Setting The Scene: The Gustavus Adolphus College women's hockey team is set to take on Augsburg College in a home-home series this Friday and Saturday. Gustavus heads into the weekend with an overall record of 2-1-1 and MIAC mark of 1-1-0, while Augsburg enters the series at 3-1-0 overall and 2-0-0 in the conference. Friday's game will be played at Ed Saugestad Rink on the Augsburg campus in Minneapolis, with faceoff set for 7 p.m., while Saturday's game will be played at Don Roberts Ice Rink in St. Peter at 2 p.m.

Gustavus is most recently coming off a series split with No. 3 University of St. Thomas this past weekend. In Friday's game in St. Peter, the Gusties earned a 6-4 victory over the Tommies, thanks in large part to a hat trick from sophomore forward Diana Draayer (Deephaven, Minn.). Gustavus led 5-1 heading into the third, but the Tommies made a furious comeback in the final period and brought the score to 5-4. However, the Gusties held on and with the win, earned their first conference victory of the season.

Draayer scored each of her three goals in the first two periods to help the Gusties take a four-goal lead into the third, but St. Thomas scored twice in the first 1:17 of the final 20 to bring the score to 5-3. The Tommies scored again at the 7:17 mark of the third to bring the Gustie lead to one, but the Black and Gold's blue line held strong for the remainder of the game to secure the game.

Saturday proved to be a different story, and St. Thomas never trailed in a 5-3 win in Mendota Heights. St. Thomas jumped out to an early 3-0 lead after just 13 minutes of play, however, the Gusties would not go into their first intermission scoreless, as senior forward Allison Eder-Zdechlik (Stillwater, Minn.) notched a power play goal off to bring the score to 3-1 after 20 minutes of play. Gustavus got within one twice more throughout the game, but St. Thomas had the answer each time to come away with a series split.

Augsburg is most recently coming off a series sweep over St. Catherine University. In game one, first-year Valerie Whichello scored both goals for Augsburg in a 2-1 win over the Wildcats. After a scoreless first period, Whichello scored for the Auggies at the 13:39 mark of the second period and struck again at the 12:58 mark of the third. St. Catherine was able to cut the lead to 2-1 at 14:06 of the third, but Auggie goalie Erika Allen held strong to bring her record to 1-1-0 on the year.

In the Auggies second game, Augsburg scored twice in a 1:49 span in the third period, to complete a series sweep of the Wildcats in a 4-2 win in Minneapolis. After a scoreless first period, the Auggies scored twice in the final 6:32 of the second period to take a 2-1 lead into the second intermission. St. Catherine tied the game at the 3:45 mark of the third period, but Johnson gave the Auggies the lead back just 2:03 later, giving Augsburg the lead for good.

Series Snapshot: This weekend's series marks the 40th and 41st meetings between Gustavus and Augsburg in women's hockey. The Gusties hold the advantage in the all-time series with a record of 31-8-0 and have won their previous 25 games against the Auggies. The last time Gustavus lost to Augsburg was December 6, 2002, a 1-0 defeat in Minneapolis.

About The Auggies: In 2014-15, Augsburg finished one game back of a playoff berth after finishing its conference schedule 7-7-4.

This season, the Auggies have been led by the first-year Whichello who has scored three of the team's eight total goals and is tied for the team lead with three points. Allen has been the Auggie's goalie of choice, as the senior has played 179:01, compiled a record of 2-1-0, and has a save percentage of .014 after making 53 saves.

Hat Trick Hero: When Diana Draayer scored her third goal on a shorthanded opportunity in Friday's game, she became the first Gustie women's hockey player to notch a hat trick since Lindsey Hjelm had one on January 26, 2013 in a 4-1 victory over Concordia College. Draayer also became the first Gustie to score a shorthanded goal since her sister Carolyn did so last season in a 5-2 win over the Tommies on Feb. 13. The Deephaven, Minnesota native also became the first to score four points in a single game since she and Erica Power both did it in a 7-1 victory over St. Olaf on Dec. 5, 2014.

