## GAME NOTES

## GUSTIES TAKE TO GRIDIRON FOR

**99TH SEASON...**The Gustavus football continues its 99th season today at Lloyd Hollingsworth Field for its home opener. Over the previous 98 years, the Gusties have compiled a record of 479-343-21, including a record of 222-126-8 in St. Peter. With 22 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) championships, Gustavus has claimed the second-most league titles in the 95-year history of the conference. Only Saint John's (32) has claimed more MIAC championships.

## FOLLOW THE GUSTIES ON KNUJ...KNUJ

AM 860 out of New Ulm, Minnesota once again broadcasts all 10 Gustavus regular season football games. The voice of the Golden Gusties Tom Wheeler handles the play-by-play duties for the 10th consecutive season. Wheeler is once again joined by 1984 Gustavus graduate and former Gustie football player Ken Ericson on the live call of this year's games. Fans can listen to the KNUJ broadcasts on the Internet through the Gustavus Athletics website. **Calling All Captains...** Of over 5,000 student-athletes who have played football for Gustavus in the 99-year history of the program, only 195 have earned the privilege to serve as team captain. Peter Haugen's captains this season include seniors Mitch Hendricks, Zach Martinez, Nick Frandsen and Marcus Kelly

**SENIOR LEADERSHIP...** In what has become a trend of Head Coach Peter Haugen's tenure, the 2015 Gustavus football roster once again features a great deal of senior leadership. With 23 seniors on this year's squad, the Gustavus roster is tied for the third-most seniors on any Gustie football team since the turn of the century. The 2003 (28), 2002 (26), 2011 (23) and 2014 (23) teams are the only squads during that span to have more or as many seniors wearing Black and Gold. This year's senior class features four defensive lineman, four defensive backs, four offensive lineman, three tight ends, two wide receivers, two quarterbacks, two linebackers, one running back and one kicker.

## GUSTIE FOOTBALL AROUND THE

**GLOBE...** The 2015 Gustavus football team features a total of 104 players from nine different states and, for the fourth straight year, a second country outside the United States. Of those 104 players, 86 claim Minnesota as their native state. Three players call Kansas home, two hail from Iowa, two from Illinois, two from Hawaii, two from Texas, and one player from California, Colorado and Florida represent the Stars and Stripes. Mexico once again makes its presence felt on this year's roster as it is the homeland of four Gusties, all of whom hail from Cancun.

**THE SERIES...** This afternoon's game is the second meeting between the Gustavus and Lake Forest football programs. Last season, the Gusties defeated the Foresters 42-9 in Lake Forest, Illinois. Lake Forest is a member of the Midwest Conference (MWC), which was created in the spring of 1994 with the merger of the Midwest Collegiate Athletic Conference (MCAC) and the Midwest Athletic Conference for Women (MACW). Gustavus holds a 7-2 record against MWC schools as the Gusties are 1-0 against Lake Forest and 6-2 against St. Norbert.

**MEET THE HEAD COACHES...** Gustavus Head Coach Peter Haugen is in his seventh season at the helm of the Gustavus football program. Haugen has a combined record of 26-35 after one game into season seven. A graduate of Bethel University, Haugen was the head coach at Washburn High School in Minneapolis prior to coming to Gustavus.

Jim Catanzaro enters his seventh season as the head coach of Lake Forest. Catanzaro has a combined record of 27-34 in his first seven seasons, including an 8-1 conference mark in 2012, which earned the Foresters a share of the conference title. A graduate of Greenville College, Catanzaro spent time as a coach at Wingate University and Glenville State College prior to coming to Lake Forest.

**BIG DAY FOR MATT BOYCE...** Senior wide receiver Matt Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.) turned in a career day in Gustavus's season-opener against Crown. Boyce led the receiving corps with 217 yards on eight catches and two touchdowns. The 217-yard mark is the third most receiving yards in a single game in program history. Both of his touchdown grabs, which came from 77 and 20 yards out, occurred in the first half.

