SETTING THE SCENE

The Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team will take part in a home-and-home Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference series this weekend against the Johnnies of Saint John's University.

The weekend will begin with a 7:00 p.m. game at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud on Friday, Jan. 30. The series will then come to an end at Don Roberts Ice Rink on Saturday, Jan. 31 with a 7:05 p.m. puck drop.

Gustavus heads into the weekend sitting in a tie for third place in the conference standings alongside Augsburg with 15 points. The Gusties are 6-7-6 overall and 3-3-4 in the MIAC following a split with Saint Mary's last weekend. Saint John's is a part of a three-way pileup in sixth place along with Hamline and Saint Mary's with 13 points. The Johnnies are 8-5-4 overall and 4-3-1 in the MIAC.

GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 73RD SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY

The Gustavus men's hockey team is in its 73rd season of existence. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 855-625-74 overall and 566-428-45 in the MIAC. The Gusties have won 14 MIAC Championships and earned a place in the NCAA Division III Tournament six times, which includes a runner-up finish in 2009.

Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the on-campus fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF

Head Coach Brett Petersen is in his 15th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 204-155-38 overall record in his 14-plus seasons at Gustavus. His win total at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10.

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 127-82-25 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, NY.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey standout David Martinson is in his third season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate and one of the most decorated hockey players to don a three crowned sweater, Martinson is a native of St. Louis Park, Minn. After being named the MIAC Player of the Year and earning All-America honors twice during his playing career, Martinson continued his education at the Bowling Green State University where he served as a graduate assistant for the men's hockey team. In the fall of 2012, David received his masters of education in sport administration.

SAINT JOHN'S COACHING STAFF

Doug Schueller is in his seventh season as the Saint John's head men's hockey coach. Prior to becoming the head coach at Saint John's, Schueller served as an assistant coach at NCAA Division I Bowling Green State University and was responsible for the Falcons' defensemen and recruiting efforts. He is a 2001 graduate of Bowling Green and a threetime captain for the Falcons. Schueller graduated from Bowling Green with a degree in sports management. He went on to complete his Master's degree (business administration in sports management) from the University of Coventry Business School (Coventry, England) in 2005.

Schueller is assisted by Michael Palmiscno (Saint John's '13), Pat Forte (Bemidji State '89), Nick Sperides (Minnesota '83), and Dave Rogalski (Saint Mary's '05).

AROUND THE GLOBE

Gustavus's 2014-15 roster features 28 players from six different states and one player from Canada. Within the United States, Minnesota (22), Alaska (1), California (1), North Dakota (1), Oklahoma (1), and Vermont (1) are represented by 27 players. Outside the U.S., the Canadian province of British Columbia is home to Sam Smith.

GAME NOTES

PRIOR EXPERIENCE

All 28 players on Gustavus's roster previously played junior hockey before beginning their collegiate careers. Thirteen of this year's Gusties are alums of the North American Hockey League (NAHL), while four played in the Superior International Junior Hockey League (SIJHL). The Eastern Junior Hockey League (EJHL), North American Tier III Hockey League (NA3HL), and Western States Hockey League (WSHL) are each represented by two players. The United States Hockey League (CCHL), American West Hockey League (AWH L), and Minnesota Junior Hockey League (MNJHL) were all home to one future Gustie.

CAPTAIN'S LOG: 2014-15

The 2014-15 Gustavus men's hockey team is led by senior captains Jack Walsh (Mahtomedi, Minn.) and Tyler Lapic (New Prague, Minn.). In the 72-year history of Gustavus men's hockey, Walsh and Lapic are the 87th and 88th student-athletes to earn the right of wearing a "C" on their Gustavus sweater. Jack Walsh is the program's first two-time captain since Ross Ring-Jarvi '12 served during the 2010-11 and 2011-12 seasons.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

Eight student-athletes are in their fourth and final season on the Gustavus men's hockey team. Sam Smith (Vancouver, B.C), Jack Walsh, Tyler Lapic, Schyler Adams (New Prague, Minn.), Nate Paulsen (La Habra, Calif.), Andy Pearson (Burnsville, Minn.), Cory Ellis (St. Paul, Minn.), and Blake Schammel (Red Wing, Minn.) make up this year's Golden Gustie seniors. All eight have been significant contributors to the program since coming to campus in the fall of 2011.

