Setting The Scene: The Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference schedule kicks off Wednesday night as Gustavus hosts Saint Mary's University at Gus Young Court. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 2-1 overall record after defeating Buena Vista 97-90 on Sunday in St. Peter. Five Gusties reached double figure points with Gary Cooper's 20 points leading the way. The Cardinals enter Wednesday's game with an identical 2-1 overall record after dropping their last contest 85-68 at the College of St. Scholastica on Sunday. Saint Mary's was held to 41.5-percent shooting from the field and was led by Wylie Ferron's 12 points.

Last Time Out: The Gustavus men's basketball team used another strong second half to come away with a 97-90 victory over Buena Vista University on Sunday evening to improve to 2-1 overall. Much like the strong start to the second half in their last outing against Simpson, the Gusties started Sunday's second frame with a 17-2 run to take a 62-55 lead and never looked back.

Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) led all scorers with 20 points on 8-of-16 shooting from the field. Cooper also led the Gusites in the rebounding category with six. Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.), Peter Kruize (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.), Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) and Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) also reached double figures scoring with 14, 13, 12 and 12 points, respectively.

Gustavus started the contest on the right foot with a 15-8 lead before the Beavers quickly charged back into the game with 10 unanswered points to take an 18-15 advantage with 12:30 on the clock. Buena Vista continued its offensive pressure over the next three minutes and led by as much as seven points at 29-22. A pair of jump shots by Ziegler and Kruize got the Gusties within two points and then a three-pointer from Cooper tied the game at 29-29 at the 8:41 mark. But BVU controlled the pace of play for the remainder of the half as it went on a 24-16 run and led 53-45 at the break.

The Gusties made key adjustments at halftime and stole the momentum back by outscoring the Beavers 17-2 in the first five minutes to take a 62-55 lead and never trailed the rest of the game. Gustavus increased its lead to as much as 11 points at 92-81 with 4:29 remaining in the game, but the Beavers would not go without a fight and scored nine unanswered points to trail by only two points with two minutes to play. The Gusties regained their composure and were able to finish the game strong with good defensive play, holding the Beavers scoreless over the final two minutes.

Gustavus improved upon its first half shooting of 47.1-percent (16-34) from the field to 64.5-percent (20-31) in the final 20 minutes for a total of 55.4-percent on the day. Buena Vista went the other direction, shooting 65.5-percent (19-29) in the first half and then fell to 44.4-percent (12-27) in the second. Rebounds were close with Gustavus edging BVU 31-29. The Beavers committed 15 turnovers compared to 10 by the Gusties. Both teams had plenty of opportunities from beyond the arc as Gustavus shot 9-of-20 from three-point land compared to 8-of-19 from the Beavers.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's matchup between Gustavus and Saint Mary's is the 170th all-time meeting between the two teams. Gustavus leads the all-time series 120-49 and has won the last ten meetings. The last time Saint Mary's defeated Gustavus was Jan. 27, 2010 in Winona. The Gusties have never lost to the Cardinals at Gus Young Court, which opened in 1985.

About The Cardinals: The Cardinals enter Wednesday's game with a 2-1 overall record after dropping their last contest 85-68 at the College of St. Scholastica on Sunday. Saint Mary's was held to 41.5-percent shooting from the field and was led by Wylie Ferron's 12 points. Connor Kaiser is the team's leading scorer averaging 15.7 points after the first three games of the season.

Last Time They Met, Gusties vs. Cardinals: The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team was able to snap a three-game losing streak when it earned a 70-51 victory over visiting Saint Mary's University on Feb. 14, 2015 at Gus Young Court.

"There were more possessions today than there have been in our previous few games, which certainly makes a difference," said head coach Mark Hanson. "We've played some teams that have played outstanding defense these past few games and fortunately we got our offense

flowing pretty well today."

Gustavus did indeed have a better offensive rhythm on Saturday as it reached the 70-point mark for the first time since an 82-61 victory over Hamline University on Dec. 13, 2014. The Gusties raced out to an early 16-6 lead and would never look back as they went on a 20-9 run over the first half's final 11 minutes to take a 21-point advantage into halftime (36-15). Chad Poppen (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) paced Gustavus in the opening frame as he scored nine points on 3-of-3 shooting from beyond the arc.

"If we hadn't gotten sloppy with the ball in the first half, I think we would have had a more significant lead," said Hanson. "That being said, we got some great things out of our defensive energy and that certainly helped our offense."

Gustavus continued to keep its foot on the gas pedal in the second half and saw its lead grow to 23 (55-32) with 10:44 remaining in the game. With 6:14 left on the clock, Gustavus still saw its lead at 23 (62-39), but at that point, Saint Mary's went on a 12-3 run over the next four minutes to cut the lead to 65-51 with 2:11 remaining. But the Gusties closed the game with five straight points to earn the 19-point victory and move into sole possession of sixth place in the MIAC.

"I was very pleased with the effort, but I wasn't necessarily pleased with all of our choices," said Hanson. "We need to continue focusing on valuing each possession and reducing our turnovers."

Shooting 53.8 percent from the floor, Gustavus had its best overall shooting performance since its aforementioned game with Hamline when it shot 57.8 percent. Poppen led Gustavus with a career-high 17 points on 5-of-7 shooting (4-for-4 from long range), while Peter Kruize (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) notched 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting and grabbed eight boards. Brody Ziegler (Jr., Mankato, Minn.) was also in double-digits for the Gusties as he tallied 10 points on 5-of-9 shooting and nabbed five rebounds.

Mark Schumacher led Saint Mary's with 10 points on 4-of-9 shooting and grabbed five rebounds. Ronnie Ortiz also scored 12 points for the Cardinals.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1439-974, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Home Grown: The 2015-16 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 15 players and all but two are natives of Minnesota. The two players who hail from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes are senior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan, and sophomore AJ Hatchett, who comes from Powder Springs, Georgia. Cooper and Hatchett are just two of 11 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 16 years.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 470 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program in 2015. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 470-216 overall record at Gustavus, including a 354-146 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
