Setting The Scene: The Gustavus Adolphus women's hockey team is set to take on Hamline University in its first home-home series this Friday and Saturday. Gustavus heads into the weekend with an overall record of 3-0-0 and MIAC mark of 2-0-0, while Hamline will enter the series with a record of 0-1-1 after its opening series with St. Catherine this past weekend at Drake Arena and Oscar Johnson Arena in St. Paul. Friday's game will be played at Don Robert's Ice RInk in St. Peter, with faceoff set for 7 p.m., while Saturday's game will be played at Oscar Johnson Arena in St. Paul at 7 p.m.

Gustavus enters the series coming off a series sweep over Concordia College in St. Peter. In Friday's opener, play was not pretty for much of the first two periods, but Gustavus came through when it mattered most and scored two third period goals en route to a 3-1 victory over the Cobbers. Gustavus was in control early when Lydia Wagner scored the game's first goal at the 10:29 mark in the first period off assists from Erica Power and Diana Draayer. Despite their uninspired performance in the second period, the Gusties managed to turn things around in the third and got goals from Power and Kaitlyn Klein on their way to the 3-1 victory.

After going scoreless for two periods in game two, Gustavus was finally able to break the ice with 17:11 remaining in the third period when Katy Fuller became the fourth Gustie rookie this season to score the first goal of her young career. The goal came off an assist from fellow first-year Erica Power. Allison Eder-Zdechlik was able to put an exclamation point on the Gustavus lead when she scored her first goal of the season at the 11:07 mark of the final period off an assist from Power and Diana Draayer to extend the lead to 2-0 which is where it would stay. Goaltender Lindsey Hibbard earned her first shutout of the season after registering 18 saves on the day and moved her record to 3-0-0 on the season.

Hamline took on St. Catherine University this past weekend and came away with one point after being defeated in its first game and earning a tie in its second. In their series opener on Friday, the Pipers found themselves down 1-0 in the third period, but fought back to tie the game when Kasey Marquardt scored at 9:20 to knot the game at 1-1. Hamline was able to fight off a power play only to allow a goal at 15:36 and another 97 seconds later to bring the score to 3-1 in favor of St. Kate's.

In game two, the Pipers' leading scorer from 2013-14, Jordan Verleye, got Hamline on the board in the second period to tie the game at 1-1 after the Wildcats' Megan Killmer scored a power play goal in the first period. The Pipers had their chances in the third when they were awarded a pair of power plays 30 seconds apart, but could not get the puck by St. Catherine rookie goaltender Kristen Pechacek and the game ended in a 1-1 draw.

Series Snapshot: This weekend's series marks the 31st and 32nd meetings between Gustavus and Hamline in women's hockey. The Gusties have controlled the series thus far with a perfect record of 30-0-0 against the Pipers. The first contest between these two teams was in 2000, when Gustavus swept Hamline in the regular season series by scores of 12-0 and 17-0, respectively. Since then, Gustavus has rattled off 28-straight victories, the latest of which was a 4-1 victory in St. Peter last season.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Nov. 22 and 23 of last season when Gustavus captured a series sweep. In game one, the Gusties scored one goal in the first period, three in the second, and two in the third, led by Emily Reibert and Allison Eder-Zdechlik, who each scored two goals. In game two, Hamline tied the game at 1-1 just over one minute into the third period, but Gustavus scored three unanswered goals to skate past the Pipers by a final score of 4-1. The game also marked the first start for goaltender Marah Sobczak '14 since the 2011-12 season after she was away from the team recovering from a serious car accident.

Gustavus Embarks On 18th Season Of Women's Hockey: The Gustavus women's hockey team is currently in its 18th season. Founded in 1997, the Gusties have attained an all-time record of 370-97-26, which stands as the second winningest program in all of NCAA Division III women's hockey. The Gustie women have won 12 MIAC titles in the 16 years of women's hockey in the conference. Those 12 titles rank first in front of St. Thomas (3) and Augsburg and Saint Mary's, who each have two. Gustavus has also earned the MIAC Playoff crown a total of 11 times, 10 of which have come in the past 11 years and led to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances.

Wearing The "C": In the 17-year history of the Gustavus women's hockey program, 33 players have earned the honor of being a captain. This year, that number stays the same as two of the 2013-14 captains, Carolyn Draayer and Courtney Boucher, will move into their senior years and accept the same role during their 2014-15 campaign.

Home Grown Talent: Of the 24 players on this year's roster, 22 are natives of Minnesota. The only players who reside outside the State of Hockey are Courtney Bethune, who hails from Fort Frances, Ontario, and Allie Lewis, who is a native of Kearney, Nebraska.

