GUSTIES TAKE TO GRIDIRON FOR 99TH

SEASON...The Gustavus football team continues its 99th season today at Lloyd Hollingsworth Field for its Homecoming game. Over the previous 98 seasons, the Gusties have compiled a record of 479-343-21, including a record of 222-126-8 in St. Peter. With 22 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) championships, Gustavus has claimed the second-most league titles in the 95-year history of the conference. Only Saint John's (32) has claimed more MIAC championships.

FOLLOW THE GUSTIES ON KNUJ...KNUJ

AM 860 out of New Illm Minnesota once again broadcasts all 10 Gustavus regular season football games. The voice of the Golden Gusties Tom Wheeler handles the play-by-play duties for the 10th consecutive season. Wheeler is once again joined by 1984 Gustavus graduate and former Gustie football player Ken Ericson on the live call of this year's games. Fans can listen to the KNUJ broadcasts on the Internet through the Gustavus Athletics website. Calling All Captains... Of over 5,000 student-athletes who have played football for Gustavus in the 99-year history of the program, only 195 have earned the privilege to serve as team captain. Peter Haugen's captains this season include seniors Mitch Hendricks, Zach Martinez, Nick Frandsen and Marcus Kelly.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP... In what has become a trend of Head Coach Peter Haguen's tenure, the 2015 Gustavus football roster once again features a great deal of senior leadership. With 23 seniors on this year's squad, the Gustavus roster is tied for the third-most seniors on any Gustie football team since the turn of the century. The 2003 (28), 2002 (26), 2011 (23) and 2014 (23) teams are the only squads during that span to have more or as many seniors wearing Black and Gold. This year's senior class features four defensive lineman, four defensive backs. four offensive lineman, three tight ends, two wide receivers, two quarterbacks, two linebackers, one running back and one kicker.

GUSTIE FOOTBALL AROUND THE

GLOBE... The 2015 Gustavus football team features a total of 104 players from nine different states and, for the fourth straight year, a second country outside the United States. Of those 104 players, 86 claim Minnesota as their native state. Three players call Kansas home, two hail from lowa, two from Illinois, two from Hawaii, two from Texas, and one player from California, Colorado and Florida represent the Starts and Stripes. Mexico once again makes its presence felt on this year's roster as it is the homeland of four Gusties. all of whom hail from Cancun.

THE SERIES... Saturday's game is the 74th meeting between the Gustavus and Augsburg football programs. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 55-18-0. Gustavus has scored more points against Augsburg than any other school in the 98-year history of the program with a total of 2,106 points in 73 games (28.8 points per game). Last season, the Gusties defeated the Auggies 55-31 on Sept. 27 in Minneapolis, Minn. Leading 20-10 at halftime, the Gusties exploded for 35 second half points en route to a 24-point victory.

MEET THE HEAD COACHES... Gustavus Head Coach Peter Haugen is in his seventh season at the helm of the Gustavus football program. Haugen has a combined record of 28-35 after three games into season seven. A graduate of Bethel University, Haugen was the head coach at Washburn High School in Minneapolis prior to coming to Gustavus.

Augsburg Head Coach Frank Haege is in his 11th season leading the Auggies on the gridiron. Haege has a combined record of 44-59 after beginning his Augsburg coaching career 2-18. A 1992 graduate of the University of Wisconsin-Stout, Haege was an assistant coach for the Auggies for three seasons before becoming the head coach in 2005.

HOMECOMING... Gustavus is celebrating its 91st Homecoming Saturday, continuing a tradition started on Nov. 8, 1924, when the Gusties defeated Saint John's 33-0 on Hallander Field. Gustavus has enjoyed a good deal of success on Homecoming Day, compiling an all-time record of 62-26-2. In last season's Homecoming game against Carleton, the Gusties treated a crowd of more than 3,000 to a 50-0 victory in what was one of the their best offensive performances of the season. The Gusties accumulated a season-high 204 yards rushing and the second most total yards of the season with 601 yards. In 83 Homecoming contests, Gustavus has compiled a 56-25-2 record against conference opponents, including a 6-1 mark against Augsburg. The last meeting between these two teams on Gustavus' Homecoming came on Oct. 8, 2005 and resulted in a 42-27 victory for the home

squad. The win was the first of the season for the Gusties after starting the 2005 campaign 0-5. Quarterback Jordan Stolp completed 20-of-38 passes for 252 yards and five touchdowns. Mitch Anderson rushed the ball 21 times for 90 yards. Adam Miron and Jared Sieling led the defense with eight tackles apiece.

