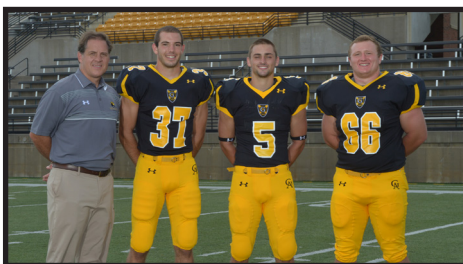
GUSTIES TAKE TO GRIDIRON FOR 98TH SEASON...

The Gustavus football team began its 98th season today at Lloyd Hollingsworth Field on Saturday, Sept. 6. Over the previous 97 years, the Gusties have compiled a record of 474-339-21, including a record of 219-123-8 in St. Peter. With 22 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) championships, Gustavus has claimed the second-most league titles in the 94-year history of the conference. Only Saint John's (31) has claimed more MIAC championships.

FOLLOW THE GUSTIES ON KNUJ...KNUJ

AM 860 out of New Ulm, Minnesota, will once again broadcast all ten Gustavus regular season football games. The voice of the Golden Gusties Tom Wheeler will handle the play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Wheeler will once again be joined by 1984 Gustavus graduate and former Gustie football player Ken Ericson on the live call of this year's games. Fans can listen to the KNUJ broadcasts on the Internet through the Gustavus Athletics website. New this season, Gustavus will provide a high definition video stream of all home games for viewing on your computer, tablet, or smart phone through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Calling All Captains... Of over 5,000 student-athletes who have played football for Gustavus in the 98-year history of the program, only 191 have earned the privilege to serve as team captain. Peter Haugen's captains this season include seniors Jake Forcier, Michael Hintze, and Zach Vine.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP... In what has become a trend of Head Coach Peter Haugen's tenure, the 2014 Gustavus football roster once again features a great deal of senior leadership. With 21 seniors on this year's squad, the Gustavus roster features the fifth-most seniors on any Gustie football team since the turn of the century. The 2003 (28), 2002 (26), 2011 (23), and 2013 (22) teams are the only four squads during that span to have more or as many seniors wearing Black and Gold. This year's senior class features five defensive backs, six defensive lineman, three kickers, two wide receivers, two linebackers, one offensive lineman, and one tight end.

GUSTIE FOOTBALL AROUND THE GLOBE...

The 2014 Gustavus football team features a total of 111 players from ten different states and, for the third straight year, a second country outside the United States. Of those 111 players, 91 claim Minnesota as their native state. Four players call Illinois home, three hail from Kansas, and one player each from California, Colorado, Florida, Hawaii, Iowa, South Dakota, Wisconsin, and Texas represents the Stars and Stripes. Mexico once again makes its presence felt on this year's roster as it is the homeland of five Gusties, all of whom hail from Cancun.

NOTES

THE SERIES... Saturday's game will be the first ever meeting between the Gustavus and Lake Forest football programs. In fact, of the 11 institutions in the Midwest Conference, Gustavus has only faced St. Norbert College. The Gusties are 6-2 against the Green Knights with the last meeting coming in 1949. Macalester College only recently joined the MWC for football beginning this season. The Gusties hold an all-time mark of 49-17-3 against the Scots.

MEET THE HEAD COACHES... Head Coach Peter Haugen is at the beginning of his sixth season at the helm of the Gustavus football program. Haugen has a combined record of 20-31 in his first five-plus seasons. A graduate of Bethel University, Haugen was the head coach at Washburn High School in Minneapolis prior to coming to Gustavus.

The 2014 season will be the sixth for Lake Forest College's head coach Jim Catanzaro, who will also serve as the team's defensive coordinator for the ninth straight year. Catanzaro came to Lake Forest from NCAA Division II Wingate University, where he was the defensive line coach for three seasons. Prior to his time at Wingate, Catanzaro served as the defensive line coach, recruiting coordinator, and head strength coach for three seasons at Glenville State College. Catanzaro graduated from Greenville College where he started every game of his career and earned all-conference honors on both sides of the ball.

HENDRICKS HONORED BY MIAC... For his standout performance on Saturday in the Gustavus football team's season-opening 44-17 win over Crown College, junior quarterback Mitch Hendricks (Laporte, Minn.) was honored by the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference as the Offensive Player-of-the-Week. With the time to sit in the pocket thanks to an offensive line that allowed little to no backfield pressure, Hendricks completed 23 of his 28 passes for a total of 281 yards to go along with five touchdowns. His 23 completions, 82.1-percent completion percentage, 281 yards, and five throwing touchdowns were the top marks within their respective statistical categories amongst MIAC quarterbacks in the opening weekend of the 2014 season.

