Setting The Scene: Following its first MIAC loss of the season to St. Olaf this past Saturday, Gustavus will play in its 2015 home opener against Augsburg College on January 7 on Gus Young Court, with tipoff set for 7 p.m. Gustavus and Augsburg will enter Wednesday's game as two of the MIAC's top teams, with the Gusties coming in at 3-1 in the MIAC and 7-2 overall, and the Auggies currently owning a 3-1 mark in the MIAC and an 6-3 overall record.

Quick Rewind: The Gusties last played on Saturday and suffered their first MIAC defeat of the season in an 85-61 loss to St. Olaf College in Northfield. Gustavus committed a season high 27 fouls in the game, which allowed the Oles to shoot a whopping 37 free-throws, 34 of which St. Olaf converted. The Gusties were not able to get to the charity stripe as frequently, as they shot only 18 free-throws on the afternoon, converting 15 of them.

The two teams went back and forth during the game's first 10 minutes and Gustavus held a 17-16 lead with 10:50 remaining in the first half.

But it was all St. Olaf from that point on, as the Oles went on a 3010 run to close out the half and led $46-27$ going into halftime.

St. Olaf continued to add to its lead to begin the second half, and with 16:08 remaining in the game, led the Gusties 57-32. However, Gustavus went on a 13-0 run over the next four minutes to pull within 12 and cut the Ole lead to $57-45$. The 25 point hole proved to be too much for the Gusties to overcome, and the Oles scored seven of the next nine points to bring their lead to 65-47 with 10:18 to play and put the game out of reach. Following a Riley Aikens free-throw at the 11:08 mark, St. Olaf's lead would never dip below 15 for the remainder of the game.

Augsburg has yet to play a game in the New Year and last played on Dec. 13, 2014 in a 57-40 loss to the University of St. Thomas in Minneapolis. Despite holding St. Thomas to a season-low in points and field goal percentage, the Auggies struggled to find their offensive rhythm and couldn't overcome a St. Thomas team that is currently ranked No. 5 in the country. Augsburg was able to keep within striking distance for the entire first half and a three-pointer by the Auggies' Parker Hines at the 1:54 mark in the first half brought the Tommie lead to only seven going into halftime. The Auggies would go on a 9-2 run to begin the second half to bring their defecit to one. However, St. Thomas would never trail and with 8:09 to play had built its lead to 11 and by game's end, the score favored the Tommies by a final of 57-40.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's game marks the 174th meeting between Gustavus and Augsburg in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the upper hand in the all-time series with a record of 105-68. Gustavus has also won four of the past six meetings between the two squads. Last season, the two teams split the season series, with each team winning at home. Gustavus defeated Augsburg 74-54 on Dec. 9, 2013 in St. Peter, while the Auggies defeated the Gusties 83-59 on Jan. 29 in Minneapolis.

About The Auggies: Augsburg will enter Wednesday's contest well rested, as it is playing in its first game since Dec. 13, 2014. After losing its two leading scorers from last season in Andy Seidlitz and 2013-14 MIAC MVP Dan Kornbaum, Augsburg has begun its season strong, especially in conference play. The Auggies' only loss in the MIAC came in their last game, a 57-40 loss to No. 5 ranked St. Thomas.

The Auggies are the conference's top defensive team, as they have held opponents to a mere 60.8 points per game this season. However, Augsburg has had a difficult time making the most of its shooting chances this season, as they shoot only 43.5-percent from the floor, good for 10th in the conference and 36.8-percent from beyond the arc, eighth best in the MIAC.

This season, the Auggies are led by senior gaurd Parker Hines and sophomore forward Brett Rasmussen. Hines and Rasmussen lead the team in scoring with 14.2 and 13 points per game, respectively. They also lead the team in rebounding, as Rasmussen has pulled down an average of 5.4 boards per game and Hines 5.2. Hines also acts as the team's distributor, as he has dished out an average of 5.2 assists per contest.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Jan. 29, 2014 in Minneapolis, with Augsburg handing Gustavus an 83-59 defeat. The Auggies opened the game on a 15-3 run and would never look back, as they cruised to the 24 -point win. Augsburg did its damage inside, outscoring the Gusties 42-24 in the paint.

Najera Named Gustavus December Student Athlete Of The Month: Following a productive December, junior big man Sergio Najera was named Gustavus December Student Athlete Of The Month as selected by the Gustavus Sports Information Department. Najera helped his team to a 4-0 finish during the last month of 2014, including a key 68-65 victory over No. 5 ranked University of St. Thomas on Dec. 3 in which Najera was the team's second leading scorer with 13, leading rebounder with seven and leader in blocked shots with three. In a 63-57 victory over Carleton on Dec. 10, Najera tallied a team-leading 17 points, including going 5 -for-5 from the charity stripe which proved crucial in the six point victory. Overall in December, Najera led the team in scoring in 2-of-4 games for an average of 15.7 points per game, including going 26-of-49 from the floor for a .530 field goal percentage. He also pulled down 14 rebounds, including four offensive boards and dished out four assists. The New Prague native was also a difference-maker on the defensive side of the floor with a total of 10 blocks for an average of 2.5 per game.

An Inside Team: So far this season, Gustavus has been a team that scores its points from inside the three-point line. The Gusties are last in the MIAC in three-point shots attempted with 86 and are also last in three-point shooting percentage by shooting an average of 26.7-percent from beyond the arc. Carleton who ranks second to last in both those categories, has taken 24 more three-point shots (110) and is almost a full 10 -percent better percentage-wise (36.4-percent).

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1395-965, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 923-560. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected each year to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, five sophomores and just one freshman. Of those players, nine are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

Home Grown: The 2014-15 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 13 players and all but two are natives of Minnesota. The two players who hail from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes are junior Gary Cooper from Detroit, Michigan and Jake Weber from Dubuque, Iowa. They are two of just 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 25th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 459 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason a year ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back this season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by senior Jordan Dick (Wabasha, Minn.) with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 8978 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 459-208 overall record at Gustavus, including a 347-138 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three AllAmericans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens'Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