CHASING HISTORY... From 2005-07, the pass and catch combination of Jordan Stolp '08 to Chad Arlt '09 proved to be the best quarterback-receiver combination in the history of Gustavus football. Stolp finished his career with 8,496 passing yards, while Arlt finished his career with 3,180 receiving yards - both program records. From 2013 to present day, the pass and catch combination of seniors Mitch Hendricks to Matt Boyce is proving to rival that of the Stolp-Arlt connection eight years ago. After three games this season, Hendricks has 6,386 career passing yards and is averaging 348.3 yard per game this season. If he stays on that pace, Hendricks would surpass Stolp to become Gustavus' all-time leader in passing yards. Meanwhile, Boyce currently has 2,448 career receiving yards and is averaging 157.0 yards per game this season. Boyce would need to average 105 yards in the remaining seven games to surpass Arlt as the all-time receiving leader at Gustavus. In the NCAA Division III ranks, Hendricks' 1,045 passing yards this season ranks fourth in the nation, his .757 completion percentage is fifth, and his 72 points responsible for ranks sixth. Boyce currently ranks third in the nation with 471 receiving yards and his six receiving touchdowns also rank third in the country.

NEXT MAN UP... Prior to game one this season, starting running back Luke Martinez suffered an injury, which has him sidelined for the foreseeable future. Leeland Lauti was next in line and responded well with 10 carries for 101 yards and a touchdown in week one against Crown, Lauti followed in week two with 17 carries for 109 vards and a touchdown against Lake Forest, but was injured during the game as has been on the sidelines since. Down to their No. 3 running back, the Gusties turned to DaiVon Poole in week three and he didn't miss a beat. rushing the ball 15 times for 107 yards and three touchdowns in the win at Hamline. But the injury bug hit Poole as well as he is questionable today. With such a deep running back class, the Gusties also used Karim Ortiz in week three as Ortiz rushed

MIAC Offensive Player-of-the-Week

Tyrell Martin, Augsburg West St. Paul, Minn. / Henry Sibley

The Augsburg offense was in high-gear in Saturday's MIAC opener. The Auggies racked up 54 points in a 54-28 win over Carleton, with running back Tyrell Martin (West St. Paul, Minn./Henry Sibloy) doing a lot of the beautiffing. The senior ran for

MIAC Defensive Player-of-the-Week

Erik Byr, Concordia Moorhead, Minn. / Moorhead

The Concordia football team came up just short in its attempt to topple eighth-ranked Saint John's, the defending MIAC champion.

Despite Saturday's 24-16 loss, the Cobber defense played admirably led by linebacker Erik Bye (Moorhead, Minn.). The senior more than doubled his career high in tackles with 17 to lead the Concordia defense.

MIAC Special Teams Player-of-the-Week

Jake Swanberg, Hamline Le Sueur, Minn. / Le Sueur -Henderson

The Hamline football team nearly completed a furious comeback to topple Gustavus on Saturday, only to come up just short in a thrilling 42-35 loss. Piper senior Jack Swanberg (LeSueur, Minn./Le Sueur-Henderson) did all he could to ignite the rally on special teams with two blocked kicks and a key recovery of an onside kick, in addition to a great game on defense.

13 times for 68 yards and a touchdown. Ortiz is looked upon to fill in at running back in a position group that is suffering from a long list of injuries.

SCORING SPREE... Through the first three games of the season, the 2015 Gustavus football team boasts the best scoring average in program history. So far, the Gusties have scored a total of 147 points for an average of 49.0 points per game, which ranks 14th in the nation. The 1979 team held the previous record with 136 points for an average of 45.3 points per game thanks to wins over Augustana (45-27), Hamline (35-13) and St. Thomas (56-32). However, the 2015 Gusties have a tough task to stay at the top in the program's record book as the 1979 team scored a school record 69 points in its fourth game of the season against National Polytechnic (69-12).

