SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team heads back into Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference play with a home-and-home series against the Auggies of Augsburg College this weekend.

The weekend will begin with a 7:05 p.m. game at Ed Saugestad Rink in Minneapolis on Friday, Jan. 16. The series will then conclude at Don Roberts Ice Rink on Saturday, Jan. 17 with a 7:05 p.m. puck drop.

The Gustavus and Augsburg men's hockey teams are currently grid-locked alongside Concordia in the conference standings with nine points each. The Gusties are 4-5-6 overall and 1-1-4 in the MIAC, while the Auggies are 6-7-0 overall and 3-1-0 in the MIAC. Gustavus was in action last weekend with a 4-2 victory over Finlandia and a 0-0 tie against St. Scholastica in a pair of games played at Don Roberts Ice Rink. Augsurg began the second half of its season last weekend with a pair of losses to UW-Stevens Point 2-1 and UW-Eau Claire 4-1 at home in Minneapolis.

GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 73RD SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY

The Gustavus men's hockey team is in its 73rd season of existence. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 853-623-74 overall and 564-426-45 in the MIAC. The Gusties have won 14 MIAC Championships and earned a place in the NCAA Division III Tournament six times, which includes a runner-up finish in 2009.

Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the on-campus fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF

Head Coach Brett Petersen is in his 15th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 202-153-38 overall record in his 14-plus seasons at Gustavus. His win total at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10.

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 125-80-25 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey standout David Martinson is in his third season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate and one of the most decorated hockey players to don a three crowned sweater, Martinson is a native of St. Louis Park, Minn. After being named the MIAC Player of the Year and earning All-America honors twice during his playing career, Martinson continued his education at the Bowling Green State University where he served as a graduate assistant for the men's hockey team. In the fall of 2012, David received his masters of education in sport administration.

AUGSBURG COACHING STAFF

Chris Brown (Wisconsin-River Falls '94) enters his ninth season as head coach of the Augsburg men's hockey team. During his tenure behind the Auggie bench, Brown has compiled a record of 94-106-18. Prior to coming to Augsburg, Brown served for four seasons (2000-04) as head coach at Marian College (Fond du Lac, Wis.), where his teams won multiple Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association titles. HeC played collegiate hockey at UW-River Falls, where he was a captain of the Falcons' 1993-94 NAA Division III national championship team.

Brown is assisted by Mike LaValle (Lakewood CC), Chris Johnson (Augsburg '10), Andrew Kent (Augsburg '08), and Chris Student (Augsburg '14).

AROUND THE GLOBE

Gustavus's 2014-15 roster features 28 players from six different states and one player from Canada. Within the United States, Minnesota (22), Alaska (1), California (1), North Dakota (1), Oklahoma (1), and Vermont (1) are represented by 27 players. Outside the U.S., the Canadian province of British Columbia is home to Sam Smith.

PRIOR EXPERIENCE

All 28 players on Gustavus's roster previously played junior hockey before beginning their collegiate careers. Thirteen of this year's Gusties are alums of the North American Hockey

League (NAHL), while four played in the Superior International Junior Hockey League (SIJHL). The Eastern Junior Hockey League (EJHL), North American Tier III Hockey League (NA3HL), and Western States Hockey League (WSHL) are each represented by two players. The United States Hockey League (USHL), British Columbia Hockey League (BCHL), Central Canada Hockey League (CCHL), American West Hockey League (AWH L), and Minnesota Junior Hockey League (NNJHL) were all home to one future Gustie.

CAPTAIN'S LOG: 2014-15

The 2014-15 Gustavus men's hockey team is led by senior captains Jack Walsh (Mahtomedi, Minn.) and Tyler Lapic (New Prague, Minn.). In the 72-year history of Gustavus men's hockey, Walsh and Lapic are the 87th and 88th student-athletes to earn the right of wearing a "C" on their Gustavus sweater. Jack Walsh is the program's first two-time captain since Ross Ring-Jarvi '12 served during the 2010-11 and 2011-12 seasons.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

Eight student-athletes are in their fourth and final season on the Gustavus men's hockey team. Sam Smith (Vancouver, B.C), Jack Walsh, Tyler Lapic, Schyler Adams (New Prague, Minn.), Nate Paulsen (La Habra, Calif.), Andy Pearson (Burnsville, Minn.), Cory Ellis (St. Paul, Minn.), and Blake Schammel (Red Wing, Minn.) make up this year's Golden Gustie seniors. All eight have been significant contributors to the program since coming to campus in the fall of 2011.

