### ABOUT THE MATCH

The Gustavus Adolphus men's soccer team will travel to St. Paul for a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference test against the Scots of Macalester College on Saturday afternoon at 1:00 p.m. at Macalester Stadium. The Gusties head into the weekend in a tie for second place in the conference standings alongside Carleton College with 13 points at 4-1-1 in the MIAC and 10-3-1 overall. Macalester is tied with Augsburg and St. Thomas in fifth place with 10 points at 7-5-2 overall and 3-3-1 in the MIAC. St. Olaf remains in first place with 19 points at 6-0-1 in the MIAC and 10-3-1 overall.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Gustavus men's soccer team was able to use some late-regulation magic for the second straight match in its last outing against St. Thomas on Saturday, Oct. 11 at the Gustie Soccer Field. One week removed from Eric Schneider's (Sr., St. Anthony, Minn.) goal in the 89th minute that allowed Gustavus a 1-1 tie against conference-leader St. Olaf, the Gusties once again used a late goal to come away with a 1-0 win. Following nearly 75 minutes of scoreless soccer, senior striker Zach Brown (Eau Claire, Wis.) was able to break the ice with a goal from Patrick Roth at the 74:40 mark. Gustavus's back line held the Tommies to just two shots all afternoon, as Braden Schmid (Sr., West Fargo, N.D.) recorded the shutout win after making one save.

### SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's match will be the 59th meeting between Gustavus and Macalester in men's soccer. In a matchup between the two programs that have the most MIAC titles to their name, the Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 39-13-6. In last year's regular season meeting, Zach Brown scored goals in the 61st and 82nd minutes to propel Gustavus to a 2-0 win. Brett Ylonen (Sr., Lake Elmo, Minn.) earned the complete-much shutout after making two saves.

### NEWS AND NOTES

• **In The Polls** - Gustavus made its debut at No. 25 in the most recent NSCAA/Continental Tire NCAA Division III Men's Poll released Tuesday, Oct. 14. It is the first week this season that Gustavus has cracked a top 25 ranking in any of the national polls. The Gusties are also ranked fourth in the most recent NSCAA North Region Poll released this afternoon. Loras at No. 1 (12-1-1), Wartburg at No. 2 (10-2-2), Luther at No. 3 (12-1-0), and St. Olaf at No. 5 (9-4-1) make up the top five teams in the region.

• **Saturday's** - For the second week in a row, the Gustavus men's soccer team had the luxury of not playing a mid-week match. In the Gusties' five Saturday matches this season, they have compiled a record of 2-2-1 with a scoring average of one goal per match and a goals against average of 0.8.

• **On The Road We Go** - After being at home in seven of its past nine matches, the Gusties will take to the road for two consecutive and three of their last four contests. Following Saturday's match at Macalester, Gustavus will head to Minneapolis to face Augsburg on Oct. 25 and St. Paul to take on Hamline on Nov. 1. The club's final home match, which will serve as Senior Day, will take place on Tuesday, Oct. 28 against Bethel. Thus far, Gustavus is 3-1-1 away from St. Peter with a 3.0 goals per match scoring average and a 0.77 goals against average.

• **Turf Burn** - The Gusties will battle Macalester on an artificial surface on Saturday at Macalester Stadium. In its only match contested on field turf prior to this weekend, Gustavus came away with a 3-0 victory over Pacific Lutheran on Sept. 5 at the East Field in Tacoma, Washington. The Black and Gold went 3-1-1 in matches played on field turf last season.

### MIDDLETON ON THE MATCH

We're back in the top 25 this week, which is excellent news. It's not easy to get into the national rankings if you are on the wrong side of results early on. In fact, it's extremely difficult. Our seniors have now been in the top 25 at some point during the season every single year of their college careers, so great kudos to them. That's not bad considering there are over 400 teams nationwide. Even though a national ranking is nice for the players, we are concentrating on where we finish in the MIAC.

Macalester plays on turf so that will be an adjustment early. However, we are generally very good on the slicker surfaces where we can move the ball with tempo. It'll be a tough task to break down a very stubborn defense, so we must move rate ball wide, shift their players around and play the ball into dangerous areas early on. The strikers and attackers in the midfield will have to come out ready to finish chances and be willing to put the work-rate in to create those chances. We must also be defensively tight in open play and on set-pieces.

Macalester plays a tight 4-2-3-1 with the attacking three behind the striker working very defensively to close space. The two defensive midfield players will also sit and the back four will not hesitate to clear their lines. We'll have to keep the ball well and be positive in possession. This should be an excellent game and a big hurdle for us to overcome if we wish to repeat as conference champion. But, we like the challenge and that makes life fun!