SCOUTING THE AUGGIES... The Augsburg football team improved to 2-1 overall and 1-0 in the MIAC after a convincing 54-28 victory over Carleton College last Saturday in Minneapolis, Minn. Ayrton Scott (Sr., Minneapolis, Minn.) and Tyrell Martin (Sr., West St. Paul, Minn.) each rushed for 154 yards and each scored two touchdowns.

Augsburg trailed 21-20 at halftime, but outscored Carleton 34-7 in the second half, scoring on five of its seven second-half drives to reach the 54-point mark for the second straight week. As a team, Augsburg outgained Carleton by a 534-375 margin. Augsburg had 347 rushing yards and 187 passing yards, while Carleton had 204 passing yards and 171 rushing yards.

Scott rushed for 154 yards on 18 carries and scored two rushing touchdowns, while completing 15-of-21 passes for 187 yards and three touchdowns against one interception. He rushed for a 20-yard touchdown in the first quarter and a one-yard touchdown early in the fourth quarter. Scott's three touchdown passes were to Derek Ruff (Sr., Shoreview, Minn.) in the second quarter, Scott Bossard (Sr., North Branch, Minn.) in the third quarter and Jorden Gannon (So., Roseville, Minn.) in the fourth quarter. The Auggies leading receiver on the season, Joey Sonnenfeld (Sr., Maple Grove, Minn.), caught nine passes for 109 yards.

Martin rushed for 100-plus yards for the second time in his three starts this season, rushing for an 11-yard score in the first quarter and a 64-yard score in the third quarter. Tiras Bolton (So., Omaha, Neb.)

rushed for 41 yards on six carries, including a 20-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter.

Defensively, Raymond Carter (So., Jordan, Minn.) led the way for the Auggies with 10 tackles, while Matt Bowlin (Jr., Chanhassen, Minn.) had eight tackles. Tyler Sis (Sr., Brooklyn Park, Minn.) and Christopher Hanson (Sr., New Prague, Minn.) each had quarterback sacks. Sis recorded seven tackles, including three tackles for-loss.

Peter Haugen, a native of Minneapolis and a 1991 graduate of Bethel University, is in his seventh year as head football coach at Gustavus Adolphus College.

Last season, the Gustavus football team matched its 2013 campaign with an overall record of 6-4 and a MIAC mark of 4-4. The Golden Gusties started the season on a tear, winning their first six games, which was the best start to a season since the 1987 team went 10-0 and claimed the MIAC title. Last season's hot start was highlighted by conference wins over Hamline, Augsburg, Carleton and St. Olaf. Offense was the name of the game as the Gusties averaged 47.5 points per game during that four-game stretch. Of the four losses, three were by 10 points or less.

In the MIAC's post-season honors, first team all-conference recipients included senior kicker Thomas Scheusener (Rapid City, S.D.), junior quarterback Mitch Hendricks (Bemidji, Minn.), junior wide receiver Matt Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.), junior wide receiver Gabriel Boyce (Excelsior, Minn.) and junior offensive lineman Marcus Kelly (Woodbury, Minn.). Matt Boyce, Gabriel Boyce and Mitch Hendricks were later named to the D3football.com All-West Region Team, while Matt Boyce was selected to the D3football.com All-America Team.

In six seasons at the head of the Gustavus Adolphus football program, Haugen has compiled an overall record of 25-35 and a MIAC record of 18-30.

Haugen, who was the head football coach at Washburn High School for 15 years prior to coming to Gustavus, compiled an overall record of 111-44 during that span, while winning 11 league championships and posting a league record of 76-8. He directed the Millers to the Class AAAA quarterfinals in 2007 finishing with a mark of 9-3. In his last season as the Millers' head coach, Haugen's squad posted a mark of 8-2. While building the program at Washburn, Haugen increased player participation from 35 players in 1994 to 110 players in 2008. He also implemented academic monitoring and meal programs for student-athletes as well as creating and directing the highly successful Washburn Athletic Leadership Academy. He has also served as the chair of the Minneapolis Football Conference and he is an active clinician working at many local and regional clinics including the NIKE Coach of the Year clinic. Haugen was also a member of the Metro coaching staff for the Minnesota All-Star game in 1998. He started his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as the offensive line coach during the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

A three-sport standout at Bethel, Haugen was a starting tight end on the football team, a starting goaltender on the hockey team, and a starting catcher on the baseball team in the late '80s and early '90s. In his senior year, he earned all-conference honors in football, and was selected Most Valuable Player of the hockey team.