Saturday was the seventh time in Boyce's career that he tallied 150 or more yards receiving in a game. Last season the Minnetonka High School graduate notched 150-yard-plus receiving games against Crown, Hamline, Augsburg, Carleton and Saint John's. With 217 yards last Saturday, Boyce became the third receiver in Gustavus history with more than 2,000 career yards. Boyce now has 2,194 career receiving yards, third all-time behind Ryan Hoag '03 (2,232) and Chad Arlt '09 (3,180).

**FAST START...** With 49 points by halftime and 28 of those points coming in the first quarter, the Gusties hope the trend of getting off to a fast start continues the remainder of the season. Of Gustavus' 379 total points in 2014, 207 were scored in

the first half. The second was Gustavus' top scoring quarter a year ago with an average of 11.4 points coming out of the second frame.

**RED ZONE SCORING...** The Gustavus offense went 6-for-7 in red zone scoring against Crown. All six red zone scores were touchdowns. The Foresters were 3-for-3 in the red zone with three touchdowns.

**SCOUTING LAKE FOREST...** The Lake Forest football team dropped its season opener last Saturday in heartbreaking fashion, losing 38-37 in double overtime to Wisconsin Lutheran College. Tailback Charlie Quinn (Jr., Scottsdale, Ariz.) carried the ball a career-high 34 times for 143 yards and a touchdown. Lake Forest racked up 449 yards of offense, the team's highest total in nearly three seasons.

Quinn led a rushing attack that gained 190 yards. Senior quarterback Sean Dickson (Sr., Westlake, Texas) was next on the team with 19 rushing yards and a score. He also completed 18-of-32 passes for 217 yards, two touchdowns, and an interception. Wide receivers Willie McIntyre (Sr., Long Beach, Calif.) and George Vidas (Sr., Chicago, Ill.) shared team-high honors with six receptions apiece and both scored a touchdown. McIntyre finished with a career-high 114 yards.

Safety Pat Clark (Sr., Naperville, Ill.) led the Forester defense with 10 tackles and added an interception. Linebacker Michael Cole (So., Scottsdale, Ariz.) was next with nine stops and cornerback Chase Slagboom (So., Spring Lake, Mich.) finished with seven tackles, a pair of interceptions, and a fumble recovery.

Wisconsin Lutheran needed just four plays to reach the end zone in the first overtime and take its first lead of the contest. Dickson found Vidas for six yards on fourth-and-five and later found wide receiver Alex Pasiewicz (Jr., Beach Park, Ill.) in the end zone on a fourth-and-nine play from the 13-yardline. Jon Gurchak's (Sr., Graylake Ill.) extra point tied the score at 31 and forced a second overtime.

Twenty-nine rushing yards by Quinn helped the Foresters overcome a holding penalty in the second overtime and Dickson's quarterback sneak from inside the one put the home team ahead 37-31. The team was unable to execute the extra point, however, a mistake that would prove costly. The visitors drove for a touchdown of their own and converted the extra point for the victory.



## MIAC Special Teams Player-of-the-Week

The St. Thomas football team put up a big number in Saturday's 62-7 season-opening win at UW-Eau Claire, with senior kicker Paul Graupner (Minnetonka, Minn./Benilde-St. Margaret's) contributing to the team's impressive point total with a perfect placekicking performance. Graupner was a perfect 8-for-8 combined on field goals and extra points, and his kickoffs gave UST an edge in the field-position battle.



## SCOUTING THE GUSTIES...

The Gustavus Adolphus football team started its 2015 season last Saturday on a positive note with a convincing 56-13 victory at Crown College in non-conference action. The Gusties accumulated 683 yards of total offense, breaking the program record for most total yards of offense in a game, which previously stood at 650 yards in a 49-14 victory over Concordia in 1998.

After one week of Division III football across the county, Gustavus ranks third in the nation in total offense with 683 yards and fourth in passing offense with 420 yards. Quarterback Mitch Hendricks (Sr., Laporte, Minn.) ranks fourth among Division III quarterbacks with 385 yards passing, while wide receiver Matt Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) ranks second with 217 receiving yards.