LETTERWINNERS AND FRESH FACES

Brett Petersen returned 20 letterwinners from a 2013-14 squad that went 16-7-4 overall (12-3-1 MIAC) and advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship for the third consecutive season. To go along with his 20 returners, coach Petersen welcomes eight new players to the team. Five of the eight fresh faces are frosh while the other three spent last season on Gustavus's junior varsity team. This season's rookies include Jake McCann (Shoreview, Minn.), Jake Bushey (Duluth, Minn.), Conor Deal (Anchorage, Alaska), Tim Donohue (Bloomington, Minn.), and Isaak Tjaden (Eagan, Minn.). Sophomores Cameron Jackson (Lakeville, Minn.), Matt Petersen (Center City, Minn.), and Mason Wyman (Burnsville, Minn.) moved up to varsity after a season on JV. McCann, Deal, Donohue, and Wyman are forwards, Bushey, Jackson, and Petersen are defenseman, and Tjaden is a goaltender.

THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD

To go along with the team's standard 16 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference contests, this season's long and winding schedule features non-conference games against teams belonging to the MIAC, WIAC, NCHA, and NESCAC. In addition to non-league games against conference foes Bethel and St. Olaf this weekend at the MIAC Showcase, Gustavus will face UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 7) and UW-Stout (Nov. 8) of the WIAC, Lawrence (Nov. 29), Marian (Nov. 30), Finlandia (Jan. 9), and St. Scholastica (Jan. 10) of the NCHA, and Williams (Jan. 2) of the NESCAC. The Gusties will play 13 of its games at home at Don Roberts Ice Rink including non-conference bouts against Lawrence and Marian in the MIAC/NCHA Thanksgiving Showdown Nov. 29 and Nov. 30.

THE SERIES

This weekend's games will be the 124th and 125th meetings between Gustavus and Augsburg in men's hockey. The Gusties have taken control of the matchup as of late and now lead the all-time series with a record of 71-46-6. Since a 5-3 loss on Nov. 1 at the MIAC showcase held in Bloomington, Gustavus has put together a 12-0-1 record against Augsburg that includes an eight-game winning-streak. Augsburg's last win in St. Peter came by way of a 4-3 victory on Feb. 1, 2008.

In last season's series, the Gusties jump-started what was a six-game win-streak with a sweep over the Auggies. The Black and Gold won 3-1 on Friday night at Don Roberts Ice Rink and completed the sweep with a 4-2 win on Saturday night at Ed Saugestad Rink.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND

The Gustavus men's hockey team will look to build on last weekend's 4-2 victory over Finlandia on Friday night and 0-0 tie against St. Scholastica on Saturday night. The win over the Lions snapped an eight-game dry spell and was the team's first victory since Nov. 14 against Concordia.

Against Finlandia on Friday, Gustavus jumped out to a 2-0 lead thanks to goals by Conor Deal at 11:09 of the first period and Gavin Tufte at 2:32 of the second. After the Lions cut the lead to 2-1 early in the second, Deal put the Gusties back to two up 3-1 with a goal at the 15:34 mark. Although Finlandia once again cut the lead to one goal down 3-2 at 4:42 of the third, the Gusties answered less than one minute later at 5:19 when Nate Paulsen netted his first goal of the season. Gustavus carried a 39-14 shots advantage, as John McLean picked up the win in a 12-save effort.

On a night that legendary Gustavus men's hockey coach Don Roberts was honored with a bronze bust bearing his signature look was dedicated at the entrance of the ice rink graced with his name, it was only fitting that the non-conference game between the Gustie and Saints ended in historical fashion. After 60 minutes of regulation and a five-minute overtime session, neither team could solve the other's goaltender and the contest resulted in a 0-0 tie – the first in program history for both sides. John McLean made 39 saves in the shutout, while his counterpart, Tyler Bruggeman, made 34.

GAME NOTES

SCOUTING THE AUGGIES

The Augsburg men's hockey team heads back into MIAC play seeking a turnaround having dropped five of its last six games dating back to Nov. 25. The Auggies kicked off the second half of their season last weekend with a pair of home games against UW-Stevens Point and UW-Eau Claire. Augsburg suffered a 2-1 loss to the Pointers on Friday before falling to the Blugolds 4-1 on Saturday.

Augsburg heads into the weekend ranked second in the MIAC in scoring with a 3.08 goals per game average despite scoring a total of two goals last weekend. Defensively, the Auggies rank fifth in the league with a team goals against average of 3.00.

Leading Augsburg's scoring charge is junior forward Mack Ohnsted who ranks sixth in the MIAC in overall scoring with 14 points and fourth in the goals with eight. Ohnsted, who also leads the MIAC with three game-winners, had his four-game point-streak snapped last weekend when he was kept off the scoresheet on Friday night. Behind Ohnsted sits senior forward Ben McClellan with 13 points (3G, 10A), sophomore forward Corbin Chapman with 12 (4G, 8A), and senior defenseman Zach Dick with 10 (3G, 7A). Dick is currently the second-ranked scoring defenseman in the league.

