SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team will take on the Pipers of Hamline University in a home/home series this weekend.

The Gusties and Pipers will first square off at 7:05 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 22 at Don Roberts Ice Rink. The two squads will then cap the weekend with a 7:05 p.m. game at Oscar Johnson Arena on Saturday, Nov. 23.

Gustavus enters weekend with an overall record of 3-3-0 and an MIAC mark of 1-1-0. The Gusties kicked off their MIAC schedule last weekend with a split at home against Concordia. Gustavus fell 3-1 on Friday night, yet rebounded with a 3-1 win on Saturday afternoon.

Hamline will attempt to get its season on track this weekend after going 0-5-1 over its first six games. The Pipers head into MIAC play coming off back-to-back losses to WIAC opponents UW-Eau Claire (6-1) and UW-Superior (4-0) last weekend at Oscar Johnson Arena.

GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 72ND SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY

The Gustavus men's hockey team is currently in its 72nd season of existence. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 836-614-64 overall and 552-422-41 in the MIAC. Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the on-campus fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF

Head Coach Brett Petersen is in his 14th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 185-144-28 overall record in his 13-plus seasons at Gustavus. His 185 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10. Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey standout David Martinson is in his second season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate and one of the most decorated hockey players to don a three crowned sweater, Martinson is a native of St. Louis Park, Minn. After being named the MIAC Player of the Year and earning All-America honors twice during his playing career, Martinson continued his education at the Bowling Green State University where he served as a graduate assistant for the men's hockey team. In the fall of 2012, David received his masters of education in sport administration.

HOCKEY ALUM ENTERS THE HALL IN 2013

Former Gustavus men's hockey player Dave Newcomer was inducted into the Gustavus Athletics Hall of Fame on Nov. 2. A keen leader and lanky center, Newcomer brought finesse and style to one of the most prolific scoring lines in Gustavus men's hockey history from 1987 to 1991. Newcomer carved up defenses and gave opposing goaltenders nightmares with his quick hands, stick handling, and pin-point accuracy. Paired with Scott Reddy '91 and Mike Gempeler '91, the "Newcomer-Gempeler-Reddy line" skated together for four seasons, scoring a combined 500 points (212 goals, 288 assists). Newcomer ranks sixth in program history in points with 177, ninth in goals with 74 and third in assists with 103. He garnered all-conference accolades three times (1989, 1990, 1991) including being named the MIAC Player-of-the-Year in 1991. He was also selected to the American Hockey Coaches Association All-America Second Team in 1991. Newcomer's durability allowed him to play in all 118 games of his career, which ranks second in Golden Gustie history.

HAMLINE HEAD COACH DOC DELCASTILLO

Doc DelCastillo is in his third season as the Head Coach of the Hamline men's hockey program. DelCastillo played four seasons at St. Cloud State, where he received his bachelors' degree. Later, he earned his master's in sports management at SCSU. Prior to taking the job at Hamline, DelCastillo coached the Blizzard where he posted a 103-56-17 regular season record, including the franchise's first-ever Central Division title in 2010-11. AROUND THE GLOBE

Gustavus's 2013-14 roster features 28 players from seven different states and two different countries other than the United States of America. Within the United States, Minnesota (19), California (1), Florida (1), Massachusetts (1), North Dakota (1), Oklahoma (1), and Vermont (1) are represented by 25 players. Outside the U.S., the Canadian province of British Columbia is home to both Sam Smith (Jr., Vancouver, B.C.) and Patrick Sullivan (Sr., Kelowna, B.C.), while Sweden is home to Gustavu Bengtson (Sr., Sollentuna, Sweden).