Haugen became the 17th head coach in the 98-year history of Gustavus football. The Golden Gusties have a long and storied football tradition that includes 22 MIAC titles. The program ranks in the top-50 all-time in Division III (out of 235 institutions) with a 58.0 winning percentage (479–343–21). The Gusties will soon join an elite group of 40 NCAA Division III institutions whose football teams have won 500 games.

Along with great teams, Gustavus has also been blessed with many outstanding individual players, which includes 30 players who have received All-America honors, 13 who have received CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, and five who have received NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships. Most recently, wide receiver Matt Boyce '16 was named to the D3football.com All-America Team.

CROWN 13 GUSTAVUS 56

St. Bonifacius, Minn. (623) Klein Bank Stadium 88°, Sunny

St. Bonifacius, Minn. – The Gustavus Adolphus football team started the 2015 season Saturday on a positive note with a convincing 56-13 victory at Crown College in non-conference action.

The Gusties accumulated 683 yards of total offense, breaking the program record for most total yards of offense in a game, which previously stood at 650 yards in a 49-17 victory over Concordia in 1998.

"Solid first game for our team," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "Great energy early. We need to clean up penalties and learn from our mistakes."

Most of the yards Saturday came in the first half as Gustavus jumped out to a 28-0 lead after the first quarter and entered the locker room at halftime with a comfortable 49-6 advantage.

Leeland Lauti (So., Ewa, Hawaii) got the game going with an 11-yard touchdown run at the 8:42 mark in the first quarter. The touchdown run capped an 11-play. 91-yard drive.

The Gustie defense forced a three-and-out on the next possession, which was highlighted by a sack by Tyler Jakes (Jr., North Mankato, Minn.) for a 10-yard loss. The Black and Gold then started at its own 32 and drove the field in five plays, ending with a four-yard touchdown from Mitch Hendricks (Sr., Bemidji, Minn.) to Gabe Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) to take a 14-0 lead after the Brendan Boche (So., Lakeville, Minn.) extra point.

Another three-and-out by the Gustie defense put the ball back into the offense's hands at its own 28. After a false start put the Gusties back five yards, Hendricks then fired a strike to Matt Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) for a 77-yard touchdown with 4:58 left in the first guarter.

Crown got its first first down on the ensuing possession, but on the seventh play of the drive, the Storm were forced to punt. Gustavus started at its own 34 and after five plays and a first down, Hendricks connected with George Buchner (Jr., Excelsior, Minn.) for a 52-yard touchdown to take a 27-0 lead. The Boche extra point made it 28-0.

On the ensuing kickoff, Sergio De Pablos Velez (Jr., Cancun, Mexico) forced a fumble that was recovered by Nathan Hajder (So., Rogers, Minn.) at the Crown 30. The offense gained two first downs on its next two plays and the whistle blew to end the first quarter with the Gusties leading 28-0 and the ball on the Crown four-vard line.

DaiVon Poole (So., San Angelo, Texas) then started the second quarter with a four-yard touchdown to make it 35-0 after the Boche extra point.

Crown finally got on the scoreboard after a 10-play, 75-yard drive, ending with a two-yard touchdown pass. The extra point failed and the score read 35-6 Gustavus with 9:49 left in the second quarter.

The Gusties started the next drive at their own 18 and drove the field in 10 plays, finishing with a 20-yard touchdown pass from Hendricks to Matt Boyce. Another Boche extra point made it 42-6 Gustavus.

Another three-and-out by the Gustie defense gave the ball back to the offense at its own 34. On the fourth play of the drive, Hendricks was intercepted, but the Crown offense was unable to capitalize and its drive faltered after five plays. The Storm's punt was downed at the Gustavus two-yard line with 3:12 left in the

Starting in the shadow of its own goal post, the Gustie offense used two big passing plays to drive the field for a touchdown in nine plays. The first big-yardage play was a 27-yard Hendricks-to-Matt Boyce connection on a third and 10 from the two-yard line. And the next was a 46-yard touchdown pass once again from Hendricks to Matt Boyce. The Boche extra point gave the Gusties a 49-6 advantage with 1:03 left in the half, and that score stood at half time.