His five touchdown passes rank second in school history and are the most since Jordan Becker '10 threw for five touchdowns against Pacific Lutheran on Oct. 2009. Jordan Stolp '08 also threw for five touchdowns against Augsburg on Oct. 8, 2005, while Bob Southworth '99

holds the school-record with six against Hamline on Oct. 31, 1998. With his added rushing touchdown, Hendricks is the first Gustavus player to account for six touchdowns in a game since Southworth's aerial display against the Pipers in 1998. He is also the first Gustavus quarterback to earn MIAC Athlete-of-the-Week honors since Oct. 12, 2009 when Jordan Becker won the award.

BIG DAY FOR MATT BOYCE... Junior wide receiver Matt Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.) turned in a career day in Gustavus's season-opener against Crown. Boyce was Hendrick's top target, catching nine passes for a career-high 151 yards to go along with three touchdown receptions. All three of his touchdown grabs, which came from 28 yards, 37 yards, and 18 yards out, occurred in the first half.

Saturday was the second time Boyce's career that he tallied 150 or more yards receiving in a game. Last season against St. Olaf, the Minnetonka High School product caught 13 passes for 150 yards. Boyce is also the first Gustavus receiver to record three touchdown receptions since Ryan Hoag '03 did so against Augsburg on Sept. 28, 2002. Rich Ryan '77 holds the school-record for touchdown receptions in a game with four against Washington University (St. Louis) in 1976.

AERIAL DEFENSE... The Crown passing game found itself in dire straights against a veteran Gustavus secondary last weekend. The Gusties limited the Storm to just 71 yards passing as quarterback, Brandon McCormick was just 11-for-25 with one interception and one touchdown. It is the lowest passing yards total by an opponent of Gustavus since Carleton was limited to just 17 yards on Nov. 12, 2011.

FAST START... With 30 points by halftime and 17 of those points coming in the second quarter, the Gusties will hope the trend of getting off to a fast start continues the remainder of the season. Of Gustavus's 300 total points in 2013, 170 were scored in the first half. The second was Gustavus's top scoring quarter a year ago with an average of 11.5 points coming out of the second frame.

MULTIFACETED THREAT... Whether he's in the slot, backfield, returning kicks, or handling punts, junior transfer Gabriel Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.) proved himself to be a multifaceted threat in his first game in Black and Gold last Saturday. Boyce caught six passes for 65 yards (10.8 ypc) to go along with a 13-yard touchdown reception that came early in the third quarter. Along with this receiving stats, Boyce returned four punts for a total of 65

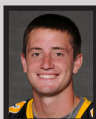

Hendricks accounted for six total touchdowns in Saturday's 44-17 win over Crown while completing more than 80 percent of his passes and nearly reaching 300 yards through the air.

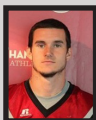

MIAC Special Teams Player-of-the-Week

Forrest Coughlin, Hamline

Heading into the 2014 season, Hamline Head Football Coach Chad Rogosheske said his team was hoping for more consistency and contributions in the kicking game. So far, so good, as junior kicker Forrest Coughlin (Maple Lake, Minn.) got off to a great start in Saturday night's 37-6 win on the road at UM-Morris. Coughlin didn't miss a PAT or field goal all night as he contributed seven points to the Piper victory.



yards and one kickoff for 30 yards. Of his 65 punt return yards, 52 yards came on one return late in the first quarter. The run-back set up Gustavus's second touchdown of the afternoon and is the longest punt return since Ethan Armstrong '09 returned a punt back 52 yards against Hamline on Sept. 22, 2007. The longest punt return by a Gustie since the turn of the century was a 79-yarder by Loren Havemeier against Hamline on Oct. 25, 2003. Gabriel Boyce's 16.3-yard punt return average currently ranks 18th in the country.

BROTHERLY LOVE...For the first time since the 1946 season, the Gustavus football team took the field last Saturday with a roster that features three brothers in senior Anthony Boyce and his younger siblings Gabriel and Matt of Excelsior, Minnesota. Two brothers have donned winged helmets on numerous occasions in the previous 98 years, but not since Leif Langsjoen '47, Sven Langsjoen '48, and Ralph Langsjoen '50 helped the 1946 Gusties win the MIAC Championship have three siblings played together. In yet another rare occurrence relating to the family, this season's squad also features two sets of twins. Along with Gabriel and Matt, Luke and Zack Martinez of Lenexa, Kansas settle in for their third season on the team. To go along with two sets of twins, brothers Kyler (Sr.) and Riley (So.) Trnka of Waconia will grace the field together, and three other current Gusties have had brothers on the team in the past including junior Derek Wilking (Carl '08, Blake '12) of Nicollet, sophomore Isaac Kotila (Jade '11) of Buffalo, and freshman Nick Vanek (Christian '10) of Prior Lake.