PRIOR EXPERIENCE

Brett Petersen's 2013-14 Gustie squad consists of 26 players with prior junior hockey experience. Those 26 players come from 23 different junior hockey teams that hail from nine different leagues. Nine of Gustavus's players are alumni of the North American Hockey League, four played in the Eastern Junior Hockey League, and three played in the Superior International Junior Hockey League. The United States Hockey League (2), Western States Hockey League (2), North American Tier III Hockey League (1), British Columbia Hockey League (1), Central Canada Hockey League (1), and the Minnesota Junior Hockey League (1) make up the rest of the leagues represented on Gustavus's roster. Gustavus seniors Joey Olson (Warroad, Minn.) and Adam Smyth (Burnsville, Minn.) are the only two players on this year's team to make the jump straight from high school to the collegiate ranks.

CAPTAIN'S LOG: 2013-14

In the 71 year history of Gustavus men's hockey, 85 players have earned the right to wear a "C" on their chest for the Black and Gold. Senior Corey Leivermann (North Mankato, Minn.) and junior Jack Walsh (Mahtomedi, Minn.) serve as captains of this year's team, becoming the 86th and 87th in the history of the program.

LETTERWINNERS AND FRESH FACES

Brett Petersen returned 15 letterwinners from last year's team that went 17-8-3 overall (9-5-2 MIAC) and advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship. To go along with his 15 returning letterwinners, coach Petersen also welcomes 11 new players to the program. Nine of the fresh faces are freshman while the other two are transfers from schools in the WIAC. This year's freshman class includes Jared Docken (Northfield, Minn.), Drew Apsinwall (Maple Grove, Minn.), Tony Paulson (Maple Grove, Minn.), Sam Akins (Stowe, Vt.), Sam Majka (Wayzata, Minn.), Blake Barnes (Broken Arrow, Okla.), Ross Kovacs (Dickinson, N.D.), Joncarlo Westerlund (Baudette, Minn.), and Erik Johnson (Rice, Minn.). Gavin Tufte is a transfer from UW-Stout, and Alec Austin is a transfer from UW-Superior.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND

The Gustavus men's hockey was able to salvage a split at home in its opening series of MIAC play last weekend against Concordia. After suffering a 3-1 loss on Friday night, the Gusties bounced back with a 3-1 win on Saturday afternoon to help them get back to a .500 record overall.

In Friday night's game, Concordia used goals in the first and second periods to go up 2-0 heading into the third. Corey Leivermann was able to cut the lead to 2-1 at the 5:04 of the third, but Concordia closed the door on any comeback hopes with a power play goal at 12:33 to go up 3-1.

Cobber goaltender Chris Neamonitis was just too good on Friday night, stopping 40-of-41 shots on the way to the two-goal victory. Gustie netminder John McLean made 20 saves in the loss, 14 of which came in the second period alone.

The Gusties turned things around on Saturday and were able to put the puck past Neamonitis early. Jared Docken scored to put Gustavus on top 1-0 at the 13:17 mark of the opening frame, and Jack Walsh scored on the power play to extend the lead to 2-0 later at the 18:47 mark. The Cobbers cut the lead to one (2-1) with a goal early in the third at 1:16, but Gustavus answered five minutes later with a goal by Cory Ellis at 6:30 to take back a two-goal advantage (3-1). McLean picked up the win in net after turning away 29 shots.

Gustavus outshot Concordia 41-23 on Friday night and 33-30 on Saturday. The Gusties went 1-for-7 on the power play and killed 3-of-4 penalties over the weekend.

GAME NOTES

THE SERIES

This weekend's games will be the 116th and 117th meetings between Gustavus and Hamline in men's hockey. Gustavus holds the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 80-25-5.

The Gusties and Pipers met three times over the course of the 2012-13 season. Gustavus defeated Hamline 2-0 in the season-opener at the MIAC Showcase in Blaine, then earned a sweep over the Pipers in their regular season series on Feb. 1-2. Gustavus took game one 7-4 on Friday in St. Paul before completing the four point weekend with a 4-2 win on Saturday in St. Peter.

