ABOUT THE MATCH

The Gustavus Adolphus men's soccer team will travel to Moorhead, Minnesota for a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference test against the Cobbers of Concordia College on Saturday, Sept. 20 at 3:00 p.m. The Gusties head into the weekend with an overall record of 7-2-0 and an MIAC mark of 1-0-0 following a 3-1 victory over Carleton College in their MIAC-opener on Wednesday afternoon in St. Peter. Concordia heads into conference-play seeking its first victory of the season with an overall record of 0-6-0. The Cobbers were in action this past weekend when they traveled to Colorado Springs, Colorado, where the team suffered a 2-1 loss to Centenary (La.) and a 6-0 defeat at the hands of Colorado College.

LAST TIME OUT

The Gustavus men's soccer team came out firing in its MIAC-opener, scoring three first half goals en route to a 3-1 victory over Carleton on Wednesday afternoon at the Gustie Soccer Field. The Gusties' red-hot start included first half goals by Patrick Leach (Jr., Sioux Falls, S.D.) in the 11th, Ryan Tollefsrud (Sr., Spearfish, S.D.) in the 32nd, and Zach Brown (Sr., Eau Claire, Wis.) in the 37th minutes. Carleton brought the game's scoring to a close with a goal in the 89th minute by Stephen Johnson. Of Carleton's 16 shots in the match, seven of them made it all the way to goalkeeper Braden Schmid (Sr., West Fargo, N.D.). Schmid was up to the on the challenge six shots on the way to his first complete-match win of the season.

SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's match will be the 28th meeting between Gustavus and Concordia in men's soccer. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 21-4-2. In last season's regular season matchup on Sept. 21 in St. Peter, Gustavus edged the Cobbers 1-0 thanks to a late goal by Sean Sendelbach '14 at the 83:49 mark. Brett Ylonen (Sr., Lake Elmo, Minn.) earned the complete-match shutout in a three-save effort.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Breakout Match For The Big Guy Junior defender Patrick Leach (Sioux Falls, S.D.) had a breakout match in the conference-opener on Wednesday afternoon. Leach who is listed at 6' 1" and every bit of 170 pounds his roster bio reads took full advantage of his stature when the Gusties were awarded a free kick in the 11th minute. On the high-arching free kick sent to the backside post by David Lilly (Sr., Maple Grove, Minn.), Leach was able to rise above the defenders around him and snap a header into the back of the net for the go-ahead goal. The goal was the Sioux Falls, S.D. product's first of his collegiate career. Later in the match, Leach sent a through ball upfield to a streaking Zach Brown (Sr., Eau Claire, Wis.) who found himself one-on-one with the Carleton goalkeeper. Brown put the ball away to give Gustavus a 3-0 lead and Leach his third point of the afternoon. Leach is Gustavus's first defender to post a multiple-point match since Jason Schwab (Jr., Stillwater, Minn.) did so with five points against Pacific Lutheran on Sept. 5.
- Tolly Going Streaking Senior forward Ryan Tollefsrud (Spearfish, S.D.) is currently in the midst of the longest scoring-streak of his Gustavus career. With a goal against the Knights on Wednesday a goal that turned out to be the game-winner Tolllefsrud extended his point-streak to five matches. Over that five match time-span, "Tolly" has scored four goals and added two assists for 10 points. He currently ranks second on the team in scoring with 13 points (5G, 3A) to go along with 11 shots on goal (2nd/team) and two game-winning goals (2nd/team).

MIDDLETON ON THE MATCH

If you want to say you are conference champions, you have to earn it inch by inch, lung busting run by lung busting run. You have to be mentally tough. It's not enough to talk about it, you have to do it. Is this team mentally tough enough? We'll see. The team undoubtedly has the physical talent, but that's only part of the package. You have to earn these victories with blood, sweat, toil and tears.

We have the added disadvantage of traveling five hours to the game the morning of the contest. And, Concordia is well-rested after a bye on Wednesday for the opening round of conference games. Although they may be tired and sore, we will see if the lads are up the challenge.

On the up side, we have some seriously talented players at this level. We've clicked for periods of the game rather than put a full game together. We've worked hard in practice to knock off the rough edges from our performances. We've challenged individuals to step up and take responsibility on their shoulders for the team success. We have to get the little details right, and every individual needs to pull his weight. Now we must start doing it every time we get onto the field for games and for practice. Nothing less will do.
