

Setting The Scene: The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will take on Saint John's University on Saturday, Jan. 17 in a 3 p.m. game on Gus Young Court. Gustavus will head into Saturday's contest with a record of 4-3 in the MIAC and 8-4 overall, while Saint John's currently owns a 5-2 mark in the MIAC and a 7-5 overall record.

Quick Rewind: Following one of its best defensive performances of the season this past Saturday, Gustavus was able to put together another strong defensive effort in Wednesday evening's game with Concordia College in St. Peter. However, cold shooting proved fatal for the Gusties and led to a heartbreaking 48-45 defeat to the visiting Cobbers.

Gustavus began the game 0-for-5 from the floor, with four out of those five shots coming within five feet of the basket. Senior forward Martin Feddersen finally put the Gusties on the board at the 15:50 mark with a driving layup to make the score 4-2 in favor of Concordia. Defense from both sides continued to fight on each possession, and at the 11:27 mark, the score was only 12-7, with

the Cobbers holding a narrow advantage. It was at that point that Gustavus went on a 10-2 run, with five of those points being scored by junior guard Gary Cooper, to put the home team in front 17-14 with 7:04 remaining.

The Cobbers began the second half with two quick turnovers from sophomore forward Brady Syverson. This seemed to give the Gusties a small spark, as they went on a 6-0 run to begin the second half and take a 29-26 lead. However, a Tom Fraase threepointer tied the game at 29-29 and killed any momentum Gustavus had gained to start the half.

A Feddersen jumper with 7:23 remaining in the game gave the Gusties a 39-36 lead. But two three-pointers from the Cobbers' Brett Bergeson keyed an 8-0 run for Concordia that would allow it to take a 44-41 lead with 2:23 left on the clock.

Gustavus then scored four straight points off a jumper from Sergio Najera and a tough layup from Feddersen to give the Gusties a 45-44 lead with 40 seconds remaining. However, Concordia countered on a jumper from Jordan Bolger to make it a 46-45 Cobber advantage. On the next Gustavus possession, Feddersen misread teammate Isaac Tapp's movement and threw the ball out of bounds, forcing the Gusties to foul intentionally to stop the clock and send Concordia to the free-throw line. Bergeson was able to convert on both of his attempts to give the Cobbers a 48-45 lead and set up a dramatic finish.

Gustavus called timeout with eight seconds remaining to draw up a final play. The Gusties inbounded and set several screens to set up a Chad Poppen three-pointer as time expired. However, Poppen was jostled by a Concordia defender on the final screen, causing an errant pass from Feddersen to end up in a Cobber defender's hands, which ended the game.

Saint John's played on Wednesday as well and earned a 93-74 victory over Saint Mary's. The Johnnies shot 53.8 percent (14-for-26) from the field but surrendered 12 points on seven turnovers to take a 38-31 lead into halftime. The Cardinals hit three-pointers on the first two possessions of the second half to cut their deficit to four (41-37) before the Johnnies embarked on a 26-7 scoring run to gain a 67-44 lead with 11:24 remaining and eventually come away with the 19-point victory.

Series Snapshot: Saturday's contest marks the 173rd meeting between Gustavus and Saint John's in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the upper hand in the all-time series with a record of 108-64. The two teams split their regular season series last year, as Gustavus came away with a 71-47 win in Collegeville and Saint John's won 68-63 in St. Peter. However, the Gusties got the best of the Johnnies in the MIAC Playoff quarterfinal where Gustavus took home a 65-64 victory.

About The Johnnies: Saint John's will enter Saturday's game on a four-game win streak that began on Jan. 3 in a 69-67 win at Bethel. The Johnnies are a team that shoots and relies on the three-pointer, as they lead the league in three-point shots converted with 92, are third in the league in attempts with 218 and are also third in the league in percentage at 42.2 percent.

The Johnnies are led by a pair of three-point shooters in junior guard Alex Schmitt and junior forward Mitchell Kuck. Schmitt leads the team and the MIAC in scoring with 19.0 points per game on 43 percent shooting, while Kuck is second on the team and fifth in the MIAC with 15.6 points per game. On the season, Schmitt is 25-for-62 (40.3 percent) from beyond the arc, while Kuck is 21-of-52 (40.4 percent) from long range. Blake Maslonkowski is the main man inside for the Johnnies. The 6-5, 215 pound post averages 6.5 points per game on 53.4 percent shooting and leads the team in rebounding with 7.0 per game.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Feb. 27, 2014 in Collegeville, Minnesota, with Gustavus handing Saint John's a 65-64 defeat in a thrilling MIAC Playoff quarterfinal. Tied 64-64 with 2.3 seconds remaining, Jordan Dick '14 made one of two free throws to lift the Gusties past Saint John's and into the MIAC semifinal.

Three-Ball Is King: The Johnnies' Alex Scmitt and Mitchell Kuck have combined to take 114 three-point shots on the season, which is three more than the entire Gustavus team has taken combined. As a team, Saint John's has taken a total of 218 shots from beyond the arc, while the Gusties have only taken 111.

Welcoming A Legend: Saint John's is coached by Jim Smith, who is the winningest coach on any level in the state of Minnesota. The 2014-15 season is the 51st for Smith at the helm of Saint John's and he has amassed a 777-551 record during his Johnnie tenure. Besides ranking first among college coaches in Minnesota, Smith is also second among active NCAA Division III coaches for most victories, second all-time in Division III basketball history and 17th all-time in all divisions of collegiate basketball.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1403-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 927-562. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. In addition, Gustavus will once again stream all home games for viewing on your computer and other portable internet devices through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected each year to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, five sophomores and just one freshman. Of those players, nine are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

Home Grown: The 2014-15 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 14 players and all but one are natives of Minnesota. The lone player who hails from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes junior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan. Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 25th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 460 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason a year ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back this season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by senior Jordan Dick (Wabasha, Minn.) with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 460-210 overall record at Gustavus, including a 348-140 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children. Hans and Annika.
