SETTING THE SCENE

• The Gustavus Adolphus women's basketball team will face the Oles of St. Olaf College in a critical Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletics Conference tilt on Saturday, Feb. 1 at Gus Young Court. Gustavus sits in seventh place in the conference standings at 9-8 overall and 6-8 in the MIAC. St. Olaf is in fifth place at 11-6 overall and 9-5 in the MIAC.

LAST TIME OUT

• The Gustavus women's basketball team enters the weekend coming off a 61-51 victory over Augsburg in its last time out on Wednesday night at Gus Young Court. The Gusties jumped out to a 10 point halftime lead and led by as many as 12 points with just under 10 minutes to play in the second half. The Auggies cut the lead to five (48-43) at the 7:50 mark, but Gustavus clamped down on defense in the final five minutes and outscored Augsburg 8-4 to hold on for the win.

Gustavus was led in scoring by Rachelle Blaschko and Lindsey Johnson who scored 13 and 12 points, respectively. Blaschko went 5-for-9 from the field and 3-for-6 from three-point range, while Johnson went 4-for-8 from the field and 4-for-5 at the free throw line. Gustavus shot 42.6-percent from the floor and outrebounded the Auggies 40-23, which included a 14-5 advantage on the offensive glass.

SERIES HISTORY

• Saturday's game will be the 70th meeting between Gustavus and St. Olaf in women's basketball. Gustavus holds the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 45-24. Gustavus has won 13 straight games against St. Olaf on Gus Young Court. St. Olaf's last victory in St. Peter came on Feb. 6, 1999 when the Oles came out victorious 84-79 in a barn-burner.

AT LAST THEY MET

• St. Olaf took the opening game of the season series by the score of 68-64 back on Jan. 4. The Oles

led by five points at halftime and held Gustavus to just 32.4-percent shooting in the second half. The Gusties managed to cut the lead to three points (67-63) with :20 seconds left in the game yet couldn't close the gap.

Britta Rinke led Gustavus with her best overall performance of the season, scoring 28 points (11-21 FG, 6-7 FT) and bringing down 11 rebounds. St. Olaf was led by Emily Wahlberg who scored 17 points (6-8 FG, 2-2 3PT, 3-5 FT) and brought down eight rebounds. Gustavus shot 35.4-percent from the field, while St. Olaf shot 41-percent.

SCOUTING THE OLES

• After defeating Gustavus to kick off January, the St. Olaf women's basketball team went on a three-game slide. The Oles got back on track with five straight wins, yet suffered a 76-52 loss to Saint Mary's in their last outing on Wednesday in Winona. The Cardinals cruised to a 45-20 lead at halftime and didn't look back. St. Olaf shot 32.7-percent from the field and turned the ball over 20 times.

Kim Cerjan led St. Olaf in scoring against the Cardinals with 13 points. Cerjan has paced the Oles' scoring effort all season, entering the weekend averaging 14.2 points per game and shooting 36.5-percent from the floor. Elise Raney is next in line averaging 10.6 points, 7.1 rebounds and shooting 48.1-percent from the field.

St. Olaf is averaging 61.6 points per game (9th/MIAC) and is shooting 38.5-percent from the field (6th/MIAC). The Oles are the top rebounding team in the league, averaging 14.1 offensive rebounds and 29.2 defensive rebounds for an average of 43.3 rebounds per game. St. Olaf is allowing 62.1 points defensively (6th/MIAC) and limiting its opponents to 34.6-percent shooting from the field (2nd/MIAC).

NEWS AND NOTES

So Long January - Gustavus waves goodbye to the month of January and will kick off February with Saturday's game against St. Olaf. The Gusties went 6-4 in January and averaged 65.2 points per game and shot 41.2-percent from the field. Defensively, Gustavus allowed 65.9 points and held its opponents to 42.4-percent shooting from the field. Karina Schroeder recorded three double-doubles in the month and was Gustavus's leading scorer. She averaged 13.5 points, 9.7 rebounds, and shot 51-percent from the floor.

Dime Deliverers - This weekend's game will feature three of the top four ball contributors in the MIAC. Rachelle Blaschko ranks second in the league with a total of 66 assists, St. Olaf's Lauren Gutierrez ranks third with 55, and Julia Dysthe ranks fourth with 52. Within league play, Blaschko averages 3.9 assists per game, while Dysthe averages 3.2, and Gutierrez averages 3.1.

BY THE NUMBERS

12.75 - The rebounding average of Karina Schroeder over the past four games. Schroeder has reached double-digit rebounds eight times this season. She currently ranks third in the league in both total rebounds (161) and rebounds per game (9.5).

