Setting The Scene: The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team will travel to Collegeville, Minnesota on Wednesday to take on Saint John's University in the quarterfinal round of the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Playoffs. After finishing the regular season with a conference record of 14-6, the Johnnies will enter the game as the No. 3 seed, while the Gusties finished 11-9 in the MIAC to earn the No. 6 seed. Wednesday night's game is set for a 7 p.m. opening tip.

Last Time Out: With a playoff berth already secure, Gustavus went into its final regular season game of the season with Saint John's playing for seeding purposes. With their 50-47 loss to the Johnnies on Saturday, Gustavus fell to the sixth seed, meaning it will travel back to Collegeview Wednesday evening for a chance at revenge, as well as an opportunity to advance to the MIAC semifinals this Friday.

Defense for both squads ruled throughout, as each team shot an identical 37.7 percent from the floor. That percentage was the second lowest of the season for Gustavus. The Gusties also went 0-for-7 from three-point range and failed to score a point on its 10 offensive rebounds, while Saint John's missed 11 shots in the paint.

Neither team led by more than five points for the entire first half. Gary Cooper had a hot start for the Gusties, scoring the team's first six points and also scored a game-high 20 points on 8-of-13 shooting. However, with the rest of the team shooting only 30 percent (12-for-40), Gustavus was never able to pull away from the Johnnies and were tied 23-23 at halftime.

Following the half, Gustavus jumped out to a four point lead by the 13:35 mark in the second half, but the Johnnies recovered and went on a 14-4 run over the next five minutes to take a 45-39 lead with 9:33 remaining on the clock. Saint John's took its largest lead of the game with 6:50 to go when it led 48-41. But the Johnnies failed to score a field goal from that point on to allow Gustavus to creep back to within one (48-47) with 1:33 to play.

However, Gustavus failed to get off a shot in the game's final minute and half, while Saint John's got two free-throws from junior guard Alex Schmitt to seal the Johnnie's three-point victory.

About The Johnnies: Saint John's will enter Saturday's game riding high after completing a five-game win streak to close its season. The Johnnies are also winners of 12 of their past 16 games. Saint John's is a team that shoots and relies on the three-pointer, as it is second in the league in three-point shots converted with 179, are fourth in the league in attempts with 434 and are also second in the league in percentage at 41.2 percent.

The Johnnies are led by a pair of three-point shooters in junior guard Alex Schmitt and junior forward Mitchell Kuck. Schmitt leads the team and is third in the MIAC in scoring with 16.1 points per game on 47.2 percent shooting, while Kuck is second on the team and fourth in the MIAC with 15.5 points per game. On the season, Schmitt is 42-for-107 (39.3 percent) from beyond the arc, while Kuck is 51-of-126 (40.5 percent) from long range. Blake Maslonkowski is the main man inside for the Johnnies. The 6-5, 215 pound post averages 5.9 points per game on 53.1 percent shooting and leads the team in rebounding with 7.0 per game.

Last Time They Met: The last time these two teams met was this past Saturday at Sexton Arena with Saint John's handing Gustavus a 50-47 defeat. Both teams shot poorly and at an identical 37.7 percent.

In the Gusties' and Johnnies first game of the regular season series however, Gustavus earned a 69-59 victory over the Johnnies on Gus Young Court on Jan. 18.

Gustavus began the game in an 7-0 hole, but managed to race back and tie the game at 8-8 to keep the game in check. Four of those eight points came from big man Peter Kruize who then scored twice more to put the score at 14-12 in favor of Saint John's. Isaac Tapp then sank a three-pointer to give the Gusties their first lead of the game (15-14) at the 10:41 mark in the first half.

With the score tied at 17-17 with 9:01 remaining in the first half, Cooper converted on two three-point plays in a row, when he was fouled driving to the basket on two consecutive possessions. Cooper sank both free-throws to give the Gusties six quick points and a 23-20 lead with 7:41 remaining.

Over the final seven minutes of the half, Gustavus went on a 10-3 run that was highlighted by a Cooper jump shot as time expired to give the Gusties a 33-26 advantage at the half.