Last Saturday, most of the offense's yards came in the first half as Gustavus jumped out to a 28-0 lead after the first quarter and entered the locker room at halftime with a comfortable 49-6 advantage. After throwing an interception on the first offensive play of the game, the Gusties found a groove and scored touchdowns on their next six drives.

By the time the final whistle blew, Gustavus compiled 263 yards rushing and 420 passing for its record-setting 683 yards of total offense. The offense tallied 73 plays for an average of 9.4 yards per play. Hendricks completed 25-of-32 passes for 385 yards, four touchdowns and two interceptions. Gabe Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) was Hendricks' favorite target, hauling in nine receptions for 71 yards and a touchdown. Matt Boyce led the receiving corps with 217 yards on eight catches and two touchdowns. Boyce's 217 yards receiving is third most in a single game in program history. Leeland Lauti (So., Ewa, Hawaii) led the ground attack, rushing 10 times for 101 yards and a touchdown. Tyler Jakes (Jr., North Mankato, Minn.) Kysten Zierke (So., Blue Earth, Minn.) and Anders Raarup (So., Eagan, Minn.) paced the defensive front with six tackles each.

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is in his seventh year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College.

Last season, the Gustavus football team matched its 2013 campaign with an overall record of 6-4 and a MIAC mark of 4-4. The Golden Gusties started the season on a tear, winning their first six games, which was the best start to a season since the 1987 team went 10-0 and claimed the MIAC title. Last season's hot start was highlighted by conference wins over Hamline, Augsburg, Carleton and St. Olaf. Offense was the name of the game as the Gusties averaged 47.5 points per game during that four-game stretch. Of the four losses, three were by 10 points or less.

In the MIAC's post-season honors, first team all-conference recipients included senior kicker Thomas Scheusener (Rapid City, S.D.), junior quarterback Mitch Hendricks (Bemidji, Minn.), junior wide receiver Matt Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.), junior wide receiver Gabriel Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.) and junior offensive lineman Marcus Kelly (Woodbury, Minn.). Matt Boyce, Gabriel Boyce and Mitch Hendricks were later named to the D3football.com All-West Region Team, while Matt Boyce was selected to the D3football.com All-America Team.

In six seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 25-35 and a MIAC record of 18-30.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 98-year history of Gustavus football. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 235 institutions) with a 58.0 winning percentage (479-343-21). The Gusties will soon join an elite group of 40 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 30 players who have received All-America honors, 13 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships. Most recently, wide receiver Matt Boyce '16 was named to the D3football.com All-America Team.

**St. Bonifacius, Minn.** – The Gustavus Adolphus football team started the 2015 season Saturday on a positive note with a convincing 56-13 victory at Crown College in non-conference action.

The Gusties accumulated 683 yards of total offense, breaking the program record for most total yards of offense in a game, which previously stood at 650 yards in a 49-17 victory over Concordia in 1998.

"Solid first game for our team," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "Great energy early. We need to clean up penalties and learn from our mistakes."

Most of the yards Saturday came in the first half as Gustavus jumped out to a 28-0 lead after the first quarter and entered the locker room at halftime with a comfortable 49-6 advantage.

Leeland Lauti (So., Ewa, Hawaii) got the game going with an 11-yard touchdown run at the 8:42 mark in the first quarter. The touchdown run capped an 11-play, 91-yard drive.

The Gustie defense forced a three-and-out on the next possession, which was highlighted by a sack by Tyler Jakes (Jr., North Mankato, Minn.) for a 10-yard loss. The Black and Gold then started at its own 32 and drove the field in five plays, ending with a four-yard touchdown from Mitch Hendricks (Sr., Bemidji, Minn.) to Gabe Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) to take a 14-0 lead after the Brendan Boche (So., Lakeville, Minn.) extra point.

Another three-and-out by the Gustie defense put the ball back into the offense's hands at its own 28. After a false start put the Gusties back five yards, Hendricks then fired a strike to Matt Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) for a 77-yard touchdown with 4:58 left in the first quarter.

