Setting The Scene: After getting back on track with key wins over Saint Mary's University and Bethel University this past Saturday and Monday, respectively, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will look to clinch its spot in the MIAC playoffs with a victory over Macalester College on Wednesday evening at Leonard Center. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. Gustavus will head into Wednesday's contest with a record of 10-8 in the MIAC and 14-9 overall, while Macalester currently owns a 2-16 mark in the MIAC and 5-18 overall record.

Quick Rewind: When it mattered most, Gustavus was able to play its best basketball and earned a 77-67 victory over Bethel University on Monday evening at Gus Young Court.

Gustavus found itself in an early 12-6 hole at the 16:16 mark in the first half following nine combined points from Royal leading scorers Kyle Zimmerman and Kyle von_Schmidt-Pauli. Less than one minute later, the Gusties had that lead down to one thanks to a Chad Poppen three-pointer and Gary Cooper steal and layup. The two teams continued to go back and forth for the next two minutes, until Bethel went on a 10-4 run to take a 27-19 lead with 9:45 remaining in the first half.

But Gustavus fought back and executed a 12-0 run of its own over the next five and a half minutes, keyed by points from six different Gusties, to take a 31-27 lead with 4:27 to play in the opening frame. Bethel clawed back though, and managed to take a slim 36-35 advantage into the half.

In the second half, Bethel maintained its slim advantage for approximately six minutes. The Royals led 46-43 with 15:35 to play before Gustavus went on an 11-0 run over the next 4:18 minutes to take a 54-46 advantage and a lead that would stick for the remainder of the game.

The Royals would not go away quietly though, and with 6:18 to play had cut the Gustie lead to 64-60. However, a Tapp three-pointer would spark a 7-0 Gustavus run over the next minute and a half to give Gustavus a 71-60 lead and seemingly give the Black and Gold the momentum it so needed to finish the game.

Bethel continued to remain resilient and cut the Gustie lead to 72-67 with 1:30 to play, but Gustavus would go on a 5-0 run by making 5-of-6 free-throws to close the game and secure the 10-point win.

Macalester last played on Monday as well and suffered a 74-58 victory to Saint John's University in St. Paul. The Scots and Johnnies exchanged the lead eight times in the game's opening 10 minutes but the Johnnies used a 14-2 run to open up an 11-point lead by the 5:28 mark in the first half.

Despite its lead, Saint John's was not able to rid itself of Macalester, as the Scots closed the half on an 11-3 run to come within six of the Johnnies by halftime. But Saint John's big man Blake Maslonkowski scored the game's next six points to extend the Johnnie lead to 12 and help Saint John's run away for its eventual 16 point victory.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's contest marks the 153rd meeting between Gustavus and Macalester in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 100-52 and earned their 100th victory over the Scots in their first game of the two teams' regular season series on Jan. 19. Gustavus has won each of the last seven contests, including a series sweep of Macalester last season, a 75-52 result in St. Paul on Jan. 6, 2014 and a 64-54 victory on Feb. 5, 2014 in St. Peter.

About The Scots: Macalester enters Saturday's contest having compiled an MIAC record of 2-16 and 5-18 overall. The Scots have endured a tough season, as they have not won a conference game since Jan. 24 when they defeated Carleton by a final score of 57-49 in overtime.

The Scots are led by sophomore Kareem Ismail, as the forward leads the team in scoring and rebounding with 14.3 points and 7.2 rebounds per contest. Junior guard Dylan Kilgour has had a breakout season, and is second on the team in scoring with 11.2 points per game and third in rebounding with three boards per contest.

Macalester is known as a defensive-minded squad, as the Scots allow an average of only 66.2 points per game (6th/MIAC). However, Macalester is ranked last in the league in points scored per game (54.6), field goal percentage (41.1) and rebounds per contest (29.7).

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Jan. 19 on Gus Young Court with Gustavus handing Macalester a 61-43 defeat. After leading by only one point at halftime, the Gusties went on a 31-7 second half run in their 18-point victory.



The Gusties got out to a quick 5-0 lead, before the Scots raced to a 13-4 run to tie the game at 9-9 at the 14:09 mark and take a 13-9 lead 10 minutes into the game. The Scots' pressure on the Gustavus post players forced the Gusties into eight first half turnovers and out of their typical inside play. Macalester led 17-11 with 8:02 remaining in the first half, before Gustavus was able to go on a 9-2 run that gave the home team the lead back at 20-19. The Scots would retake a 23-22 lead when Kareem Ismail scored two of his 10 first half points with 3:21 left to play in the opening frame. But Gustavus came back to take a narrow one point (28-27) advantage into halftime.

Following the break, Macalester briefly retook a one point lead (31-30) at 18:10, but Gustavus then went on a 31-7 run over the next 14 and a half minutes to take a 61-38 lead with 3:43 left to play. The run was capped by an Isaac Tapp steal and thunderous two-handed dunk that energized the Gustie bench and crowd.

Offense Is Clicking: For the second game in a row, Gustavus eclipsed the 70-point mark in Monday's game against Bethel thanks to a 64 percent team field goal percentage. The team's percentage was the highest since it shot 65.9 percent against Northwestern University on Dec. 6, 2014 and was its second highest percentage of the season. The Gusties had not previously made it to 70 points since their 81-62 victory over Hamline back on Dec. 13, 2014.

Magic Number...1: With a win against the Scots, the Gusties would clinch a berth in the MIAC Playoffs for the third time in the last five years and the 22nd time in head coach Mark Hanson's tenure. Gustavus is currently tied with Concordia College for fifth place in the MIAC standings with a record of 10-8 and are still in the hunt for a home playoff game.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1409-975, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 933-567. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

In addition, Gustavus will once again stream all home games for viewing on your computer and other portable internet devices through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, four sophomores and three freshman. Of those players, 10 are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring.

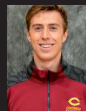

III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 466 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason two seasons ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back last season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by Jordan Dick '14 with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 466-213 overall record at Gustavus, including a 354-145 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
