The Gusties and Cobbers will begin the weekend with a 7:00 p.m. game on Friday, Nov. 14. The two teams will then cap the weekend on Saturday, Nov. 15 with a 2:00 p.m. game. Both contests will be played at the Moorhead Sports Center.

Gustavus heads into league play at 2-2-0 overall after falling to No. 2 UW-Stevens Point 4-1 and defeating UW-Stout 4-3 in overtime last weekend in St. Peter. The Cobbers come in at 2-2-0 overall after falling to UW-River Falls 4-3 and defeating UW-Superior 2-1 last weekend in Moorhead.

GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 73RD SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY

The Gustavus men's hockey team is in its 73rd season of existence. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 851-620-68 overall and 563-424-42 in the MIAC. The Gusties have won 14 MIAC Championships and earned a place in the NCAA Division III Tournament six times, which includes a runner-up finish in 2009.

Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the on-campus fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF

Head Coach Brett Petersen is in his 15th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 200-150-32 overall record in his 14-plus seasons at Gustavus. His 200 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10.

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 124-79-21 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey standout David Martinson is in his third season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate and one of the most decorated hockey players to don a three crowned sweater, Martinson is a native of St. Louis Park, Minn. After being named the MIAC Player of the Year and earning All-America honors twice during his playing career, Martinson continued his education at the Bowling Green State University where he served as a graduate assistant for the men's hockey team. In the fall of 2012, David received his masters of education in sport administration.

CONCORDIA COACHING STAFF

Concordia coach Chris Howe was hired in the spring of 2008 and became only the third Concordia men's hockey coach in the past 40 years. Before coming to Concordia Howe spent the previous five seasons as the top assistant at St. John's University. Before going to Saint John's, Howe served as a volunteer assistant coach for St. Cloud State University under head coach Craig Dahl. A native of St. Cloud, Minn., Howe received his bachelor's degree in social studies and secondary education from Saint John's University in 1999.

Chris Howe is assisted by Erick Galt (Concordia-Moorhead '12) and Michael Benedict (Concordia-Moorhead '13).

AROUND THE GLOBE

Gustavus's 2014-15 roster features 28 players from six different states and one player from Canada. Within the United States, Minnesota (22), Alaska (1), California (1), North Dakota (1), Oklahoma (1), and Vermont (1) are represented by 27 players. Outside the U.S., the Canadian province of British Columbia is home to Sam Smith.

PRIOR EXPERIENCE

All 28 players on Gustavus's roster previously played junior hockey before beginning their collegiate careers. Thirteen of this year's Gusties are alums of the North American Hockey League (NAHL), while four played in the Superior International Junior Hockey League (SIJHL). The Eastern Junior Hockey League (EJHL), North American Tier III Hockey League (NA3HL), and Western States

Hockey League (WSHL) are each represented by two players. The United States Hockey League (USHL), British Columbia Hockey League (BCHL), Central Canada Hockey League (CCHL), American West Hockey League (AWHL), and Minnesota Junior Hockey League (MNJHL) were all home to one future Gustie.

CAPTAIN'S LOG: 2014-15

The 2014-15 Gustavus men's hockey team is led by senior captains Jack Walsh (Mahtomedi, Minn.) and Tyler Lopic (New Prague, Minn.). In the 72-year history of Gustavus men's hockey, Walsh and Lopic are the 87th and 88th student-athletes to earn the right of wearing a "C" on their Gustavus sweater. Jack Walsh is the program's first two-time captain since Ross Ring-Jarvi '12 served during the 2010-11 and 2011-12 seasons.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

Eight student-athletes embark on their fourth and final season on the Gustavus men's hockey team. Sam Smith (Vancouver, B.C.), Jack Walsh, Tyler Lopic, Schyler Adams (New Prague, Minn.), Nate Paulsen (La Habra, Calif.), Andy Pearson (Burnsville, Minn.), Cory Ellis (St. Paul, Minn.), and Blake Schammel (Red Wing, Minn.) make up this year's Golden Gustie seniors. All eight have been significant contributors to the program since coming to campus in the fall of 2011.