Crown got its first first down on the ensuing possession, but on the seventh play of the drive, the Storm were forced to punt. Gustavus started at its own 34 and after five plays and a first down, Hendricks connected with George Buchner (Jr., Excelsior, Minn.) for a 52-yard touchdown to take a 27-0 lead. The Boche extra point made it 28-0.

On the ensuing kickoff, Sergio De Pablos Velez (Jr., Cancun, Mexico) forced a fumble that was recovered by Nathan Hajder (So., Rogers, Minn.) at the Crown 30. The offense gained two first downs on its next two plays and the whistle blew to end the first quarter with the Gusties leading 28-0 and the ball on the Crown four-yard line.

DaiVon Poole (So., San Angelo, Texas) then started the second quarter with a four-yard touchdown to make it 35-0 after the Boche extra point.

Crown finally got on the scoreboard after a 10-play, 75-yard drive, ending with a two-yard touchdown pass. The extra point failed and the score read 35-6 Gustavus with 9:49 left in the second quarter.

The Gusties started the next drive at their own 18 and drove the field in 10 plays, finishing with a 20-yard touchdown pass from Hendricks to Matt Boyce. Another Boche extra point made it 42-6 Gustavus.

Another three-and-out by the Gustie defense gave the ball back to the offense at its own 34. On the fourth play of the drive, Hendricks was intercepted, but the Crown offense was unable to capitalize and its drive faltered after five plays. The Storm's punt was downed at the Gustavus two-yard line with 3:12 left in the half.

Starting in the shadow of its own goal post, the Gustie offense used two big passing plays to drive the field for a touchdown in nine plays. The first big-yardage play was a 27-yard Hendricks-to-Matt Boyce connection on a third and 10 from the two-yard line. And the next was a 46-yard touchdown pass once again from Hendricks to Matt Boyce. The Boche extra point gave the Gusties a 49-6 advantage with 1:03 left in the half, and that score stood at half time.

After a frenzy of offense in the first two quarters, neither team was able to reach the end zone in the third. Crown fumbled the ball on its first drive of the quarter, which was recovered by Jakes at the Crown 45. The Gusties got down to the 11-yard line, but Boche missed a 28-yard field goal wide left.

Crown's ensuing drive went 14 plays and 58 yards, but ended on another fumble on a fourth down attempt.

Gustavus followed with a three-and-out on the next possession and the Storm started their next drive at their own 35. After three plays and a first down, the whistle blew and the third quarter ended with the Gusties leading 49-6.

Crown continued its drive in the fourth quarter and found the end zone after seven plays, finishing on a four-yard rushing touchdown.

Gustavus couldn't get much going on its next drive and went three-and-out.

The Storm responded with a 10-play drive, but Josh Curtis (Fy., Houston, Texas) recorded his first collegiate interception and gave the Gusties the ball at their own 35.

With Sam Lundberg (Sr., Ellendale, Minn.) in at quarterback in place of Hendricks, Lundberg directed a 13-play, 65-yard drive that ended on a one-yard quarterback keeper for a touchdown with 2:06 remaining in the game. The Boche extra point made it 56-13 and the score stood for a final.

Gustavus compiled 263 yards rushing and 420 passing for its record-setting 683 yards of total offense. The offense tallied 73 plays and average 9.4 yards per play.

Hendricks completed 25-of-32 passes for 385 yards and four touchdowns. He also had two interceptions.

Gabe Boyce was Hendricks' favorite target, hauling in nine receptions for 71 yards and a touchdown.

Matt Boyce led the receiving corps with 217 yards on eight catches and two touchdowns. Boyce's 217 yards receiving is third most in a single game in program history.

Lauti led the ground attack, rushing 10 times for 101 yards and a touchdown.

Jakes, Kysten Zierke (So., Blue Earth, Minn.) and Anders Raarup (Eagan, Minn.) paced the defensive front with six tackles each.

Gustavus starts the season 1-0 overall and returns to St. Peter Saturday for its home opener against Lake Forest College. Kickoff is slated for 1 p.m.
