Setting The Scene: After clinching an MIAC playoff berth with a win over Macalester College, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will look to close out its regular season on a high note when it takes on Saint John's University on Saturday afternoon at Sexton Arena. Tip-off is set for 3 p.m. Gustavus will head into Saturday's contest with a record of 11-8 in the MIAC and 15-9 overall, while Saint John's currently owns a 13-6 mark in the MIAC and 15-9 overall record.

Quick Rewind: Following a 1-3 stretch to begin the month of February, Gustavus has turned its fortune around of late, winning three straight games and its latest result being a 70-61 victory over Macalester on Wednesday evening at Leonard Center. The win clinched the Gusties a spot in the MIAC Playoffs that begin next Wednesday.

For the game's first 12 minutes, the score remained tight, with Macalester holding the lead for a majority of the first five minutes and Gustavus taking control for the next seven. But with 7:59 remaining in the first half, the score was knotted at 19-19, the fourth tie of the game to that point.

It was then that the Gusties went on a 17-3 run to close the half and take a 14-point (36-22) lead into halftime. The run was highlighted by three three-point plays: a three-pointer by Chris Narum and an and-one apiece from sophomores Coleman Sweeney and Peter Kruize.

Following the break, Gustavus kept hold of its comfortable lead and held a 49-31 advantage with 12:29 to play. However, the Scots proved to have some life left in them and went on an 8-0 run to bring the Gustie lead to just 10 with 8:49 to play.

Gustavus maintained its composure though and went on an 8-0 run of its own over the next 3:33 to retake its 18-point lead and held a seemingly comfortable 59-41 lead with just 4:43 left on the clock.

But the Scots proved they had one more run in them and charged to a 15-2 run over the next 3:51 to cut the Gustie lead to five (61-56) with 52 seconds left on the clock. Macalester's Dylan Kilgour scored eight of those 15 points.

However, five would be the closest the Scots would come, as Gustavus made 9-of-10 free-throws in the last 46 seconds, including six from Chad Poppen to seal its third straight victory and a spot in this season's conference playoffs.

Saint John's last played on Wednesday as well and earned a 72-61 victory over Augsburg College in Minneapolis. The Johnnies shot 64 percent from the field to earn their fourth straight victory and fifth in their past six games. The win also gives Saint John's the third seed in the MIAC playoffs, guaranteeing them at least one home playoff game.

With 11:16 remaining in the game, the Auggies were able to cut Saint John's lead to five (46-41). However, the Johnnies bounced back with a 17-5 run to build a 17-point lead and put the game away thanks in large part to career games from Joe Risinger and Tyler Weiss. Risinger led all scorers with a career-high 27 points, his first collegiate 20-point game, as well as personal bests in three-pointers (6) and assists (5). He also tied a career high with four steals. Weiss tallied 18 points on 7-for-8 shooting and six blocks, both of which were career highs.

Series Snapshot: Saturday's contest marks the 174th meeting between Gustavus and Saint John's in men's basketball. The Gusties hold the upper hand in the all-time series with a record of 109-64. The two teams split their regular season series last year, as Gustavus came away with a 71-47 win in Collegeville and Saint John's won 68-63 in St. Peter. However, the Gusties got the best of the Johnnies in the MIAC Playoff quarterfinal where Gustavus took home a 65-64 victory and also earned a victory in the two teams first regular season series game this year, a 69-59 win in Saint Peter.

About The Johnnies: Saint John's will enter Saturday's game on a four-game win streak that began on Feb. 11 in a 94-70 win at Saint Mary's. The Johnnies are a team that shoots and relies on the three-pointer, as they are second in the league in three-point shots converted with 174, are fourth in the league in attempts with 418 and are also second in the league in percentage at 41.6 percent.

The Johnnies are led by a pair of three-point shooters in junior guard Alex Schmitt and junior forward Mitchell Kuck. Schmitt leads the team and is third in the MIAC in scoring with 16.0 points per game on 46.9 percent shooting, while Kuck is second on the team and fourth in the MIAC with 15.8 points per game. On the season, Schmitt is 40-for-103 (38.8 percent) from beyond the arc, while Kuck is 50-of-120 (41.7 percent) from long range. Blake Maslonkowski is the main man inside for the Johnnies. The 6-5, 215 pound post averages 6.1 points per game on 53.6 percent shooting and leads the team in rebounding with 6.9 per game.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was on Jan. 18 on Gus Young Court with Gustavus handing Saint John's a 69-59 defeat. The Gusties were able to limit the Johnnies to 36.1-percent shooting on the afternoon and received 21 points from Gary Cooper to pick up the 10-point win.



Gustavus began the game in an 7-0 hole, but managed to race back and tie the game at 8-8 to keep the game in check. Four of those eight points came from big man Peter Kruize who then scored twice more to put the score at 14-12 in favor of Saint John's. Isaac Tapp then sank a three-pointer to give the Gusties their first lead of the game (15-14) at the 10:41 mark in the first half.

With the score tied at 17-17 with 9:01 remaining in the first half, Cooper converted on two three-point plays in a row, when he was fouled driving to the basket on two consecutive possessions. Cooper sank both free-throws to give the Gusties six quick points and a 23-20 lead with 7:41 remaining.

Over the final seven minutes of the half, Gustavus went on a 10-3 run that was highlighted by a Cooper jump shot as time expired to give the Gusties a 33-26 advantage at the half.

Gustavus began the second half with a steal and quick basket from Tapp, but then allowed two quick three-pointers from the Johnnies' Alex Schmitt and Mitchell Kuck which brought the Gustie lead to only 35-32. Despite coming into the game as one of the MIAC's top three-point shooting teams however, those would be the only shots from beyond the arc that the Johnnies would have all afternoon, as the Gustie defense only allowed Saint John's to go 2-for-13 from long range (15.4-percent).

The Gusties continued to gradually build their lead as the game wound down and never let their lead dip below six after the 8:10 mark. With 2:28 remaining, Gustavus led 62-51 and would finish the game 5-of-6 from the free-throw line to secure the 69-59 victory.

Shooters Touch: Saturday's game will feature two of the best shooting teams in the MIAC, as Saint John's ranks first in field goal percentage at 49 percent and Gustavus is third at 48.9 percent. The Johnnies do shoot the three-ball better (41.6 percent from beyond the arc compared to the Gusties' 33.6 percent), however, Gustavus allows far less points per game with 61.3 compared to 68.6 for Saint John's.

Saturdays=Kind: A Saturday game with the Johnnies could be exactly what Gustavus needs to close out its season. So far this year, the Gusties are 8-2 in games played on Saturday, with one of those eight wins coming in Gustavus's last game against Saint John's on Saturday, Jan. 18 in Saint Peter.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1410-975, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 934-567. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

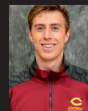

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, four sophomores and three freshman. Of those players, 10 are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

Home Grown: The 2014-15 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 14 players and all but one are natives of Minnesota. The lone player who hails from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes junior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan. Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 21 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 467 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGroot begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGroot returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGroot played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason two seasons ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back last season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by Jordan Dick '14 with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 467-213 overall record at Gustavus, including a 355-145 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 20 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
