Setting The Scene: After suffering two straight losses to No. 21 St. Olaf College and Augsburg College this past Saturday and Monday, respectively, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will attempt to snap its two-game losing streak when it takes on Concordia College on Wednesday, Feb. 11 in a 7:45 p.m. game in Moorhead, Minnesota. Gustavus will head into Wednesday's contest with a record of 8-7 in the MIAC and 12-8 overall, while Concordia currently owns an identical 8-7 mark in the MIAC and 12-8 overall record.

Quick Rewind: Gustavus suffered a 63-59 loss to Augsburg College on Monday evening at Si Melby Hall. The Gusties never trailed by more than 10, but also never led, making for a close game throughout.

The Gusties quickly fell behind 11-4, but never let the Auggies go on a deep run and were able to stay within eight points for the entire first half. By halftime, Augsburg led 33-28. The Auggies shot 4-of-6 from three-point range in the opening half compared to Gustavus going 2-for-11. Collin Olmscheid led the way for Augsburg through the first 20 minutes, scoring 12 points on 3-of-6 shooting, including going 2-for-3 from beyond the arc.

Following the half, the Auggies went on a brief 4-0 run to take a nine-point lead (37-28) which equaled their largest lead of the game. Three-pointers by Gary Cooper and Chad Poppen early in the second half helped Gustavus to keep the Gusties close, but Augsburg still led 48-40 with 11:46 to play.

It was then Gustavus went on a 7-0 run, keyed by layups from Poppen and Martin Feddersen and a three-pointer by Chris Narum to bring the scored to 48-47. However, the Auggies' Parker Hines slowed the Gustie momentum with a layup that brought the Auggie lead back to three and the Gusties would not get that close again until a Feddersen layup with 2:54 remaining in the game brought the Augsburg lead to 60-57. Hines again countered to bring the lead back to five, but Feddersen got to the rim one last time to cut the lead back to three (62-59) with 1:28 left to play. But Gustavus managed only one shot attempt in that last 1:28, and Augsburg eventually secured the four-point victory.

Concordia last played on Monday as well and suffered a 74-66 loss to Bethel University in Arden Hills, Minnesota. After rolling to a 31-21 lead at halftime, the Cobbers were unable to stop a furious 13-3 run from the Royals over the first 2:44 of the second half that tied the game at 34-34 with 17:16 to play.

Despite the Royals' quick second half run, the game still hung in the balance until the final two minutes of play. A pair of free-throws from the Cobbers' Tom Fraase cut the Royal lead to two points at 59-57 with 2:02 to play. Bethel then made a layup on its next possession, which was followed by a missed three-pointer from the Cobbers. The Royals then began their free-throw shooting parade, as they proceeded to make 11-of-12 free throws in the final minute of play to salt away the eight-point win.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's contest marks the 87th meeting between Gustavus and Concordia in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 51-35. Gustavus has also won nine out of the last 11 meetings, but the Cobbers took home a 48-45 win over the Gusties earlier this season. Under head coach Mark Hanson, Gustavus is 39-13 against the Cobbers.

About The Cobbers: Concordia enters Wednesday's contest having compiled an MIAC record of 8-7 and 12-8 overall, identical to Gustavus. The Cobbers are locked with the Gusties in a tie for the sixth and final playoff spot, making Wednesday's game plenty meaningful for both squads.

Jordan Bolger continues to lead the Cobbers in both scoring and rebounding by putting up 14.6 points and 7.6 rebounds per game. Senior guard Brandon Giese and junior guard Tom Fraase help compliment a balanced Cobber offensive attack by averaging 12.0 and 9.3 points per game, respectively. Brett Bergeson stretches the floor for Concordia, as the junior guard has converted 47-percent of his three-point attempts this season (29-for-61).

Concordia has proven it is capable of knocking down the three-ball, as it is fourth in the MIAC in three-point field goal percentage at 36.4 percent. The Cobbers are also a strong defensive team and one that takes care of the ball, as they rank fourth in the league in points allowed per game at 61.9 and are third in turnovers per game at 10.0.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Jan. 14 in Saint Peter, with Concordia handing Gustavus a 48-45 defeat. Defenses controlled the game for both teams and at halftime, the score was only 26-23 in favor of Concordia.

A Martin Feddersen jumper with 7:23 remaining in the game gave the Gusties a 39-36 lead. But two three-pointers from the Cobbers' Brett Bergeson keyed an 8-0 run for Concordia that would allow it to take a 44-41 lead with 2:23 left on the clock. Gustavus then scored four straight points off a jumper from Sergio Najera and a tough layup from Feddersen to give the Gusties a 45-44 lead with 40 seconds remaining. However, Concordia countered on a jumper from Jordan Bolger to make it a 46-45 Cobber advantage. On the next Gustavus possession, Feddersen misread teammate Isaac Tapp's movement and threw the ball out of bounds, forcing the Gusties to foul intentionally to stop the clock and send Concordia to the free-throw line. Bergeson was able to convert on both of his attempts to give the Cobbers a 48-45 lead and set up a dramatic finish.

Gustavus called timeout with eight seconds remaining to draw up a final play. The Gusties inbounded and set several screens to set up a Chad Poppen three-pointer as time expired. However, Poppen was jostled by a Concordia defender on the final screen, causing an errant pass from Feddersen to end up in a Cobber defender's hands, which ended the game.

Defense Rules: In Gustavus's last outing with Concordia on Jan. 14, the Gusties' 23 and 22 points in the first and second halves, respectively, were the lowest amount of points Gustavus has scored in either half all season. The Gusties' total of 45 points in that game was also a season low.

Home Sweet Road?: The Gusties' long road trip on Wednesday evening could prove to be a dose of the right medicine. Gustavus's previous two losses against St. Olaf and Augsburg both came at home, marking the first time all season the Gusties have fallen in consecutive games on Gus Young Court.

By The Numbers...536: The number of miles roundtrip the Gusties will travel for Wednesday's game in Moorhead. It is estimated that the trip between St. Peter and Moorhead will take four hours and 20 minutes one way.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1407-974, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 931-566. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. In addition, Gustavus will once again stream all home games for viewing on your computer and other portable internet devices through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, four sophomores and three freshman. Of those

Home Grown: The 2014-15 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 14 players and all but one are natives of Minnesota. The lone player who hails from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes junior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan. Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 25th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division

III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 464 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason two seasons ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back last season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by Jordan Dick '14 with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 464-212 overall record at Gustavus, including a 352-144 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
