ABOUT THE MATCH

The Gustavus Adolphus men's soccer team will begin a new week with a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference test against the Cardinals of Saint Mary's University on Wednesday, Oct. 1 at 4:00 p.m. on the Gustie Soccer Field. At 8-3-0 overall and 2-1-0 in the MIAC, the Gusties are looking to get back on the winning track after suffering a heartbreaking 1-0 double-overtime loss to Saint John's University last weekend in St. Peter. At at 3-4-1 overall and 0-3-0 in the MIAC, Saint Mary's heads into the match also looking to get back in the win column following a 4-0 loss to the University of St. Thomas in its last outing on Saturday in Winona.

LAST TIME OUT

The Gustavus men's soccer team suffered a 1-0 defeat in heartbreaking, double-overtime fashion to Saint John's on Saturday afternoon at the Gustie Soccer Field. After 90 minutes of regulation and one 10-minute overtime session, Saint John's midfielder Alex Niederloh scored the sudden death goal at the 103:35 mark to hand the Black and Gold its first loss in five matches. Back in action for the first time in two matches, goalkeeper Brett Ylonen (Sr., Lake Elmo, Minn.) suffered the loss in a three-save effort. Kevin Lebahn earned the shutout win after coming up with a total of six saves.

SERIES HISTORY

Wednesday's match will be the 50th meeting between Gustavus and Saint Mary's in men's soccer. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 36-3-10. In last year's matchup between the two teams on Oct. 2 under the lights in Winona, Gustavus scored three unanswered goals and outshot the Cardinals 20-8 on its way to a 3-1 victory.

NEWS AND NOTES

• **All Streaks Must End** - The Gustavus men's soccer team saw its conference winning-streak come to an end at program-record 17 matches with Saturday's loss to Saint John's. Dating back to a 3-0 loss suffered to Carleton on Sept. 29, 2012, the Gusties capped that season with five straight MIAC wins, then went an undefeated 10-0-0 through its 2013 conference schedule before winning their first two league matches of 2014.

• **Golden Goal** - To get a sense of the grittiness, composure, and fitness of the recent Gustavus teams and its student-athletes, look no further than the club's record in overtime matches. During the Mike Middleton era, which began in 2010, Gustavus had never allowed a golden goal in overtime until Alex Niederloh's game-winner last Saturday. Excluding its two NCAA Tournament matches against Carleton and UW-Platteville that were decided in shootouts after 110 minutes of scoreless soccer in 2012, Gustavus now carries a record of 9-1-10 in the 20 overtime matches that Middleton has coached since stepping onto campus.

• **So Long September** - Wednesday's match signifies the beginning of a new month as the Gustavus men's soccer team regroup and refocuses after what was a grueling September schedule. The Gusties compiled a record of 6-2-0 in September, averaging 2.8 goals per game and boasting a goals against average of just 0.54 during the month. Under coach Middleton, Gustavus carries a winning percentage of .750 and an overall record of 31-9-4 in September.

MIDDLETON ON THE MATCH

I believe they will try to keep the game tight from the outset and come out with lots of energy. We'll probably see them in a 4-4-1-1 formation, which is well structured allowing them to get numbers behind the ball. We will need to be able to break them down if we are to be successful. That will not be an easy task.

We need to be on the front foot, be quick and confident in possession, and play with tempo. I'd like to see us get numbers forward and show a degree of patience in the final third. The philosophy is to play a style that the players enjoy: a style that is player-dominant, displays confidence in the player, and one that develops each player's game. That means we have to want to play and we have to want to be good in possession. The lads have to be brave enough to risk losing the ball, which will inevitably happen. However, they must try to keep doing the right things, even if everything doesn't necessarily go their way.

I must admit, I'm not a proponent of win at all costs. It may be a results-based business, but performance is the key. We have to try to perform the right way and in the right manner. We've done that a lot this year and that has been great to see. We have to strive for good performance and the results hopefully will take care of themselves. But, it does take courage. That's what I would like to see from this game: courage to hold the ball and try to play under pressure. Courage to test one's skills and put one's ability on the line. Courage to take the risk. Courage to have confidence in one's ability. And, courage from the coach to let his players perform. No problem there!

Its great to play games and match day is the best day of the week. This is another exciting game for the lads to look forward to.