Gustavus began the second half with a steal and quick basket from Tapp, but then allowed two quick three-pointers from the Johnnies' Alex Schmitt and Mitchell Kuck which brought the Gustie lead to only 35-32. Despite coming into the game as one of the MIAC's top three-



point shooting teams however, those would be the only shots from beyond the arc that the Johnnies would have all afternoon, as the Gustie defense only allowed Saint John's to go 2-for-13 from long range (15.4-percent).

The Gusties continued to gradually build their lead as the game wound down and never let their lead dip below six after the 8:10 mark. With 2:28 remaining, Gustavus led 62-51 and would finish the game 5-of-6 from the free-throw line to secure the 69-59 victory.

MIAC Playoff History: Since the inaugural year of the MIAC Playoffs in the 1984-85 season, Gustavus has now made 23 appearances in the playoff field, while this season marks the 20th appearance for Saint John's. The Gusties have an all-time record of 31-14 in the conference tournament, which has led to nine MIAC Playoff titles. However, the Gusties have not lifted the playoff trophy since the 2004-05 season. Since then, Gustavus is 0-4 in championship games. In quarterfinal match ups, Gustavus is a perfect 5-0 in the 29-year history of the MIAC postseason.

Against the Johnnies, Gustavus is 4-3 in playoff tilts, including a 3-3 mark in Collegeville. The last time these two teams squared off in a playoff contest was on Feb. 26, 2014, when the Gusties defeated Saint John's by a final score of 65-64 in quarterfinal action in Collegeville. Jordan Dick '14 made one of two free-throws with 2.3 seconds remaining to give the Gusties a narrow one point lead and victory.

Cooper Breaking Out: In eight February games, junior guard Gary Cooper has been a consistent scoring force for the Black and Gold, scoring in double-digits in six of them. In games against No. 21 St. Olaf and Saint John's, Cooper reached the 20 point mark.

A New Streak: After qualifying for the MIAC Playoffs 12 consecutive seasons, Gustavus failed to make the playoff field in its 2012-13 campaign, at the time ending the longest active streak by any member of the league. Last season, the Gusties made it back into the postseason and have now made it 14 out of the past 15 seasons after clinching a spot in the 2014-15 playoff.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 106th Season: The 2014-15 season represents the 106th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1410-976, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 934-568. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 23 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Follow The Gusties On KNUJ and KCHK: KNUJ AM 860 of New Ulm, Minnesota and KCHK 95.5 FM of New Prague, Minnesota will broadcast all twenty-five Gustavus regular season men's basketball games, with the voice of the Golden Gusties, Tom Wheeler, handling play-by-play duties for the ninth consecutive season. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or Online through the Gustavus Athletics website. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, two players were given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Martin Feddersen and Isaac Tapp to the position for the second season in a row.

Future Looks Bright: With only two seniors on this season's roster, the Gusties seem

primed to be an MIAC powerhouse beyond the 2014-15 season. This season's roster consists of two seniors, five juniors, four sophomores and three freshman. Of those players, 10 are returning letterwinners and consist of 69 percent of last season's scoring. Isaac Tapp and Brody Ziegler are the two leading scorers of those that return from last season. The duo averaged 11.7 and 10.9 points per game, respectively.

Home Grown: The 2014-15 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 14 players and all but one are natives of Minnesota. The lone player who hails from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes junior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan. Cooper is just one 10 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 15 years.

helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 467 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history. Assistant coach Justin DeGroot begins his third season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGroot returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGroot played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish begins his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 25th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

After narrowly missing the postseason two seasons ago, the Gustavus men's basketball team bounced back last season with a fourth place finish in the conference standings after going 13-7 in league play. Thanks to a free throw by Jordan Dick '14 with just :02 seconds remaining in the game, the Gusties were able to defeat No. 4-seeded Saint John's 65-64 on the road in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus' tournament run came to an end in the semifinal round when it fell to No. 2-seeded St. Olaf 66-53 in Northfield. The 2013-14 Gusties finished the season with a 17-10 overall record.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 467-214 overall record at Gustavus, including a 355-146 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