Home Sweet Home: So far this season, Gustavus has played its best hockey at The Don. The team is 2-0-0 in St. Peter, compared to its 0-1-1 record on the road. The Gusties have also scored 10 goals at home, compared to its five when it serves as the visitor.

250 and Counting: With last Friday's 6-4 win over St. Thomas, Coach Mike Carroll earned his 250th career MIAC victory and is now 250-28-13 over his career in the conference, which leads all coaches.

Gustavus Embarks On 19th Season Of Women's Hockey: The Gustavus women's hockey team is currently in its 19th season. Founded in 1997, the Gusties have attained an all-time record of 388-103-29, which stands as the second winningest program in all of NCAA Division III women's hockey. The Gustie women have won 13 MIAC titles in the 18 years of women's hockey in the conference. Those 14 titles rank first in front of St. Thomas (3), and Augsburg and Saint Mary's, who each have two. Gustavus has also earned the MIAC Playoff crown a total of 11 times, 10 of which have come in the past 12 years and led to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances.

Wearing The "C": In the 18-year history of the Gustavus women's hockey program, 35 players have earned the honor of being a captain. This year, two new players earn that title in junior Allie Lewis and sophomore Diana Draayer.

Home Grown Talent: Of the 23 players on this year's roster, 20 are natives of Minnesota. The only players who reside outside the State of Hockey are Courtney Bethune, who hails from Fort Frances, Ontario, Allie Lewis, who is a native of Kearney, Nebraska, and Amanda DiNella from Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois.

Scorers Return: Despite losing two of its top four scorers from its 2014-15 squad, Gustavus will return 62 percent of its scoring from last season, including sophomore Erica Power who led last year's squad with 27 points (9G, 18A) and Allison Eder-Zdechlik who finished tied for second on the team with 20 points (9G, 11A).

A Balanced Approach: Thirteen of the Gusties' 23 players in 2015-16 are returners, and the Gusties also welcome back three of their five All-MIAC selections. However, the Gusties also welcome in 10 first-years, including five forwards, three defenders, and two goalies.

Gusties In The Polls: Gustavus is ranked eighth in the most recent USCHO.com Division III Women's Hockey Poll, which was released Monday. This week marks the 94th consecutive time that the Gusties have been ranked in the USCHO.com poll.

Head Coach Mike Carroll

Mike Carroll is in his 17th season as the women's head hockey coach at Gustavus. Within his tenure behind the Gustie bench, Carroll has turned Gustavus women's hockey into one of the most successful programs in NCAA Division III. He has compiled an overall record of 352-84-28 in 16 seasons and has the most coaching victories in the history of the program.

Last season, the Gustavus women's hockey team regained its spot atop of the MIAC standings, finishing first in the final conference standings with 32 points at 15-2-1. However, the Gusties suffered a 6-3 loss to Bethel University in the MIAC Playoff Semifinals, which brought their season to an end and the team finished with an overall record of 19-5-2.

Carroll has directed the Gusties to 12 MIAC regular season titles (2000-01, 2001-02, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13) and has been named the MIAC Coach-of-the-Year six times (2001-02, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2010-11, 2012-13, 2014-15). In addition to coaching 37 players who have earned All-Conference honors 64 times, he has coached five MIAC Players-of-the-Year in Sarah Garrison, Andrea Peterson, Stefanie Ubl, Allie Schwab, Lindsey Hjelm. Carroll has also worked with 14 players who have earned All-America distinction 22 times and two American Hockey Coaches Association Players-of-the-Year, including four-time MIAC Player-of-the-Year and four-time All-American Andrea Peterson.

Prior to coming to Gustavus, Carroll served as the head boys' hockey coach at Mankato West High School from 1991 to 1999. Carroll's college coaching resume included a stint as head men's hockey coach at Fergus Falls Community College from 1986 to 1987 as well as a season as the assistant men's coach at the University of St. Thomas in 1983.

Carroll, an Edina, Minnesota native, competed in hockey and baseball at Mankato State. After graduating with a degree in municipal recreation in 1982, Carroll played professional baseball in the Montreal Expos organization for two years.

Mike and his wife, Terri, live in Mankato and have two sons, Matt and Mike.