The Auggies have consistently gone back-and-forth between sophomore Fredrik Melander and senior John Bretzman in goal. Melander – who was in goal for both contests last weekend, allowing five goals and making a total of 59 saves (44 saves vs. UW-Stevens Point) – is 4-4-0 with a 2.89 goals against average and a .889 save percentage. Bretzman is 2-3-0 with a 2.95 goals against average and a .867 save percentage.

In 73 years of Gustavus men's hockey – a rich history that includes 1,550 games – never has there been a result the likes of Saturday evening's game against St. Scholastica. For the first time in program history, the Gusties skated to a 0-0 tie against an opponent. To demonstrate the rarity of such an occurrence, it was also the first time in St. Scholastica men's hockey history that a Saints club has ever played an opponent to a scoreless draw.

MCLEAN PICKS UP FIRST SHUTOUT

In just his second and third starts of the season after missing the first half of the year due to recovery and rehabilitation, junior goaltender John McLean earned his first win and first shutout of the season last weekend. This follows a sophomore season that saw McLean wait 23 starts before achieving his first complete-game shutout. Despite being challenged just 14 times on Friday night against Finlandia, the junior made 12 saves to help the Gusties earn the two-goal victory. Although it's rare to see a goalie not earn a win despite putting up a shutout, McLean did just that in Saturday's 0-0 tie against Scholastica. The junior was tested a total of 39 times over the course of the 65-minute affair, which included a 13-save first period and a 16-save third period. McLean's 39-save effort matches his career-high set in a 4-2 win over St. Olaf College his rookie season in the MIAC Playoff Championship on March 3, 2012. He has made 30 or more saves a total of eight times in his collegiate career.

KILL OR BE KILLED

After a stretch during which Gustavus's nationally-ranked penalty kill went 8-for-11 and allowed a power play goal in three consecutive games, the Gustie killers got back on track with a 7-for-7 showing last weekend. Gustavus killed two Finlandia penalties and then all five of St. Scholastica's. The unit's showing against the Saints on Saturday was its best performance since the season-opener on Oct. 31 when the Gusties blanked Bethel on five power play opportunities. Thanks to its efforts last weekend, Gustavus heads into the Augsburg series ranked second in NCAA Division III on the penalty kill at 91.7-percent (44-48). St. Norbert leads the country with a 96.2-percent (51-53) kill-rate.

LETS MAKE A DEAL

Freshman forward Conor Deal enters the weekend not only Gustavus's leading scorer, but also the top scoring rookie in the MIAC. With 11 points off six goals and five assists, Deal is the first Gustie to reach double-figure points this season. After not recoding a point over a five game stretch, Deal has registered four points (3G, 1A) over the team's last three games. The Anchorage, Alaska product scored twice against Finlandia with his second tally turning out to be the game-winner. Deal is the fourth Gustie to score two goals in a game this season. He follows Tyler Lapic (Nov. 2 vs. Hamline), Blake Schammel (Nov. 15 vs. Concordia), and Jake Bushey (Nov. 2 vs. St. Olaf).

TIES

With last Saturday's 0-0 tie against St. Scholastica, the 2014-15 Gustavus men's hockey team broke the program record for ties in a single season. The previous record of five draws was held by the 2011-12 team that went 17-7-5 and the 1989-90 team that went 20-6-5. With ten games remaining on their 2014-15 regular season schedule, the Gusties are on the verge of matching and breaking the single season NCAA Division III record of seven held by UMass Dartmouth (12-8-7) in 2013, UW-Superior (19-3-7) in 2005, and UW-Stevens Point (13-13-7) in 1995.

Brett Petersen is in his 15th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team.

The 2013-14 Gustavus men's hockey team posted its best finish in the conference standings since the 2009-10 season and made it back to the MIAC Playoff Championship for the third straight year after what was the team's seventh consecutive winning season. Gustavus finished second in the MIAC with 38 points after going 12-3-1 within conference play. After defeating Saint John's 3-2 in the MIAC Playoff Semifinals at Don Roberts Ice Rink, the Gusties saw their season end with a 2-1 loss to St. Thomas in front of a capacity crowd at the St. Thomas Ice Arena in the MIAC Playoff Championship. Head Coach Brett Petersen's club finished the year 16-7-4 overall, reaching the 15-win mark for the sixth straight season.

Gustavus had a strong showing in the MIAC's postseason awards last season with three players taking home all-conference honors. Gusties featured on the 20-player All-Conference Team included senior forward Corey Leivermann (North Mankato, Minn.), sophomore goaltender John McLean (Eagan, Minn.), and senior forward Adam Smyth (Burnsville, Minn.). Smyth earned all-conference marks for the second straight year, while Leivermann and McLean were both first time recipients. Corey Leivermann shared the MIAC scoring title after scoring 19 points off a league-leading 12 goals and seven assists inside conference play.

In his 15-plus seasons behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 202-153-38 overall record. His win total at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 18 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, eight AHCA All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 125-80-25 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.