After a frenzy of offense in the first two quarters, neither team was able to reach the end zone in the third. Crown fumbled the ball on its first drive of the quarter, which was recovered by Jakes at the Crown 45. The Gusties got down to the 11-yard line, but Boche missed a 28-yard field goal wide left.

Crown's ensuing drive went 14 plays and 58 yards, but ended on another fumble on a fourth down attempt.

Gustavus followed with a three-and-out on the next possession and the Storm started their next drive at their own 35. After three plays and a first down, the whistle blew and the third quarter ended with the Gusties leading 49-6.

Crown continued its drive in the fourth quarter and found the end zone after seven plays, finishing on a four-yard rushing touchdown.

Gustavus couldn't get much going on its next drive and went three-and-out.

The Storm responded with a 10-play drive, but Josh Curtis (Fy., Houston, Texas) recorded his first collegiate interception and gave the Gusties the ball at their own 35.

With Sam Lundberg (Sr., Ellendale, Minn.) in at quarterback in place of Hendricks, Lundberg directed a 13-play, 65-yard drive that ended on a one-yard quarterback keeper for a touchdown with 2:06 remaining in the game. The Boche extra point made it 56-13 and the score stood for a final.

Gustavus compiled 263 yards rushing and 420 passing for its record-setting 683 yards of total offense. The offense tallied 73 plays and average 9.4 yards per play.

Hendricks completed 25-of-32 passes for 385 yards and four touchdowns. He also had two interceptions.

Gabe Boyce was Hendricks' favorite target, hauling in nine receptions for 71 yards and a taurhdown

Matt Boyce led the receiving corps with 217 yards on eight catches and two touchdowns. Boyce's 217 yards receiving is third most in a single game in program history.

Lauti led the ground attack, rushing 10 times for 101 yards and a touchdown.

Jakes, Kysten Zierke (So., Blue Earth, Minn.) and Anders Raarup (Eagan, Minn.) paced the defensive front with six tackles each.

Gustavus starts the season 1-0 overall and returns to St. Peter Saturday for its home opener against Lake Forest College. Kickoff is slated for 1 p.m.



LAKE FOREST 0 **GUSTAVUS** 49

St. Peter, Minn. (1,648) **Hollingsworth Field** 65°, Sunny, pleasant

ST. PETER, Minn. – After starting Saturday's game against Lake Forest with a fumble and a punt on its first two offensive possessions, the Gustavus football team regrouped and ended its next five drives with touchdowns en route to a 49-0 shutout over the Foresters at Hollingsworth Field.

The win was a complete team effort as the offense amassed 530 total yards, while the defense held Lake Forest to 288 yards with two interceptions.

After a slow start, the Gustie offense cracked the scoreboard with 52 seconds remaining in the first quarter. Mitch Hendricks (Sr., Laporte, Minn.) found a hole through the middle of the Foresters defense and ran seven yards for a touchdown. The touchdown run capped a 12-play, 80-yard drive that lasted 4:12.

Lake Forest went three-and-out on the ensuing possession and the Gusties started their next drive at the Foresters 45-vard line five seconds into the second guarter. Gustavus then put together a nine-play drive and ended it on a seven-yard strike from Hendricks to Gabe Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) for a touchdown.

Lake Forest responded with an impressive 17-play, 83-yard drive, but it didn't end in favor of the visitors. On a fourth-and-one try from the Gustavus three-yard line, Kyle Krzmarzick (Sr., Sleepy Eye, Minn.) stuffed a rushing attempt for no gain, giving the Gusties the ball.

Starting the following drive with its heels in its own end zone, the Gustie offense rolled off a number of big gains throughout the possession and ended the nine-play, 97-yard drive with a one-yard touchdown run by Leeland Lauti (So., Ewa, Hawaii). The drive included five first downs, one of which featured a 26-yard run down the home sideline by Lauti.

On the ensuing kickoff, Michael Heitzman (Fy., Spicer, Minn.) forced a fumble, which was recovered by the Black and Gold at the Lake Forest 31. After a penalty to start the drive, Hendricks found Matt Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) for an acrobatic catch in the end zone, giving Gustavus its fourth touchdown of the half. The Brendan Boche (So., Lakeville, Minn.) extra point made it 28-0, which stood as the score at halftime.