Veteran Squad: Despite losing three of its top five scorers from its 2013-14 squad, Gustavus will return 63 percent of its scoring from last season. Sixteen of the Gusties' 24 players are returners, compared to just eight first-year players. Gustavus will also welcome back three of its four 2013-14 All-MIAC honorees, which include Courtney Boucher, Carolyn Draayer and Allison Eder-Zdechlik.

Gusties In The Polls: Gustavus is ranked seventh for the second week in a row in the most recent USCHO.com Division III Women's Hockey Poll, which was released Monday. This week marks the 80th consecutive time that the Gusties have been ranked in the USCHO.com poll.

About The Pipers: The Pipers are led by their 2013-14 leading scorer, Jordan Verleye. Verleye scored 11 goals and tallied 11 assists last season to finish with 22 points for the Pipers. This season, Verleye has already made her presence felt, scoring Hamline's lone goal in its 1-1 tie with St. Catherine on Saturday. Hamline has scored just two goals in its first two games, with Verleye and sophomore Kasey Marquardt being the long goal scorers. Goaltenders Mary Shefveland and Katie Beckman have started one game apiece for the Pipers. Shefveland started game one against St. Catherine and allowed three goals, while making 28 saves and suffered the loss. Beckman started the following game against the Wildcats and allowed one goal, while making 22 saves and earned a tie to put her record at 0-0-1.

Sweet Start: Junior goaltender Lindsey Hibbard has gotten off to a great start for Gustavus and is a key reason the team is still undefeated. Hibbard has started all three games for the Gusties and played the maximum 180 minutes. She has allowed just two total goals for a goals against average of 0.67, while making 107 saves for a .972 save percentage. She also recorded the third most saves in a game of her career on Saturday when she allied 29 against Concordia.

Rookies On A Roll: Much has been made of the Gusties' talented first-year class so far this season and for good reason. In its first three games, Gustavus has totaled 20 points and 15 of those have been scored by first-year players.

Saving Their Best For Last: Gustavus has tended to wait until the latter parts of the game to do a majority of its scoring in its first three games. The Gusties have scored eight total goals to this point, with five of those coming in the third period.

Shots, Shots, Shots: In its series against Concordia, Gustavus recorded 42 and 44 shots, respectively. The two games against the Cobbers mark the first time Gustavus has taken 40 shots in back-to-back games since its 2013-14 series with Hamline when it shot 48 and 41 shots, respectively.

Boss-Like: First-year Katie Aney has been a menace for opposing teams on faceoffs this season. Aney has taken a total of 25 faceoffs and won 20 of them to total a .800 faceoff percentage.

Head Coach Mike Carroll

Mike Carroll is in his 16th season as the women's head hockey coach at Gustavus. Within his tenure behind the Gustie bench, Carroll has turned Gustavus women's hockey into one of the most successful programs in NCAA Division III. He has compiled an overall record of 333-78-25 in 15 seasons and has the most coaching victories in the history of the program.

Last season, the Gustavus women's hockey team saw its reign atop the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) come to an end. The Gusties finished second in the final conference standings with 28 points at 14-4-0, ending their streak of consecutive MIAC Championships at nine. After defeating Bethel 3-2 in the MIAC Playoff Semifinals, Gustavus's season concluded with a 2-0 loss to regular season champion St. Thomas in the MIAC Playoff Championship. The postseason defeat suffered to the Tommies ended Head Coach Mike Carroll's run of 10 consecutive MIAC Playoff titles and trips to the NCAA Tournament. The Gusties finished the year with an overall record of 17-8-2.

Carroll has directed the Gusties to 11 MIAC regular season titles (2000-01, 2001-02, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13) and has been named the MIAC Coach-of-the-Year six times (2001-02, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2010-11, 2012-13). In addition to coaching 34 players who have earned All-Conference honors 59 times, he has coached five MIAC Players-of-the-Year in Sarah Garrison, Andrea Peterson, Stefanie Ubl, Allie Schwab, Lindsey Hjelm. Carroll has also worked with 13 players who have earned AHCA All-America distinction 21 times and two American Hockey Coaches Association Players-of-the-Year, including four-time MIAC Player-of-the-Year and four-time All-American Andrea Peterson.

Prior to coming to Gustavus, Carroll served as the head boys' hockey coach at Mankato West High School from 1991 to 1999. Carroll's college coaching resume included a stint as head men's hockey coach at Fergus Falls Community College from 1986 to 1987 as well as a season as the assistant men's coach at the University of St. Thomas in 1983.

Carroll, an Edina, Minnesota native, competed in hockey and baseball at Mankato State. After graduating with a degree in municipal recreation in 1982, Carroll played professional baseball in the Montreal Expos organization for two years.

In addition to his hockey coaching duties at Gustavus, Carroll is also the head coach of the Golden Gustie baseball team. Mike and his wife, Terri, live in Mankato and have two sons, Matt and Mike.