RED ZONE SCORING...The Gustavus offense was a perfect 5-for-5 in red zone scoring against Crown. Of the team's five red zone scores, four were touchdowns and the other was a 26-yard field goal by Thomas Schleusener. The Foresters were 2-for-2 in the red zone with a touchdown and a 37-yard field goal.

SCOUTING LAKE FOREST...The Lake Forest football team will also seek a 2-0 start to the year after a 20-14 win over Wisconsin Lutheran last Saturday at Raabe Stadium in Milwaukee. The Foresters scored 20 unanswered points over the course of three quarters to jump out to a 20-0 lead. Wisconsin Lutheran answered with two fourth quarter touchdowns to cut the lead to 20-14, yet couldn't come up with a game-winning drive on its final possession of the game.

Forester quarterback Anthoney Prestly went 11-for-24 for 181 yards with one touchdown and one interception through the air. His top target in the passing game was Willie McIntyre who made four catches for 75 yards with one touchdown. Prestly

also finished second on the team in rushing with 22 yards on 13 carries (2.5 ypc) to go along with a rushing touchdown. Charlie Quinn led the ground game with 48 yards on 15 carries (3.2 ypc), while Sam Mulford ran 12 times for 33 yards (2.8 ypc).

Special teams played a key role in Lake Forest's season-opening win as Jon Gurchak handled all the kicking duties. Gurchak went 2-for-2 in field goals from 37 and 45 yards out, respectively, punted eight times for 298 yards (37.2 avg.), and downed two punts inside the 20-yard-line.

As a team, Lake Forest totaled 298 yards of offense (181 pass, 115 rush), was 38-percent on third down, and won the time of possession battle handily 37:03-to-22:57.

Defensively, the Foresters gave up 367 yards of total offense (307 pass, 60 rush). They sacked the opposing quarterback three times, picked off two passes, and recovered a fumble.

Defensive back Chris Rantis led the defense with nine solo tackles and an interception. Fellow defensive back Pat Clark finished with seven tackles (5 solo), an interception and the team's lone fumble recovery.

His five passing touchdowns (5) rank second, passing efficiency (219.1) ranks fifth, and points responsible for (36) lead the nation alongside Lemar Johnson of Morrisville State who threw for six touchdowns opening weekend.

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is entering his sixth year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College.

The Gustavus football team capped the most successful season during head Coach Peter Haugen's tenure with an overall record of 6-4 and an MIAC mark of 4-4. Gustavus picked up signature wins over St. Olaf 45-19 on Homecoming in late-September and Saint John's in a double-overtime thriller 23-20 in early-November. Of Gustavus's four losses in 2013, three were by eight or fewer points. In the MIAC's post-season honors, first team all-conference recipients included senior running back Jeffrey Dubose (St. Paul, Minn.), senior center David Gschneidner (Edina, Minn.), and senior guard Lyle Opdahl (Norwood Young America, Minn.) on offense, and senior defensive tackle Donte Green (Minneapolis, Minn.), senior linebacker Joe Haas (Mission, Kan.), and junior cornerback Zach Dilger (South St. Paul, Minn.) on defense.

In five-plus seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 21-31 and an MIAC record of 14-26.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference this past year and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early 90s. In his senior year, he earned All-Conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 95-year history of Gustavus football. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 235 institutions) with a .580 winning percentage (473-339-21).

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 29 players who have received All-America honors, 13 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships. Most recently in 2014, senior cornerback Torey Asao was named a CoSIDA Academic All-America honoree.

St. Peter, Minn. – The Gustavus Adolphus football team ran away with a 44-17 victory over Crown College in its 2014 season-opener on Saturday afternoon at Hollingsworth Field. The Gusties jumped out to a 30-7 halftime lead and never looked back as their aerial attack proved to be too much for the Crown secondary. Quarterback Mitch Hendricks (Jr., Laporte, Minn.) was efficient throughout the afternoon, going 23-for-28 for 260 yards with five touchdowns. His top target was Matt Boyce (Jr., Excelsior, Minn.) who made nine catches for 146 yards and three touchdowns.

