ABOUT THE MATCH

The Gustavus Adolphus men's soccer team will head on the road for Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference match against St. Olaf College at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 4. After picking up a 5-0 victory over Saint Mary's University on Wednesday in St. Peter, Gustavus heads into the weekend at 9-3-0 overall and 3-1-0 in the MIAC. The St. Olaf men's soccer team sits alone atop the MIAC standings with 12 points at 7-2 overall and 4-0 in the MIAC after defeating Hamline 3-1 in its last time out on Tuesday in Northfield.

LAST TIME OUT

The Gustavus mens' soccer team got back on the winning track with a 5-0 home victory over Saint Mary's in its most recent outing. With a 1-0 halftime lead, the Gusties scored four second half goals and blistered the opposition's net with a total of 29 shots en route to their largest MIAC win of the season. Zach Brown (Sr., Eau Claire, Wis.) led the Gusties on the scoresheet with two goals and an assist for a season-best five points. Ryan Tollefsrud (Sr., Spearfish, S.D.), Aden Letcher (Jr., Brandon, S.D.), and Konnor Tranoris (Jr., Des Moines, Iowa) also added goals. Gustavus's back line handled all of Saint Mary's offensive pressure and didn't allow a single shot to make it on goal. As a result, Braden Schmid (Sr., West Fargo, N.D.) earned the complete-match shutout – his second of the season.

SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's match marks the 50th meeting between Gustavus and St. Olaf in men's soccer. The Gusties hold a slight advantage in what has been a back-and-forth series with a record of 21-18-10. Gustavus was able to come away with a 2-1 victory over the Oles in last year's regular season matchup on Oct. 5 in St. Peter. With the score tied at 1-1, Zach Brown struck the game-winning goal in the 70th minute to allow the Gusties their third straight win. Gustavus is 5-3-2 in its last ten matches against St. Olaf.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Bounce Back Victory After seeing its five-match win-streak come to an end against Saint John's on Saturday, Sept. 27, Gustavus bounced back with its best offensive performance against an MIAC opponent in Wednesday's win over Saint Mary's. Dating back to the 2010 season, Gustavus has compiled a record 9-1-0 in matches following a loss. Within that same time-span, the Gusties have lost two consecutive matches on only one occasion, which came in game two (2-1 vs. St. Scholastica) and three (3-1 vs. Central) of the 2010 campaign.
- On The Road After enjoying home field advantage for six of its last seven matches, Gustavus heads to Northfield for what will be its second MIAC road test of the season. In its four matches away from St. Peter, Gustavus holds a record of 3-1-0 with its one loss coming at the hands of Puget Sound (3-2) on Sept. 7 in Tacoma, Wash. The Gusties are averaging 3.5 goals and 16 shots per match on the road. Defensively, they have allowed a total of three goals for a goals against average of 0.75.

MIDDLETON ON THE MATCH

St. Olaf has been playing a 4-2-3-1 with two big strong central defensive midfield players acting as a bulwark for their two big central defenders. The central defenders will be up and at us, and will not attempt to play preferring to clear their lines at the first available opportunity. The center forward leads the line well, and the attacking midfield player looks tidy. They are also dangerous at set plays and in the attacking third have a nice long throw-in, which they exploit extensively.

We'll get the ball down and play, as is our mantra. The movement will have to be good, as it was last game. These games have been very tight with teams winning by the odd goal. I don't think Saturday will be any exception to that. Their team is perhaps more direct than it has been, and ours has gone the opposite way by playing even more than we have in the past. That's great and lovely to watch, but our defense has to be very alert and will need to concentrate throughout the full ninety minutes.

We've already seen teams change their systems to mimic ours after our last season sojourn. If we do well again this year, you'll see a move to more teams trying to play; developing the players rather than this win at all costs stuff. The six team play-off should help this with better quality regular season games.

St. Olaf will find the progression easy, but some coaches will find that a stretch. Kurt Anderson loves his soccer and is a student of the game – watching it as much as he can. I fear that if we don't succeed, the MIAC could be stuck in the dark ages with this dirgestyle soccer for another decade. That's a dead weight holding back the USA game. I think we have to work at the game and our knowledge to keep up to date - anything else lets the players down.