- **39 -** The number of minutes logged by Rachelle Blaschko in Wednesday night's win over Augsburg. Blaschko has played in a total of 567 minutes for an average of 33.4 minutes per game, which ranks second in the MIAC in both categories.
- **19.2** The average number of turnovers committed by St. Olaf per game. The Oles rank 11th in the MIAC in turnovers per game and 12th in forced turnovers per game (13.3).
- **6.2 -** The number of three-pointers St. Olaf averages per game. The Oles are the fourth-best three-point shooting team in the league at 32.3-percent. Kim Cerjan ranks third in total three-pointers with 32 and is shooting 32.1-percent from beyond the arc.
- **11.3** The scoring average of Lindsey Johnson over the past four games. Johnson has scored in double-figures three of the last four contests, which included a season-high 18-point performance in the overtime loss to Concordia on Jan. 25. Johnson has increased her season average to 7.2 points per game following her recent scoring surge.

Laurie Kelly will begin her second season as the head coach of the Gustavus women's basketball team in 2013-14. Kelly, a 1993 graduate of the University of St. Thomas with a major in speech communications, comes to Gustavus from Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, where she directed the Division I Lumberjacks for nine seasons.

Under Kelly's direction, the 2012-13 Gusties went 14-8 in the MIAC, finishing sixth in the conference standings. In the team's 13th appearance in the MIAC Playoffs, Gustavus was eliminated in the first round by Saint Mary's 76-69. The Gusties finished 15-11 overall, reaching the 15-win mark for the eighth consecutive season. Senior Abby Rothenbuehler (North Mankato, Minn.) and first-year Karina Schroeder (Lake Crystal, Minn.) were featured in the MIAC's Post-Season Awards. Rothenbuehler earned a spot on the All-Conference Team, while Schroeder was placed on the All-Rookie Team. Rothenbuehler scored a career-best 327 points to lead Gustavus with a 12.6 points per game scoring average. She shot 48.3-percent from the field and brought down a total of 213 rebounds (8.2 rpg). Rothenbuehler finishes her career the program's all-time leader in blocked shots with 121.



A Rochester, Minnesota, native, Kelly made a quick ascent through the Division II and I coaching ranks after a record setting Division III playing career at the University of St. Thomas in the early `90s. In the past nine years at Northern Arizona, she has compiled the most wins in the program's history (117), while also directing the team to its first-ever Big Sky Conference tournament title and NCAA tournament bid in the 2005-06 season. During Kelly's tenure, the Lumberjacks advanced to the Big Sky tournament six times with two appearances in the championship game (2006, 2007), and her teams have registered two of the three 20-win seasons in the program's history.

In addition to quality on the floor, her squads have also been strong in the classroom, with four players earning CoSIDA Academic All-District honors including one Academic All-American. The Lumberjacks were recognized in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Academic Honor Roll six times, with two Top Ten national rankings. Following the 2012-13 season, the Gustavus women's basketball team achieved a significant milestone when the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced its Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll following the year. Making their 15th appearance on the NCAA Division III honor roll, the Gusties were recognized as the team with the top cumulative grade point average in country at a 3.600 – a first in the program's history.

Prior to her position at Northern Arizona, Kelly coached at Binghamton University in New York and built the Bearcats into one of the top Division II programs in the country before helping the institution transition to a Division I program in 2001-02. In that first year of Division I competition, Kelly directed the team to a 19-9 record and a second-place finish in the America East Conference. During her five years at Binghamton, Kelly compiled a record of 94-22, including a mark of 75-13 in the program's final three years at the Division II level, and her squads won New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) titles in 1999 and 2000 and Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference (ECAC) titles in 2000 and 2001. She was named ECAC Coach of the Year in 2000 and New York State Coach of the Year in 2002. Kelly started her collegiate coaching career as the graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato from 1996 to 1998. While she was at Minnesota State, Mankato she earned a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in sports administration.

Before her success in the coaching ranks, Laurie Trow Kelly was a standout player at the University of St. Thomas from 1989 to 1993 and is recognized by many as one of the greatest players in NCAA Division III history. A gifted athlete, the 6-I Kelly scored 2,607 points and pulled down 1,204 rebounds in four years, earning Kodak All-America honors three consecutive seasons. In her senior season (1992-93), Kelly was voted National Player of the Year by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association after averaging more than 26 points per game. She set 22 conference and 24 school records, was conference MVP three times and was also named Midwest Sports Channel NCAA Division III Women's Athlete of the Year. In January of 2006, Kelly was one of five players selected to the NCAA Division III 25th Anniversary Team.

Laurie Kelly is the ninth head coach in the 44-year history of the Gustavus women's basketball program. Heading into the 2013-14 season, the Gusties have compiled an all-time record of 618-422 (.594), winning two Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championships and making five NCAA tournament appearances.

In addition to her coaching duties, Kelly will serve as the coordinator of the Gustavus Health Promotion program (GHP). The Gustavus Health Promotion program offers employees at Gustavus a variety of educational opportunities, assessment tools, and physical activity experiences so that they can achieve and maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Kelly lives in St. Peter with and her husband, Matt, and their two daughters, Morgan and Madison.
