Setting The Scene: The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will take on Concordia College on Wednesday, Jan. 14 in a 7:45 p.m. game on Gus Young Court. (NOTE: Due to the distance between the two schools, tip-off will change from its usual 7 p.m. time and will take place at 7:45 p.m.) After dropping two straight games to St. Olaf and Augsburg, respectively, Gustavus was able to bounce back with a victory over Saint Mary's University this past Saturday in Winona. Gustavus will head into Wednesday's contest with the Cobbers at 4-2 in the MIAC and 8-3 overall, while Concordia currently owns a 3-3 mark in the MIAC and a 7-4 overall record.

Quick Rewind: The Gusties last played on Saturday and earned their fourth MIAC victory in a 67-47 win over Saint Mary's. Gustavus was able to build an early lead, and with 12:34 remaining in the first half, led the Cardinals 12-4. By the 7:12 mark, Saint Mary's had chipped that lead to only two (19-17), but four straight points from Gustie big man Peter Kruize allowed Gustavus to come back and retake an eight point lead going into halftime (32-24).

Gustavus roared out of the gates following the half and went on a 26-5 run during the first eight and a half minutes of the game's final half to take a 58-29 lead with 11:29 remaining in the contest. The Gusties did not let up throughout the half and when the final buzzer sounded, had secured a 67-47 win.

Concordia played on Saturday as well and suffered a 64-38 loss to No. 5 St. Thomas. The Cobbers had a tough day on the offensive side of the ball, as they failed to make a 3-point field goal in either half and scored a season-low 38 points. Despite their icy outside shooting touch, the Cobbers were still within striking distance throughout the first half and into the first six minutes of the second period. Concordia trailed by only 10 at the break (26-16) and cut the deficit to six points (28-22) at the 17:10 mark in the second half. However, the Tommies exploded over the next 13 minutes and went on a 30-10 run that snapped a four-game win streak for the Cobbers.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's contest marks the 86th meeting between Gustavus and Concordia in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 51-34. Gustavus has also won nine out of the last 10 meetings, including a series sweep against the Cobbers in the teams' two games last season. Under head coach Mark Hanson, Gustavus is 39-12 against the Cobbers.

About The Cobbers: Concordia enters Wednesday's contest with an experienced squad, as it returns every starter from last season along with several key bench players.

Junior forward Jordan Bolger leads the team with averages of 13.7 points and 8.1 rebounds per game. Senior guard Brandon Giese and junior guard Tom Fraase also return for Concordia and compliment a balanced Cobber offensive attack by averaging 12.3 and 10 points per game, respectively. Brett Bergeson stretches the floor for Concordia, as the junior guard has converted 56-percent of his 3-point attempts this season (20-for-36).

The Cobbers are averaging 68.4 points per game (6th/MIAC) and are shooting 45.3-percent from the field (8th/MIAC), 39-percent from three-point range (4th/MIAC), and 64.2-percent from the free throw line (10th/MIAC). In its last game against St. Thomas, Concordia finished the game by missing all seven shots from outside the arc. It's the first time since the third game of the 2011-12 season that the Cobbers haven't made at least one 3-point basket – a streak of 83 games. Concordia's seven 3-point attempts against the Tommies is also a season low for the Cobbers, who tend to rely on their ability to knock down the outside shot.

With an overall record of 7-4, Concordia has seen mixed results as a team this season. To this point, the Cobbers have played five mutual opponents with Gustavus and have gone 3-2 against those teams, while the Gusties have gone 5-0. Concordia defeated the University of Minnesota, Morris 69-61 on Nov. 15, easily handled Simpson College on Nov. 28 in an 84-56 victory and took down Saint Mary's 71-62 on Dec. 3. However, the Cobbers struggled in a 66-49 defeat to Hamline on Dec. 6 and also suffered a 64-38 loss to St. Thomas this past Saturday.



Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Jan. 25, 2014 in Moorhead, Minnesota, with Gustavus handing Concordia a 49-46 defeat. Tied 46-46 with 1:08 remaining, Martin Feddersen made one of two free throws to give the Gusties a one-point lead over the Cobbers. The free throw proved to be the deciding score in a dramatic 49-46 win for Gustavus. It was the first win of the Gusties' 2013-14 season decided by less than 10 points

Welcome Aboard: Freshmen forwards Jason Faul and Schuyler Thompson, both newcomers to the team in the year 2015, saw their first game action on Saturday against Saint Mary's. Faul scored his first career points on a layup with 48 seconds remaining and also brought down his first career rebound.

Defense-Minded: In the Gusties' 67-47 win over Saint Mary's on Saturday, the 47 points scored by the Cardinals is the first time in almost a year that the Gusties have held an opponent to under 50 points. The last time that happened was on Jan. 25, 2014, a 49-46 win over Concordia.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1403-969, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 927-561. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. In addition, Gustavus will once again stream all home games for viewing on your computer and other portable internet devices through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected each year to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, five sophomores and just one freshman. Of those players, nine are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03

season. With 460 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

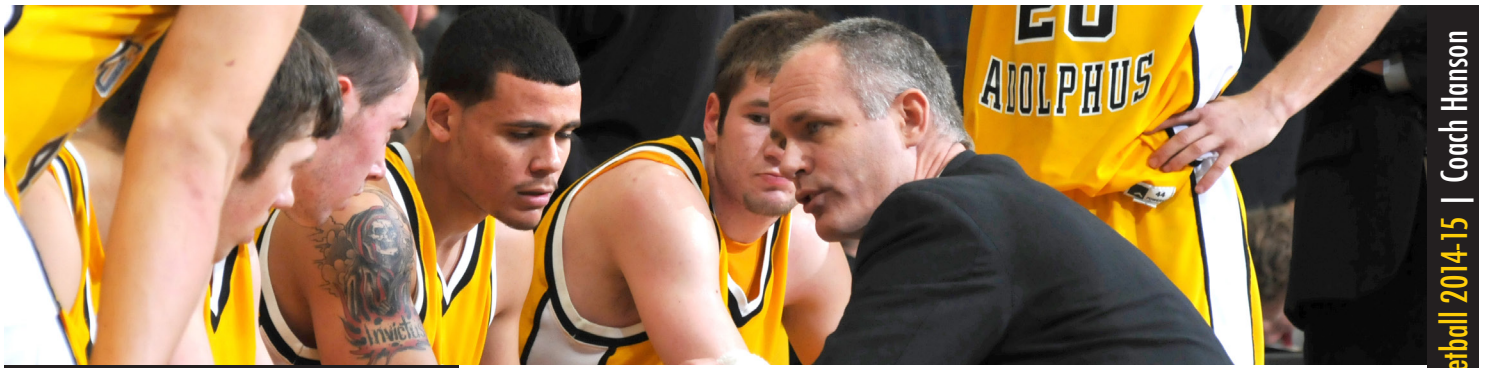

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason a year ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back this season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by senior Jordan Dick (Wabasha, Minn.) with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 460-209 overall record at Gustavus, including a 348-138 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