SCOUTING THE PIPERS

The Hamline men's hockey team enters the opening weekend of its conference schedule seeking a win after starting off the 2013-14 with an 0-5-1 record. The Pipers were most recently in action last weekend with a pair of home games against WIAC opponents UW-Eau Claire and UW-Superior. The Pipers fell to No. 2 Eau Claire 6-1 on Friday, then were blanked 4-0 by UW-Superior on Saturday.

Hamline has struggled on both the offensive and defensive ends early on this season. The Pipers are scoring a league-low 1.5 goals per game, while allowing a league-high 5.33 goals per game.

Leading the team in scoring through six games is sophomore forward Kevin Novakovich who has three goals and three assists for six points. Sophomore forward Brandon Zurn and freshman forward Tyler Gonzales each have two goals, while junior defenseman Joe Rubbelke leads the squad in assists with five.

Sophomore Nick Heimer has done the majority of the goaltending thus far with 252:42 minutes under his belt. He enters the weekend with a goals against average of 4.51 and a save percentage of .840. Freshman John Sellie-Hanson was in net against UW-Superior on Saturday, suffering the loss after allowing four goals and making 25 saves. Sellie-Hanson comes in with a 5.88 goals against average and a .788 save percentage.

FIRST GOALS

A pair of Gusties recorded the first goals of their collegiate careers in Saturday afternoon's victory over Concordia last weekend. Rookie defenseman Jared Docken scored on a shot from the left point to give Gustavus a 1-0 lead in the first period, and junior forward Cory Ellis put away a rebound in front of the net in the third period to bring the score to a final at 3-1. Docken was the first Gustavus freshman to score a goal this season.

LEIVERMANN OFF TO A FAST START

Gustavus senior captain Corey Leivermann is off to a fast start with a league-best eight points off four goals and four assists. Leivermann has scored in all but one game this season and posted a career-high four points (2G, 2A) in the Nov. 8 loss to UW-Stevens Point. The local North Mankato product joined Gustavus halfway through last season and scored 10 point (2G, 8A) in 13 games. In 19 games in a Gustavus sweater, Leivermann has not recorded a point on the scoresheet just six times.

MOVEMBER OFF AND RUNNING

The Gustavus hockey team is currently in the midst of Movember, a global event that helps raise vital awareness and funds for men's health issues, specifically prostate and testicular cancer initiatives. Movember is the global men's health charity encouraging men to grow and women to support the Mo (moustache) for the 30 days of November. Through the power of the moustache, awareness and funds are raised for men's health to combat prostate and testicular cancer.

BY THE NUMBERS

8 - The league-high number of goals Gustavus has allowed in the third period this season. Defensively, Gustavus has allowed five goals in the first period, six in the second, and eight in the third.

9 - The amount of points senior Adam Smyth has scored against Hamline over his career at Gustavus. Smyth has played in eight games against the Pipers and has recorded three goals and six assists. The Burnsville product scored six points (2G, 4A) in the regular season series between the two teams last year.

2.33 - The scoring average of the Gusties in their three wins this season. In their three losses, Gustavus actually has a higher scoring average at 2.67 goals per game.

Brett Petersen is currently in his 14th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team.

Despite another late-season surge that saw the Gustavus men's hockey team go 10-2-2 after the holiday break, the Gusties missed out on a trip to the NCAA Tournament after falling to Saint John's 3-2 in the MIAC Playoff Championship. Gustavus, who began the year 0-4-0 in the MIAC, earned the fourth seed in the MIAC Playoffs after a late push in conference play over January and February. In the conference tournament, the Gusties defeated St. Olaf (3-2) in the first round and St. Thomas (1-0) in the semifinals to earn a trip to the championship game for the fourth time in the last five seasons. Petersen's club finished 17-8-3 overall and 9-5-2 in the MIAC.

In his 13-plus year tenure behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 185-144-28 overall record. His 183 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 16 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, seven All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 113-77-20 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 12 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of five times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.