LETTERWINNERS AND FRESH FACES

Brett Petersen returned 20 letterwinners from a 2013-14 squad that went 16-7-4 overall (12-3-1 MIAC) and advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship for the third consecutive season. To go along with his 20 returners, coach Petersen welcomes eight new players to the team. Five of the eight fresh faces are frosh while the other three spent last season on Gustavus's junior varsity team. This season's rookies include Jake McCann (Shoreview, Minn.), Jake Bushey (Duluth, Minn.), Conor Deal (Anchorage, Alaska), Tim Donohue (Bloomington, Minn.), and Isaak Tjaden (Eagan, Minn.). Sophomores Cameron Jackson (Lakeville, Minn.), Matt Petersen (Center City, Minn.), and Mason Wyman (Burnsville, Minn.) moved up to varsity after a season on JV. McCann, Deal, Donohue, and Wyman are forwards, Bushey, Jackson, and Petersen are defenseman, and Tjaden is a goaltender.

THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD

To go along with the team's standard 16 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference contests, this season's long and winding schedule features non-conference games against teams belonging to the MIAC, WIAC, NCHA, and NESCAC. In addition to non-league games against conference foes Bethel and St. Olaf this weekend at the MIAC Showcase, Gustavus will face UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 7) and UW-Stout (Nov. 8) of the WIAC, Lawrence (Nov. 29), Marian (Nov. 30), Finlandia (Jan. 9), and St. Scholastica (Jan. 10) of the NCHA, and Williams (Jan. 2) of the NESCAC. The Gusties will play 13 of its games at home at Don Roberts Ice Rink including non-conference bouts against Lawrence and Marian in the MIAC/NCHA Thanksgiving Showdown Nov. 29 and Nov. 30.

THE SERIES

This weekend's games will be the 115th and 116th meeting between Gustavus and Saint John's in men's hockey. Gustavus holds the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 63-44-7. Following a 3-2 loss in the MIAC Playoff Championship on March 2, 2013 in the National Hockey Center, Gustavus got redemption on the Johnnies last year with a sweep in the regular season series and then a win in the MIAC Playoffs. The Gusties earned a six point sweep – winning their fifth and sixth straight games – with a 2-1 win at Don Roberts Ice Rink and a 4-1 win at the National Hockey Center. In the MIAC Playoff Semifinals on March 1, 2014 in St. Peter, Gustavus trailed Saint John's 2-1 heading into the third period. After Tyler Lapic tied the game at 2-2 with a power play goal at the 2:29 mark, Andy Pearson completed the comeback win with a goal at the 19:26 mark to propel the Gusties into the MIAC Playoff Championship for the second.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND

The Gustavus men's hockey heads into the weekend coming off a second straight MIAC split last weekend against Saint Mary's. Gustavus suffered a 3-0 shutout on Friday night in Winona yet bounced back with a 2-1 overtime victory on Saturday night in St. Peter.

In Friday night's game, Gustavus couldn't find a way to beat Cardinal goaltender Phil Heinle who stopped all 32 shots. John McLean suffered the loss after allowing three goals and making 25 saves. The Gusties finished with a 32-28 edge in shots, yet failed to convert on three power play opportunities. The Cardinals finished 1-for-2 on the power play.

After skating to a 1-1 tie through 60 regulation minutes, Gustavus was able to pull out a victory in dramatic fashion in the series-finale on Saturday night at Don Roberts Ice Rink.

GAME NOTES

With the clock winding down in overtime, the Gusties won an offensive zone faceoff and eventually got the puck through traffic and onto the Saint Mary's net. With :09 seconds remaining, rookie Conor Deal was able to find the puck amongst a mass of bodies and muscle it into the goal for the overtime game-winner. The Gusties were able rebound from a one goal deficit in the first period when Jack Walsh scored halfway through the second. McLean earned the 26-save victory, as Gustavus outshot Saint Mary's 45-27.

NATIONAL HOCKEY CENTER NIGHTMARES

The National Hockey Center has not been kind to the Gustavus men's hockey team since it was built over 20 years ago. In the 2011-12 season, Gustavus was able to snap an eight-game losing-streak in the National Hockey Center with a 4-3 victory on Jan. 13. Heading into the weekend, Gustavus is 3-10-2 on Saint John's home ice since the turn of the century. In the Gusties' last trip to St. Cloud, they scored four unanswered goals – three in the first period and another early in the third – en route to a 4-1 win.

