SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus Adolphus men's soccer team will conclude the home portion of its regular season schedule with a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference match against the Royals of Bethel University on Tuesday, Oct. 28 at 3:30 p.m. on the Gustie Soccer Field. With a spot in the 2014 MIAC Playoffs secure thanks to a 2-0 victory over Augsburg College in its last outing on Saturday in Minneapolis, Gustavus heads into the final week of the regular season sitting in a tie for third place in the conference standings with 16 points at 11-4-1 overall and 5-2-1 in the MIAC. Bethel sits in sixth place with 12 points at 8-9-0 overall and 4-5-0 in the MIAC.

SERIES HISTORY

Tuesday's match marks the 50th meeting between the Gustavus and Bethel men's soccer programs. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 30-11-8, which includes a ten-game winning-streak that began with a 1-0 win in the opening round of the MIAC Playoffs on Nov. 2, 2004. Thanks in part to a two-goal, one-assist performance by Zach Brown (Sr., Eau Claire, Wis.), the Gusties were able to cruise to a 4-1 victory over the Royals and in the process claim the 2013 MIAC Championship in last season's meeting on Oct. 29 in Arden Hills.

NEWS AND NOTES

• **Senior Day** - As is tradition at Gustavus, the final home match of the regular season is designated as Senior Day and a special tribute is made to the individuals who have dedicated themselves to Gustavus soccer the last several years. This year, the athletics department, head coach Mike Middleton, parents and fans salute the 12 seniors who have represented the Gustavus soccer program with pride and class throughout their collegiate careers. Student-athletes honored today for their years of commitment include Braden Schmid (West Fargo, N.D.), Brett Ylonen (Lake Elmo, Minn.), Eric Schneider (St. Anthony, Minn.), Elliot Emerson (Minneapolis, Minn.), Ryan Schultz (Delafield, Wis.), Ryan Tollefsrud (Spearfish, S.D.), Ryan Ragan (Shakopee, Minn.), David Lilly (Maple Grove, Minn.), Anthony Slack (Plymouth, Minn.), Andy Babusek (Chaska, Minn.), Zach Brown (Eau Claire, Wis.), and Nick Kieser (Plymouth, Minn.). We salute these young men and wish them good luck in all future endeavors at Gustavus and beyond. This year's senior class has won two MIAC Championships in 2012 and 2013, won a MIAC Playoff Championship in 2012, earned back-to-back trips to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and 2013, and boasts an impressive overall record of 54-12-8 for a winning percentage of .784.

• **Playoff Bound** - Saturday's victory over Augsburg secured a place in the 2014 MIAC Playoffs for the Gustavus men's soccer team. The Gusties will compete in the postseason for the fourth straight year and four out of the five seasons under the direction of Mike Middleton. Since the MIAC instituted the post-season playoff system in 2003, Gustavus has qualified for the tournament a total of 10 times.

MIDDLETON ON THE MATCH

Our lads have played well all year - playing some lovely possession football and dominating the majority of games we have played in. We have not always converted that possession into goals, and have often not put teams to the sword in terms of the scoreline that our possession has warranted. The intensity and work-rate last Saturday, and quality of the goals was a major step in curing that particular problem. The goals were well worked and chiseled out in the heat of the battle. It was not given to us - the lads stepped forward and took it.

Tempo is the key today. We must not just be happy to control possession for possession's sake. We need to aggressively attack the opposition - possession has to be for a purpose, and that purpose is to cause as many problems for the opposition as possible when we have the ball. We need to be up and at them, play positively and attack with gusto. I'll be looking to see the attacking pattern, the quality of chances we create and the movement of the forwards in particular, as well as midfield and the rest of the team in creating those chances. I want to see the forwards really goal hungry. Out of possession we need to be organized, have a strong team shape and be ready to pressure the opposition when they are in possession. The lads must be switched on at all times. When we get it right, we can purr like a Rolls Royce; we get in wrong at our peril. We need to head into the business end of the season on the back of a rich vein of form, playing with quality and tempo.

We have a number of seniors playing in their last regular season contest at home, and potentially their last game on the home pitch. It has come around very quickly. This group has been tremendous at demonstrating how the game should be played. They have played with freedom and a generosity of spirit, with considerable aplomb, and with flair and creativity to burn. They have been great ambassadors for the College and for the game at this level.

This group of lads have achieved a good deal of success; success that has included two MIAC Championships, two NCAA appearances, and a national ranking during the season at least once during all four years. But the pure quality of play is what I will remember the most. They are so good in possession and so much fun to watch. At times they have purred, playing the beautiful game with an élan seldom seen at this level. What a delight they have all been. Thanks to them all.
