Setting The Scene: The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will take on the University of St. Thomas on Wednesday, Jan. 28 in a 7 p.m. game at Schoenecker Arena. Gustavus will head into Wednesday's contest with a record of 6-4 in the MIAC and 10-5 overall, while St. Thomas currently owns a 10-1 mark in the MIAC and a 15-1 overall record.

Quick Rewind: In an unprecedented and unfortunate conclusion, Gustavus fell to Bethel University 65-64 on Wednesday evening in Arden Hills. In a game that featured five lead changes in the final 10 seconds, the Gusties were unable to hold off Royal guard Brycen Wojta's jump shot that gave Bethel the final and most important lead change with just a tenth of a second remaining on the clock.

Following the half, Gustavus continued to gradually build on its lead and led 42-32 with 16:31 remaining in the game. However, Bethel went on a 16-6 run over the next six minutes to tie the game at 49-48 with 8:38 remaining in the game. From that point forward, neither team would lead by more than four points, setting up the inevitable dramatic finish.

A Cooper jump shot with 1:02 remaining gave the Gusties a 62-61 lead that would hold until the eight second mark. A Feddersen foul on Bethel's Kyle Zimmermann gave the Royal senior two free-throws and the big man converted both to give Bethel the 63-62 lead.

A foul by Bethel's Kyle Von Schmidt-Pauli on the Gustie inbound gave Feddersen a chance to give Gustavus the lead back and the senior captain did so, as he calmly hit both free-throws on his 1-and-1 opportunity to give the Gusties a 64-63 lead with six seconds remaining.

However, Bethel was able to inbound to Wojta who dribbled the entire length of the court and sank a contested 15-foot jump shot from the right elbow to give the Royals a 65-64 advantage with 0.1 seconds left on the clock. Gustavus called timeout and followed with a full-court pass and tip-in attempt, but Wojta intercepted the pass at the Gustie free-throw line to secure the Royal victory.

St. Thomas last played on Saturday and earned its 11th straight victory in a 79-72 win over Saint John's University. The rivalry game featured nine ties and 14 lead changes. The Johnnies made their first five shots of the second half and built a five-point lead (53-48) with 17:00 remaining, but the Tommies were able to stay within reach and they closed the game making 11-of-24 from 3-point range. St. Thomas never trailed over the final 8:30 and closed out the game with a 16-6 run over the last 10:05 to secure the seven-point win.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's match up marks the 185th meeting between Gustavus and St. Thomas in men's basketball. The Tommies hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 110-74 and have won five out of the past six contests. However, Gustavus was victorious in the two teams' last matchup on Dec. 3, 2014, a 68-65 victory over the Tommies.

About The Tommies: St. Thomas enters Wednesday's game as the No. 2 ranked team in the nation and on an 11-game win-streak that began on Dec. 6, 2014 at Saint John's. The Tommies' last loss came at the hands of Gustavus, when they fell to the Gusties 68-65 on Dec. 3 in St. Peter. In its past 11 games, St. Thomas has defeated its opponents by an average of 18.5 points per game and has garnered wins against ranked opponents in No. 19 UW-Stevens Point on Dec. 20, 2014 (68-66) and No. 24 St. Olaf on Jan. 21 (86-77).

Like Gustavus, St. Thomas is a balanced team that can lean on numerous players in any given game. The Tommies' starting five each average between 10.2 and 12.1 points per game and bring a sixth man off the bench that also averages double-digit scoring (11.5). The Tommies are the MIAC's top three-point shooting team, as they average a 45.3 percent clip from long range and are second in the league in field goal percentage (49.4 percent) and points per game (76.9).

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Dec. 3, 2014 in St. Peter, when Gustavus handed the Tommies their lone defeat on the season in 68-65 fashion. Chad Poppen converted on back-to-back three-pointers late in the first half that put Gustavus up 33-24 with 3:51 remaining, and allowed the Gusties to take a 35-29 lead into the locker room at the half.



Gustavus did not look like the same team early in the second half, and St. Thomas took full advantage. The Tommies went on a 12-2 run highlighted by back-to-back three-pointers from senior guard Marcus Alipate, turning Gustavus's six-point halftime advantage into a 52-45 Tommie lead with 11:10 left to play. However, Gustavus went on a 6-0 run to cut the St. Thomas advantage to 52-51 with 9:09 remaining and finally re-took the lead on a fast break layup from Isaac Tapp to put the Gusties up 55-54 with just 6:37 left. For the next five minutes, the teams traded small leads and with 1:17 remaining, the game was tied at 65-65. It was then that a Brody Ziegler missed jumper turned into a Sergio Najera put-back with :37 remaining to put Gustavus up 67-65 and set up a dramatic finish.

An Alipate turnover gave Gustavus the ball back with :27 seconds left, however, Ziegler ended up having the ball stolen from him by Tommie guard Grant Shaeffer six seconds later. St. Thomas's Taylor Montero then missed a shot from beyond the arc, forcing the Tommies to foul Cooper who went to the free-throw line and made 1-of-2 to put the Gusties up 68-65 with :18 remaining. The Tommies got two clean three-point looks in the game's closing seconds, one from Montero and one from Cortez Tillman, but neither shot fell. With the win, Gustavus was able to snap St. Thomas's four game win-streak to start its season and five-game win-streak in the teams' series.

The Distributers: Coming into tonight's game, Gustavus leads the MIAC in assists per game with 15.4. Senior Martin Feddersen leads the team with 3.4 per game and junior Gary Cooper is not far behind with 2.8.

Defense Wins Championships: Gustavus enters Wednesday's game as the MIAC's top-ranked team in opponent field goals. Gustie opponents have converted 334 field goals this season. The league's second ranked team in that category is Carleton, which has allowed 30 more at 364.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1405-971, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 929-563. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. In addition, Gustavus will once again stream all home games for viewing on your computer and other portable internet devices through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, four sophomores and three freshman. Of those players, 10 are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

Home Grown: The 2014-15 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 14 players and all but one are natives of Minnesota. The lone player who hails from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes junior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan. Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 460 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGroot begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGroot returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGroot played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason two seasons ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back last season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by senior Jordan Dick (Wabasha, Minn.) with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 460-211 overall record at Gustavus, including a 350-141 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