LETTERWINNERS AND FRESH FACES

Brett Petersen returned 20 letterwinners from a 2013-14 squad that went 16-7-4 overall (12-3-1 MIAC) and advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship for the third consecutive season. To go along with his 20 returners, coach Petersen welcomes eight new players to the team. Five of the eight fresh faces are frosh while the other three spent last season on Gustavus's junior varsity team. This season's rookies include Jake McCann (Shoreview, Minn.), Jake Bushey (Duluth, Minn.), Conor Deal (Anchorage, Alaska), Tim Donohue (Bloomington, Minn.), and Isaak Tjaden (Eagan, Minn.). Sophomores Cameron Jackson (Lakeville, Minn.), Matt Petersen (Center City, Minn.), and Mason Wyman (Burnsville, Minn.) moved up to varsity after a season on JV. McCann, Deal, Donohue, and Wyman are forwards, Bushey, Jackson, and Petersen are defenseman, and Tjaden is a goaltender.

THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD

To go along with the team's standard 16 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference contests, this season's long and winding schedule features non-conference games against teams belonging to the MIAC, WIAC, NCHA, and NESCAC. In addition to non-league games against conference foes Bethel and St. Olaf this weekend at the MIAC Showcase, Gustavus will face UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 7) and UW-Stout (Nov. 8) of the WIAC, Lawrence (Nov. 29), Marian (Nov. 30), Finlandia (Jan. 9), and St. Scholastica (Jan. 10) of the NCHA, and Williams (Jan. 2) of the NESCAC. The Gusties will play 13 of its games at home at Don Roberts Ice Rink including non-conference bouts against Lawrence and Marian in the MIAC/NCHA Thanksgiving Showdown Nov. 29 and Nov. 30.

THE SERIES

This weekend's games will be the 103rd and 104th meetings between Gustavus and Concordia in men's hockey. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 81-26-5.

In last year's series on Nov. 15-16 at Don Roberts Ice Rink, Concordia picked up a 3-1 win on Friday night, and Gustavus bounced back with a 3-1 victory on Saturday afternoon.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND

The Gustavus men's hockey team played host to a pair of WIAC opponents last weekend in its final non-conference games before embarking on league play. The Gusties went 1-1 over the weekend with a 4-1 loss to No. 2 UW-Stevens Point on Friday night and a 4-3 overtime victory over UW-Stout on Saturday night.

In Friday night's game, UW-Stevens Point scored three unanswered goals - one in the first period and two in the second - to jump out to a 3-0 lead by the second intermission. Although the Gusties cut the lead to 3-1 with a Jake Bushey goal at the 6:18 mark of the third, the Pointers shut down the home club for the remainder of the game and added an empty net goal with :59 seconds remaining. Erik Johnson suffered the loss in what was his first start at Don Roberts Ice Rink. He allowed three goals and made 23 saves.

The weekend finale against UW-Stout had a little bit of everything. From ejections to short-handed goals, from sprawling saves to an overtime winner, it was all there. The back-and-forth began at the 16:02 mark of the first period when Tyler Lopic scored his first goal of the season on a short-handed breakaway. UW-Stout answered less than two minutes later with a goal to tie the game at 1-1 heading into

the first intermission. After Jake Bushey scored to put Gustavus up 2-1 at 4:01 of the second, UW-Stout responded right back with a goal to tie the game at 2-2 at the 7:15 mark. The Gusties got their second short-handed goal of the night from Drew Aspinwall at the 16:07 mark of the second and carried a 3-2 lead into the final period. Although UW-Stout was able to tie the game (3-3) at 7:14 of the third period, Gustavus's Gavin Tufte had the answer in overtime. With just :35 seconds remaining in the overtime session, Tufte accepted a pass from Tyler Lopic in front of the crease and put away a game-winning backhand. Gustavus outshot the Blue Devils 41-35, as Erik Johnson earned the win after making 41 saves.

PETEY GETS 200

Gustavus men's hockey coach Brett Peterson earned his 200th career win on Saturday in a 4-3 overtime victory over UW-Stout at Don Robert's Ice Rink. The victory makes Peterson just the sixth coach in the history of the MIAC to reach 200 career wins. He joins a select club made up of Don Roberts (Gustavus, 515-278-25), Terry Krypek (St. Thomas, 418-197-46), Don Olson (Saint Mary's, 377-399-41), Ed Saugestad (Augsburg, 351-275-18) and John Harrington (Saint John's, 241-142-31). Petersen is now 200-150-32 during his Gustavus tenure and is the 47th coach in Division III history to amass 200 career victories.