Gustavus started the third quarter with the ball at its own 40 after a 28-yard return by George Buchner (Jr., Excelsior, Minn.). Two quick 10-plus-yard passes from Hendricks to Gabe Boyce got the Gusties into Forester territory and they continued to drive down the field. Six plays later, Hendricks connected with Matt Boyce for a five-yard touchdown pass and with the Boche extra point the Gusties led 35-0 three minutes into the second half.

After the Gustavus defensive unit recorded a three-and-out, the offense gave the ball right back to Lake Forest on an interception. But three plays into the ensuing Lake Forest drive, the Gustie defense came up big again, returning the favor with an interception by Tyler Jakes (Jr., North Mankato, Minn.). The interception was Jakes' first career pick as he returned the pass 11 yards to the Lake Forest 43.

The offense made good use of the turnover as it drove the field in four plays, ending on a 16yard pass from Hendricks to Matt Boyce.

On the ensuing Forester drive, Levi Gibbs (Sr., LaPorte, Colo.) came away with an interception – his first career – on a tipped pass, giving the Gusties the ball back at the Lake Forest 44.

Once again, the Gustie offense turned the interception into points as Hendricks connected with Buchner for a 23-yard touchdown pass with 1:45 left in the third. Another Boche extra point made it 49-0 in favor of the home squad.

Neither team was able to find the end zone in the fourth quarter and the Gusties finished their non-conference schedule with another convincing win.

Hendricks had another impressive day as the play-caller. The Laporte, Minn. native went 28-for-35 with five touchdowns and two interceptions. He also added a rushing touchdown.

Matt Boyce was Hendricks' favorite target, hauling in 10 receptions for 136 yards and three touchdowns. Gabe Boyce added nine catches for 93 yards and a score.

Lauti led the rushing game with 17 carries for 109 yards and a touchdown.

Defensively, Jakes posted 10 tackles and an interception, Nick Francisco (Sr., North Oaks, Minn.) added eight stops, including two pass breakups and 1.5 tackles for loss.

Gustavus improves to 2-0 overall and begins its Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference schedule next Saturday at Hamline University. Kickoff is slated for 7 p.m.

"It's going to be a great challenge for us, no guestion about it." Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "The MIAC is now the number one league in the country so we know there are going to be tougher days ahead. We just need to get back to work Monday and start preparing."

HAMLINE 35 GUSTAVUS 42

St. Paul, Minn. (2,138) Klas Field 64°, Night, clear

ST. PAUL, Minn. – The Gustavus football team held off a late comeback Saturday night at Hamline University, coming away with an exciting 42-35 victory over the Pipers to improve to 3-0 overall and 1-0 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference

"We made enough plays to win and that's important," Head Coach Peter Haugen said. "Finding ways to win is important, but we certainly need to get better in all phases of the game. We had a turnover deep in our end, they had some long plays and we had a couple special team blunders. But we showed some resiliency and won the game."

The Gusties scored touchdowns on their first four drives of the game and looked every bit in control with a 28-7 lead midway through the second quarter. But the Pipers chipped away at the lead with a pair of unanswered touchdowns to end the first half and went into the break trailing the Gusties by seven.

Gustavus controlled the third quarter with a pair of touchdowns to take a comfortable 42-21 advantage, but once again, the Pipers responded with a pair of touchdowns late in the fourth quarter to make it a one-possession game. Facing third down and nine from the Hamline 48 and 2:02 left in the game, Mitch Hendricks (Sr., Bemidji, Minn.) heaved a high pass down the right sideline to Matt Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) and Boyce came down with the jump ball at the 16-yard line for a first down that proved to be the final straw. The Gusties then ran out the clock and found a way to win against a conference opponent on the road.

Gustavus started with the ball at its own 28 to begin the game and marched down the field in nine plays, capped by a five-yard touchdown run by DaiVon Poole (So., San Angelo, Texas).

Hamline converted one first down on the ensuing drive, but the Gustie defense forced a punt where the Pipers pinned the ball down at the four-yard line.

No stranger to starting drives in the shadow of its own goal post, the Gustie offense put together a 12-play, 96-yard drive to go ahead 14-0. Gustavus got into Hamline territory on its first three plays. The second play of the drive was a 21-yard pass-and-catch to tight end Jake Douglas (Sr., Montevideo, Minn.) and the third was a 43-yard strike to Matt Boyce. The drive ended on a six-yard touchdown rush by Poole.

