**Setting The Scene:** The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will take on Bethel University on Wednesday, Jan. 21 in a 7 p.m. game at Robertson Center Gym. Gustavus will head into Wednesday's contest with a record of 6-3 in the MIAC and 10-4 overall, while Bethel currently owns a 5-4 mark in the MIAC and a 9-5 overall record.

**Quick Rewind:** After leading by only one point at halftime, Gustavus went on a 31-7 second half run in its 61-43 victory over Macalester College on Monday at Gus Young Court. The Gusties got out to a quick 5-0 lead, before the Scots raced to a 13-4 run to tie the game at 9-9 at the 14:09 mark and take a 13-9 lead 10 minutes into the game. The Scots' pressure on the Gustavus post players forced the Gusties into eight first half turnovers and out of their typical inside play. Macalester led 17-11 with 8:02 remaining in the first half, before Gustavus was able to go on a 9-2 run that gave the home team the lead back at 20-19. The Scots would retake a 23-22 lead when Kareem Ismail scored two of his 10 first half points with 3:21 left to play in the opening frame. But Gustavus came back to take a narrow one point (28-27) advantage into halftime.

Following the break, Macalester briefly retook a one point lead (31-30) at 18:10, but Gustavus then went on a 31-7 run over the next 14 and a half minutes to take a 61-38 lead with 3:43 left to play. The run was capped by an Isaac Tapp steal and thunderous two-handed dunk that energized the Gustie bench and crowd.

The Gustie defense limited their opponent to 40 percent shooting or less for the fourth game in a row, as the Scots shot an even 40 percent in the game (16-of-40). Chad Poppen led the Gustie scoring attack with 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting, and Brody Ziegler added eight points on 3-of-6 shooting and a team-leading nine rebounds. Chris Narum also chipped in 10 points on 5-of-6 shooting and two steals. Gustavus dominated the boards, holding a 34-13 advantage.

Bethel played on Monday as well and suffered an 80-69 defeat to No. 3 University of St. Thomas. The Royals had several chances to take the lead in both frames, but could not convert on critical free throw or shot attempts throughout the game. Bethel trailed the Tommies 36-33 at the midway mark and by only one with 18:12 to play. However, St. Thomas went on an 8-0 run and never looked back. The Royals whittled the Tommie lead to five with a chance to make it four on an and-1 attempt with 7:12 remaining in the game, but a missed free throw turned into a St. Thomas basket on the other end and Bethel was never able to recover.

**Series Snapshot:** Wednesday's contest marks the 81st meeting between Gustavus and Bethel in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the upper hand in the all-time series with an overall record of 57-23, and snapped a five-game losing streak against the Royals in the two teams' last outing. Coach Mark Hanson has compiled an overall record of 41-13 against the Royals.

**About The Royals:** Bethel will enter Wednesday's game on a two-game losing streak that began Saturday in a 60-57 loss to Carleton College. The Royals have had an up and down season, as they have compiled wins against top teams such as No. 20 St. Olaf on Dec. 6 (67-57) and Augsburg College (83-60), but have lost tight games to fellow MIAC schools in Saint John's (69-67), Concordia (80-72) and Carleton (60-57).

The Royals are led by senior forward Kyle Zimmermann. The 6'3 wing is known as one of the top players in the MIAC, and leads the team in scoring, rebounding, blocks and steals with 15.9 points, 9.6 boards, 1.9 blocks and 1.8 steals per game. He has earned MIAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week Award twice and is fourth in the conference in scoring, first in rebounding and second in both blocks and steals.

Behind Zimmermann, Bethel starts three additional players that average double-digit scoring in Brycen Wojya (15.7), Bridgeport Tusler (13.9) and Kyle von Schmidt-Pauli (10.0).

**Last Time They Met:** The last time these two teams met was on Feb. 12, 2014 in Arden Hills, Minnesota, with Gustavus handing Bethel a 68-64 defeat. After battling the Royals back-and-forth for 37 minutes, the Gusties finished the game on an 8-0 run over the final three minutes to earn the four-point victory. Gustavus led just once in the first half after trailing by as many as eight points on three separate occasions. The lead came with 40 seconds left in the frame when Chad Poppen made a layup to give his team a 30-29 lead. The advantage lasted just 17 seconds before the Royals' Jackson Canfield gave Bethel a one-point lead (31-30) heading into halftime.

Trailing by four points (64-60) with 3:01 remaining, the Gusties finished the game on an 8-0 run that was sparked by a Jordan Dick '14 three-pointer. Martin Feddersen followed with a layup on the ensuing possession to give Gustavus a one-point lead (65-64) with two minutes left.

After turning the ball over on its next possession and allowing the Gusties a pair of offensive rebounds, Bethel had a chance to take the lead with seven seconds remaining, but could not connect on a three-pointer. From there, Coleman Sweeney went on to make three consecutive three throws to seal the win for the Gusties.

**Gustie Athletics Unique Path Series:** To further tell the story of the student-athletes within the Gustavus Athletics Department, senior Lara Youngguist of Roseville, Minnesota has teamed with the Gustavus Sports Information Department in a new series of feature articles entitled the "Gustie Athletics Unique Path Series." **Defense Wins Championships:** In Monday's win over Macalester, the Gustie defense limited their opponent to 40 percent shooting or less for the fourth game in a row, as the Scots shot an even 40 percent in the game (16-of-40). Gustavus is second in the league in opponent's scoring average (61.1 points per game) and fourth in opponent field goal percentage (43.8 percent).

**Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season:** The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1405-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 929-562. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. **Captains Log:** As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

**Future Looks Bright:** With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster

Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

**Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff:** Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 25th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team

to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 460 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

# **Head Coach Mark Hanson**

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason a year ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back this season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by senior Jordan Dick (Wabasha, Minn.) with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 462-210 overall record at Gustavus, including a 350-140 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