“The offense as a whole was clicking today,” said Hendricks. “The offensive line did a great job of keeping their defenders off me, the running backs ran the ball well after a bit of a slow start, and the receivers made plays. Matt made some big catches and Gabe and George were making guys miss all over the field. It’s a receiving corps that is young but explosive and that’s what we want to take advantage of. We executed what we needed to today and that was enough to put points on the board and pick up a win.”

After forcing Crown to punt on the opening possession of the game, Gustavus went to work on its first offensive drive of the season. Hendricks completed all five of his passes on a drive that totaled 60 yards on nine plays in 2:51. The series was capped off by a 12-yard touchdown pass from Hendricks to Harrison Feldkamp (Jr., Sibley, Iowa.) that put Gustavus on top 6-0. Mitch Hendricks threw for five touchdowns and 260 yards in efficient fashion.

Following another defensive stop, Hendricks continued to stay hot in the passing game. On third down and six from the Crown 28-yard-line, Hendricks connected with Matt Boyce for a 28-yard catch-and-run touchdown that put Gustavus on top 13-0 following the extra point with 4:44 remaining in the first quarter.

Crown got back into the game and generated some momentum at the end of the first quarter when DaiVon Poole (Fr., San Angelo, Texas) coughed up a fumble that was recovered by the Storm at the Gustavus 31-yard-line. Later at the 13:34 mark of the second quarter, Crown quarterback Brandon McCormick hit Ben Olson on a three-yard touchdown pass, cutting the lead to 13-7 after the extra point.

Gustavus responded to Crown’s score with a 26-yard field goal by Thomas Scheusener (Sr., Rapid City, S.D.) on its next possession, extending its lead to 16-7 with 11:09 left in the half.

Taking advantage of a short field less than three minutes later, Hendricks once again went up top to Matt Boyce for the second of their three touchdowns together. This time, the junior quarterback hit Boyce from 37 yards out to bring the score to 23-7.

Gustavus’s defense – which took away Crown’s passing game all afternoon – was rewarded with an interception with less than two minutes left in the opening half. On third and nine from the Crown 40-yard-line, Nick Frandsen (Sr., North Oaks, Minn.) picked off McCormick at the Gustavus 20 and returned the pick 54 yards to the Crown 26.

Sticking to the trend, Hendricks hit Matt Boyce on an 18-yard touchdown two plays later. The pair’s third touchdown put the Gusties on top 30-7 after the extra point.

The Storm drove down to the Gustavus 20-yard-line on their next drive and capped the first half with a 37-yard field goal by Chad Anenson.

At halftime, Gustavus was on top 30-10 and Mitch Hendricks was clicking. He was 16-for-20 for 194 yards with four touchdowns. Matt Boyce had made seven of his nine catches for 120 yards with three touchdowns.

The Gusties opened up with the ball in the second half and put together an eight-play, 68-yard scoring drive that lasted just 2:32. Hendricks capped the drive with a 13-yard touchdown pass to Gabriel Boyce (Jr., Excelsior, Minn.) that extended the lead to 37-10 after Scheusener’s extra point. Gabriel finished behind his twin brother with 66 yards on six catches.

After a bend-don’t-break defensive stand, Gustavus got the ball back at the 4:16 mark of the third. Running back Leeland Lauti (Fr., Ewa Beach, Hawaii) carried much of the load during the Gusties’ 11-play, 70-yard scoring drive. Of the 70 yards of field covered, Lauti ran for 60 yards of it and eventually capped the drive with an eight-yard touchdown at 14:14 of the fourth quarter. His score brought an end to Gustavus’s scoring for the afternoon and extended its lead to 44-10.

Overall, running back Luke Martinez (Jr., Lenexa, Kan.) led the Gusties on the ground with 62 yards on 11 carries (5.6 ypc). Lauti finished with a net of 59 yards after nine rushes (6.6 ypc).

Crown brought the score to a final (44-17) with :34 seconds to go in the game when Matt Michaud plunged across the goal line from two yards out.

To go along with Gustavus’s stellar passing display, its pass defense was just as impressive. Crown quarterback Brandon McCormick finished with just 72 yards through the air after going 11-for-25 with one interception and one touchdown.

Crown rushed for 167 yards for a total of 239 yards in the game. To go along with 270 yards through the air, Gustavus tallied 119 yards on the ground for a total of 389. The Gusties were 5-for-5 in red-zone scoring and picked up 24 first downs compared to Crown’s 16.

Leading a balanced defense was linebacker Zack Martinez (Jr., Lenexa, Kan.) who recorded a team-best eight tackles (four solo). Tyler Jakes (So., North Mankato, Minn.) finished behind him with seven (six solo).