ABOUT THE COBBERS

The Concordia men's hockey team was also in non-conference action at home against members of the WIAC last weekend in Moorhead. The Cobbers suffered a 4-3 loss to UW-River Falls on Friday night before defeating UW-Superior 2-1 on Saturday afternoon.

Concordia heads into the weekend ranked third in the MIAC in scoring (3.0 gpg) and fourth in defense (2.50 gaa).

Freshman forward Jon Grebosky is off to a fast start in his first season of collegiate hockey with five points off an MIAC-best four goals and one assist. Junior forward Jordie Bancroft (3G, 1A), senior forward Andrew Deters (1G, 3A), sophomore forward Jordan Christianson (1G, 3A), and sophomore forward Garrett Hendrickson (1G, 3A) all sit next in line with four points each.

Although sophomore goaltender Jordyn Kaufer suffered the loss on Friday night after allowing all four goals and making 20 saves, he enters the weekend with three starts under his belt and a record of 1-2-0. Kaufer carries a goals against average of 2.68 and a save percentage of .909. Freshman goalie Alex Reichle earned the win in his first career start on Saturday against UW-Superior after stopping 21-of-22 shots.

BUSHEY OFF TO FAST START

Gustavus rookie blueliner Jake Bushey continued his goal-scoring tear last weekend with goals against both UW-Stevens Point and UW-Stout. Currently riding a three-game goal-streak during which he has tallied five points (4G, 1A), Bushey heads into conference play ranked second overall and first amongst defensemen in scoring. He also leads the league in power play goals with two - both of which came last weekend.

THE DAWNING OF LEAGUE PLAY

Both Gustavus and Concordia will begin MIAC play this weekend in Moorhead. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus is 7-6-1 in the opening game of its conference season. There are no trends to be found over opening weekend of conference play as Gustavus is 7-6-1 on Friday and 8-5-1 on Saturday. The Gusties and Cobbers opened their respective league schedules with a split against each other last season.

SHORTIES

The Gusties not only killed all six of their opponents power plays (3-3 vs. UW-SP, 3-3 vs. UW-Stout) last weekend, but they also benefitted from a pair of short-handed goals scored by Tyler Lopic and Drew Aspinwall in Saturday night's win over the Blue Devils. Since the 2000-01 season, Gustavus has scored two short-handed goals in a single game just four times. The Black and Gold notched two shorties in a 6-6 tie against Lawrence on Nov. 29, 2013, a 5-3 loss against Augsburg on Nov. 1, 2009, and a 7-5 loss against Bethel on Feb. 28, 2006.

MOVEMBER MOVEMENT IN FULL SWING

The Gustavus hockey team is currently in the midst of Movember, a global event that helps raise vital awareness and funds for men's health issues, specifically prostate and testicular cancer initiatives. Movember is the global men's health charity encouraging men to grow and women to support the Mo (moustache) for the 30 days of November. Through the power of the moustache, awareness and funds are raised for men's health to combat prostate and testicular cancer.

Brett Petersen is in his 15th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team.

The 2013-14 Gustavus men's hockey team posted its best finish in the conference standings since the 2009-10 season and made it back to the MIAC Playoff Championship for the third straight year after what was the team's seventh consecutive winning season. Gustavus finished second in the MIAC with 38 points after going 12-3-1 within conference play. After defeating Saint John's 3-2 in the MIAC Playoff Semifinals at Don Roberts Ice Rink, the Gusties saw their season end with a 2-1 loss to St. Thomas in front of a capacity crowd at the St. Thomas Ice Arena in the MIAC Playoff Championship. Head Coach Brett Petersen's club finished the year 16-7-4 overall, reaching the 15-win mark for the sixth straight season.

Gustavus had a strong showing in the MIAC's postseason awards last season with three players taking home all-conference honors. Gusties featured on the 20-player All-Conference Team included senior forward Corey Leivermann (North Mankato, Minn.), sophomore goaltender John McLean (Eagan, Minn.), and senior forward Adam Smyth (Burnsville, Minn.). Smyth earned all-conference marks for the second straight year, while Leivermann and McLean were both first time recipients. Corey Leivermann shared the MIAC scoring title after scoring 19 points off a league-leading 12 goals and seven assists inside conference play.

In his 15-plus seasons behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 200-150-32 overall record. His 200 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 18 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, eight AHCA All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 124-79-21 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several different occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with his coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.