Hamline scored it first points of the game on the ensuing drive. Starting at their own 25, the Pipers ended a four-play dive on a 32-yard touchdown pass.

Starting their next drive at their own 26, the Gusties made their way down to the Hamline 26 and then scored on a touchdown pass from Hendricks to Matt Boyce with 34 seconds left in the first quarter.

The Gustavus defense forced a three-and-out on the next Hamline possession, highlighted by a sack by Isaac Kotila (Jr., Buffalo. Minn.) for a 15-vard loss.

Gustavus received the punt at its own 43 and Gabe Boyce (Sr., Excelsior, Minn.) returned it 12 yards, giving the offense prime field position in Hamline territory. After a short gain on first down, Hendricks connected with tight end Harrison Feldkamp (Sr., Sibley, Iowa) for a 17-yard first down, which was followed by a 27-yard touchdown scamper by Poole for his third score of the game.

The Gustie defense forced another punt on the following drive, but Hendricks was picked off as the Pipers returned the interception down to the Gustavus one-yard line. It took them three plays, put the Pipers finally punched in the touchdown to make the score 28-14 with 7:25 left in the second quarter.

The Hamline defense fed off the momentum swing and forced a three-and-out on the following Gustie possession. After the punt, the Pipers started at their own 40 and drove the field in 11 plays, ending on a six-yard touchdown run to cut the deficit to seven points.

The Gusties got the ball down to the Hamline 33 and with seconds remaining in the first half, but a 50-yard field goal attempt by Brendan Boche (So., Lakeville, Minn.) was blocked and Gustavus entered the locker room at halftime with a 28-21 lead

Hamline started the second half with the ball, but Nick Frandsen (Sr., North Oaks, Minn.) put the pigskin back in the hands of the Black and Gold with interception on the fourth play of the drive. Frandsen returned the pick 40 yards to

the Hamline 37.

The Gustie offense made good on the turnover as Karim Ortiz (So., Cancun, Mexico) rushed 28 yards for a touchdown on the third play of the drive, putting the Gusties up 35-21 after the Boche extra point.

Gustavus' defense forced another three-and-out, but the ensuing drive ended on Hendricks' second interception of the game. Once again, the Gustie defense stood its ground – this time on a crucial fourth down attempt as Josh Curtis (Fy., Houston, Texas) made a tackle on the guarterback for a 10-yard loss.

With the ball at the Hamline 30, Gustavus capped a six-play drive on a five-yard touchdown rush by Hendricks to take a 42-21 advantage after the Boche extra point.

To start the fourth quarter, both teams stalled on their first possessions. On their second possession of the final quarter, the Gusties were forced to punt, which was blocked and returned for a 25-yard touchdown.

Trailing 42-28 with 4:26 remaining in the game, the Pipers elected to onside kick and did so successfully. Hamline then drove 49 yards on seven plays, capped by a 12-yard touchdown pass to make it a one-possession game.

After a timeout with 2:02 remaining in the game, Hendricks connected with Matt Boyce for the aforementioned first down strike to seal the victory.

The Gustavus offense had another big day, totaling 520 yards. Hendricks completed 31-of-44 passes for 307 yards, one touchdown and two interceptions. He also added a rushing touchdown.

Gabe Boyce was the top target with nine receptions for 70 yards. Matt Boyce compiled a team-high 118 yards on six catches and a touchdown.

The rushing game was led by Poole who had 15 carries for 107 yards and three touchdowns – a career best for yards and touchdowns in a game.

Defensively, Mason Kaliszewski (Jr., Maple Grove, Minn.) and Anders Raarup (So., Eagan, Minn.) led the way with seven stop apiece. Kaliszewski also added 2.5 tackles for a loss of 13 yards and a half sack.

Gustavus returns to Hollingsworth Field at 1 p.m., Sept. 26 for its Homecoming game against Augsburg College. Last season, the Gusties defeated the Auggies 55-31.

"We will do what we do every week in practice and clean it up," Haugen said about the team's preparation for Augsburg. "It's going to be a difficult challenge for us this week, but we'll be ready. I'm just excited for the guys after tonight."
