Setting The Scene: After suffering its third straight loss to Concordia College this past Wednesday, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will look to turn its fortune around when it welcomes Saint Mary's University to town on Saturday, Feb. 14 for a 3 p.m. game on Gus Young Court. Gustavus will head into Saturday's contest with a record of 8-8 in the MIAC and 12-9 overall, while Saint Mary's currently owns a 1-16 mark in the MIAC and 4-18 overall record.

Quick Rewind: After building a lead as large as seven in the first half, Gustavus could not seal the deal in a 58-51 loss to Concordia on Wednesday at Memorial Auditorium.

The Gusties were able to jump out to an early 13-6 lead at the 13:09 mark in the first half, but Concordia went on a 13-5 run over the next 9:27 to take its first lead of the game at 19-18 with 3:42 to play in the opening frame. Following a Chad Poppen jumper with 1:31 remaining, the Cobbers' Tom Fraase converted an old-fashioned four-point play to put Concordia back in front by three (23-20). Brody Ziegler notched a jumper for the Gusties before time expired in the first half, but Concordia still took a 23-22 lead into the break.

Following halftime, neither team led by more than four points until Concordia grabbed a six point lead (52-46) with 2:10 remaining thanks to a 7-0 run that was highlighted by five points from Fraase. A foul by Concordia's Brandon Giese allowed Poppen to shorten the deficit to four (52-48) with 1:55 to go. However, two costly Gustie turnovers in the game's final minute did not allow Gustavus to get the offensive possessions it so needed, negated the Cobbers going 2-for-5 from the free-throw line in the game's final 30 seconds and allowed Concordia to secure the seven-point win.

Saint Mary's last played on Wednesday as well and suffered a 94-70 loss to Saint John's University in Winona. The Johnnies used a 13-2 run midway through the first half to take a 29-16 lead with 7:51 to play in the opening frame. Saint John's continued to build on that lead and took a 44-28 advantage into the break.

In the game's final half, the Johnnies went 21-for-33 from the field, including five three-pointers to seal their ninth win in their last 12 games. The Johnnie win negated the Cardinal's Connor Kaiser's career night, as the sophomore poured in 19 points and was a perfect 4-for-4 from downtown.

Series Snapshot: Saturday's contest marks the 169th meeting between Gustavus and Saint Mary's in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 119-49 and have won each of the last nine contests, including a 67-47 win in the two teams' last contest in Winona on Jan. 10, 2015.

About The Cardinals: Saint Mary's enters Saturday's contest having compiled an MIAC record of 1-16 and 4-18 overall. The Cardinals have endured a tough season, as they have not won a conference game since Dec. 3, 2014 when they defeated Hamline by a final score of 70-67.

The Cardinals are led by junior Will Swiggum, as the forward leads the team in scoring and rebounding with 10.5 points and six rebounds per contest. Big man Mark Schumacher has elevated his game as the season has continued and he is now second on the team in both scoring and rebounding with 9.3 points and 4.6 rebounds per game.

Saint Mary's has proven it is capable of knocking down the three-ball, as it is fifth in the MIAC in three-point field goal percentage at 35.8 percent. However, the Cardinals also rank last in the MIAC in points allowed per game at 74.1 and turnovers per game at 15.1.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Jan. 10 in Winona, with Gustavus handing Saint Mary's a 67-47 defeat. Gustavus was able to build an eight point lead by halftime and pulled away in the second period to secure the 20-point win.

Gustavus was able to build an early lead and with 12:34 remaining in the first half, led the Cardinals 12-4. By the 7:12 mark, Saint Mary's had chipped that lead to only two (19-17), but four straight points from big man Peter Kruize (So., St. Peter, Minn.) allowed the Gusties to come back and retake an eight point lead going into halftime (32-24).



Gustavus roared out of the gates following halftime and went on a 26-5 run during the first eight and a half minutes of the second half to take a 58-29 lead with 11:29 remaining. The Gusties did not let up throughout the half and when the final buzzer sounded, had secured a 67-47 win.

Favorable Schedule: Gustavus is currently in a dead heat with Augsburg for the sixth position in the MIAC, which could mean an upcoming battle with the Auggies for the sixth and final MIAC playoff spot over the last four games of the regular season. Although Augsburg owns the head-to-head record after sweeping Gustavus in the teams' regular season series, Gustavus seemingly has the lighter schedule to close out the year. The Gusties' final four opponents in Saint Mary's, Macalester, Bethel and Saint John's have a combined record of 23-43, while Augsburg's final four teams in Bethel, Hamline, Saint John's and Concordia have a combined mark of 36-29. Gustavus will also play two of those four games at home, while Augsburg will take to the road for three of its final four contests.

Fast Starts Key: Gustavus has proven that starting game's strong is one of the key's to its success. So far this season, when Gustavus takes a lead into the half, it is 10-1, compared to its 1-7 record when it trails at halftime.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1407-975, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 931-567. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, four sophomores and three freshman. Of those players, 10 are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson begins his 25th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 464 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason two seasons ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back last season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by Jordan Dick '14 with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 464-213 overall record at Gustavus, including a 352-145 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
