off of consecutive wins over Trinity Bible College (84-63) and Saint John's University (96-87) in its last two contests. In their latest win over Saint John's, the Cougars saw six players in double-figures in the scoring column, led by Cody Emrick. Emrick made 6 of 9 field goals on the

night, including 3 of 5 from downtown and 10 of 12 from the free throw line. Tyler Pendleton followed with 20 points on 5 of 7 shooting from deep and 5 of 5 at the line, while RJ Dean added 12 points, six rebounds, and six assists. Neil Helgeson chipped in 11 points off the bench, and Brendon Foss and Kevin Heysee added 10 each.

For the season, the Cougars are led by four players averaging double-figures. Pendleton leads the way with a 14.3 points per game average. Emrick comes next averaging 11.3, while Dean and Foss each average 10.3. Foss is also the team's leading rebounder, pulling down 6.3 boards per game.

As a team, UM-Morris is averaging 73.3 points per game and is shooting 47.4 percent (72-152) from the field, including a 43.4 percent (23-53) clip from three-point range. Defensively, the Cougars are allowing 71.3 points per game and giving up 47.6 percent shooting from the field.

Martin The Maestro... Although senior captain Martin Feddersen is averaging just 4.7 points per game, he has orchestrated the Gustavus offense with his willingness to share the ball and create opportunities for others. Through the first three games, Feddersen has accumulated 27 assists (9.0 apg), which currently leads the MIAC. The Winona, Minn., product has led the team in assists in all three games so far, and has also led the team in rebounds and steals on two occasions. He has pulled down 18 rebounds (6.0 rbg) and has three steals (1.0 spg).

Dick's Time To Shine... As the lone senior on this year's squad, Jordan Dick has his time to shine in the 2013-14 season. So far, he has not disappointed. Dick has scored in double-figures in all three games to start the season, including a career-high 20 points against Buena Vista on Nov. 16th. He is currently averaging 16.0 points and 4.3 rebounds per game, thanks in large part to a career-high eight rebounds on opening night agaisnt Simpson. To top it all off, Dick is shooting a blistering 62.1 percent (18-29) from the field.

Fast Start... With a 3-0 start this season, the Gusties are off to a fast start. The last time a Gustavus team began the year 3-0 was in the 2005-06 season when the Gusties rattled off five straight victories to open the season. That same year was the last time the Gustie men opened the year with three-straight 80-point performances, which they have done again this year.

Gustavus is also off to a fast start shooting the ball. The Gusties lead the MIAC in both field goal percentage and three-point field goal percentage with marks of 57.7 percent (97-168) and 53.3 percent (24-45), respectively. On the other end of the floor, Gustavus has held its opponents to just 40.7 percent (68-167) from the field and 29.0 percent (20-69) from three, which rank first and third in the league, respectively.

Closing Out November... Saturday's contest marks the final game in the month of November for the Gusties. With its next game on Wednesday, Dec. 4th, Gustavus will get a bit of a break from the bright lights before embarking on the grueling MIAC schedule. In the last 10 years, the Gusties have finished the opening month of the season unbeaten just once. Not surprisingly, it was the 2005-06 team that did so. However, after racing out of the gate, the '05-06 team finished the season 19-8 overall and 13-7 in conference play to finish fourth in the league standings.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 24th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

Last season, Hanson led the Gusties an overall record of 13-11 and an MIAC mark of 10-9. Gustavus missed the MIAC Playoffs for just the first time in 12 years and only seventh time in Coach Hanson's tenure.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 438-196 overall record at Gustavus, including a 329-130 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 19 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occassions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 27 players who have garnered 47 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.