SCOUTING THE JOHNNIES

Despite being swept by Concordia in its last MIAC series on Jan. 16-17 in Moorhead, the Saint John's men's hockey team gained some momentum with a mid-week, 4-2 victory over UW-Stout in the team's last time on the ice Jan. 20 at the National Hockey Center. The Johnnies fell 3-2 in overtime on Friday night and 4-0 on Saturday afternoon to Concordia in their last MIAC action.

Saint John's is ranked fifth in the MIAC in offense with a 2.76 goals per game average. Defensively, the Johnnies rank second with a 2.24 goals against average. Saint John's ranks seventh on the power play at 13.3-percent and sixth on the penalty kill at 83.3-percent for a league-low special teams net of -5.

Senior forward John Haeg leads the Johnnies in scoring with 14 points off five goals and nine assists. Junior forward Neal Smith is the team's top goal-scorer with six and sits second on the team in scoring with 10 points. Senior forwards Phill Johnson (4G, 6A) and Nick Vatnsdal (3G, 7A) sit beside Smith with 10 points each.

Although junior Saxton Soley has seen the majority of time between the pipes with an overall record of 6-3-4 in 803:04 minutes, fellow junior Jason Dzurik has gotten the start the last two games and is now 2-2-0 in 239:56 minutes. Soley carries a save percentage of .937 and a goals against average of 1.94, while Dzurik has a save percentage of .886 and a goals against average of 3.00.

UNBEATEN IN OT

Saturday's win over Saint Mary's was Gustavus's first overtime victory since Nov. 8, 2014 when the Gusties came away with a 4-3 win over UW-Stout. After their overtime win over the Blue Devils, the Gusties skated to six consecutive draws in overtime games. Gustavus is now 2-0-6 in overtime games this season. Gustavus's last overtime loss came against St. Thomas 4-3 on Nov. 18, 2011 in Mendota Heights. Since that loss, Gustavus has compiled a record of 4-0-16 in overtime games. In those four overtime wins, three of the team's game-winning goals have been scored in the final minute of the overtime session. Jack Walsh scored at the 4:31 mark to propel Gustavus to a 3-2 win over Augsburg on Dec. 1, 2012, Gavin Tufte scored at 4:25 in the 4-3 win over UW-Stout earlier this season, and Conor Deal provided the game-winner at 4:51 on Saturday against Saint Mary's.

BY THE NUMBERS

11-3 - Schyler Adams' faceoff record on Saturday against Saint Mary's. Thanks to his showing against the Cardinals, Adams bumped his win-percentage to 61.4-percent, which leads the team amongst players with more than 100 faceoff opportunities.

The 2013-14 Gustavus men's hockey team posted its best finish in the conference standings since the 2009-10 season and made it back to the MIAC Playoff Championship for the third straight year after what was the team's seventh consecutive winning season. Gustavus finished second in the MIAC with 38 points after going 12-3-1 within conference play. After defeating Saint John's 3-2 in the MIAC Playoff Semifinals at Don Roberts Ice Rink, the Gusties saw their season end with a 2-1 loss to St. Thomas in front of a capacity crowd at the St. Thomas Ice Arena in the MIAC Playoff Championship. Head Coach Brett Petersen's club finished the year 16-7-4 overall, reaching the 15-win mark for the sixth straight season.

Gustavus had a strong showing in the MIAC's postseason awards last season with three players taking home all-conference honors. Gusties featured on the 20-player All-Conference Team included senior forward Corey Leivermann (North Mankato, Minn.), sophomore goaltender John McLean (Eagan, Minn.), and senior forward Adam Smyth (Burnsville, Minn.). Smyth earned all-conference marks for the second straight year, while Leivermann and McLean were both first time recipients. Corey Leivermann shared the MIAC scoring title after scoring 19 points off a league-leading 12 goals and seven assists inside conference play.

In his 15-plus seasons behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 204-155-38 overall record. His win total at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 18 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, eight AHCA All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 127-82-25 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 straight seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minnesota native, started his coaching career with the St. Paul Vulcans of the United States Hockey League (USHL) from 1992-1994. He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.






