**Setting The Scene:** The Gustavus men's basketball team has its first MIAC road test of the season Saturday afternoon in Minneapolis as it takes on Augsburg College. The Gusties enter the game with a 3-1 overall record and 1-0 mark in the MIAC after defeating Saint Mary's 69-57 on Wednesday night in St. Peter, while the Auggies are 3-1 overall and 0-1 in the league after losing 69-65 to St. Olaf on Tuesday in Northfield, Minn. Brody Ziegler is Gustavus's top point-scorer, averaging 12.5 points per game, while Collin Olmscheid is Augsburg's best offensive player, averaging 16 points per game.

**Last Time Out:** The Gustavus men's basketball team scored the first basket of Wednesday night's game against Saint Mary's University and never relinquished the lead, resulting in a 69-57 victory to begin MIAC play. With the win, the Gusties improve to 3-1 overall and 1-0 in the conference.

"I think it is important to always expect to win, even if you're not thrilled with all the things that take part during the win," Head Coach Mark Hanson said. "I thought Saint Mary's played very hard. They have some very effective players, so to build a lead and play solid in some areas I'm certainly pleased with, but 15 turnovers are far too many and the type of turnovers they were is disappointing. To be out-rebounded is disappointing, too, but I can live with the outcome."

Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) and Jacob Herd (So., Waconia, Minn.) led the Gusties with 13 points apiece. Ziegler shot 6-of-11 from the floor and added five rebounds. Herd's 13 points are a career-high, while he also hauled in a team-best six rebounds. Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) also posted double figures with 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting, including 2-of-2 from beyond the arc.

The Gusties built an 8-2 lead to start the game, forcing Saint Mary's to take a timeout 1:45 in. The two teams traded points throughout the following four minutes until Gustavus went on a 7-3 run with Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) getting a steal and a layup to put the Gusties ahead 22-12 with 11 minutes to play in the first. The Cardinals were able to cut the deficit to five points at 24-19 at the 8:36 mark, but the Black and Gold responded with six unanswered points and an 11-4 run to take its largest lead of the half at 35-23 with four minutes remaining. Saint Mary's battled back with a 7-3 run to close out the half and the Gusties went into the locker room with a 38-30 lead.

The second half went back and forth as Gustavus led by as few as eight points (40-32, 19:02) and as many as 14 (five times) after 13 minutes of play. The Gusties took their largest lead of the game at 63-47 in dramatic fashion as Ziegler broke free for a two-handed dunk with 6:26 to play. Gustavus was then able to hold off the Cardinals and came away with a 12-point victory.

The Gusties shot 49.2-percent (29-59) from the floor, including 7-for-16 from three-point range, and made 4-of-8 free throws. The Cardinals were held to a 41.1-percent (23-56) shooting rate and made 6-of-15 three-pointers. Gustavus tallied a season-high 12 steals, leading to 20 points off turnovers. Rebounding was close as Saint Mary's edged the Gusties 34-33.

**Series Snapshot:** Saturday's matchup between Gustavus and Augsburg is the 176th all-time meeting between the two teams. Gustavus leads the all-time series 105-70, but has lost the last three meetings. Gustavus is looking for its first win against the Auggies in Minneapolis since Jan. 17, 2013.

**About The Auggies:** The Auggies enter with a 3-1 overall record and 0-1 mark in the MIAC after losing 69-65 to St. Olaf on Tuesday in Northfield, Minn.

- In a contest that saw four lead changes and five ties, the game was bound to go down to the wire. The Auggies used a Joe Zangel (Sr., Richfield, Minn./St. Louis Park HS) layup to take a 63-62 lead with just 48 seconds remaining in the contest. St. Olaf came down on its next possession and hit a three-pointer to go up 65-63. Augsburg was forced into a turnover and had to foul. The Oles hit 1-of-2 from the free-throw line to extend the lead to 66-63. Augsburg was not able to convert on its next possession and St. Olaf again hit 1-of-2 from the free-throw line, to go up 67-63. Harry Sonie (So., Burnsville, Minn./Apple Valley HS) scored a layup with six seconds left in the game to cut the Ole lead to 67-65. Augsburg fouled and St. Olaf hit 2-of-2 to claim the 69-65 victory.

- Augsburg finished with five players in double figures, led by Brett Rasmussen (Jr., Lakeville, Minn./Lakeville North HS), who posted 14 points, which included a perfect 7-for-7 night at the free-throw line.

- Zangel and Kevin McKiernan (Fy., Savage, Minn./Prior Lake HS) scored 12 points apiece, with Zangel adding five rebounds, a block, a steal and an assist.



- Ryan Gilmer (Sr., Bloomington, Minn./Jefferson HS) led the Auggies on the boards, grabbing a team-high nine rebounds, while adding four points and an assist.
  - For the game, Augsburg shot 42.3 percent (22-of-52) from the floor, while St. Olaf connected on 45.6 percent (26-of-57) of its field-goal attempts.

**Last Time They Met, Gusties vs. Auggies:** The Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team suffered a 63-59 loss to Augsburg College on Feb. 9, 2015 at Si Melby Hall. Gustavus never trailed by more than 10, but also never led, making for a close game throughout.

The Gusties quickly fell behind 11-4, but never let the Auggies go on a deep run and were able to stay within eight points for the entire first half. By halftime, Augsburg led 33-28. The Auggies shot 4-of-6 from three-point range in the opening half compared to Gustavus going 2-for-11. Collin Olmscheid led the way for Augsburg through the first 20 minutes, scoring 12 points on 3-of-6 shooting, including going 2-for-3 from beyond the arc.

Following the half, the Auggies went on a brief 4-0 run to take a nine-point lead (37-28) which equaled their largest lead of the game. Three-pointers by Gary Cooper (Jr., Detroit, Mich.) and Chad Poppen (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) early in the second half helped Gustavus to keep the Gusties close, but Augsburg still led 48-40 with 11:46 to play.

It was then Gustavus went on a 7-0 run, keyed by layups from Poppen and Martin Feddersen (Sr., Winona, Minn.) and a three-pointer by Chris Narum (Jr., Eagan, Minn.) to bring the score to 48-47. However, the Auggies' Parker Hines slowed the Gustie momentum with a layup that brought the Auggie lead back to three and the Gusties would not get that close again until a Feddersen layup with 2:54 remaining in the game brought the Augsburg lead to 60-57. Hines again countered to bring the lead back to five, but Feddersen got to the rim one last time to cut the lead back to three (62-59) with 1:28 left to play. But Gustavus managed only one shot attempt in that last 1:28, and Augsburg eventually secured the four-point victory.

Feddersen led Gustavus with 14 points on 6-of-8 shooting and also had six rebounds, both team highs. Cooper was next with 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting and four rebounds and Poppen tallied 12 points on 5-of-9 shooting with three rebounds.

Olmscheid led Augsburg with 24 points on 8-of-14 shooting, while Auggie leading scorer Hines notched a double-double with his 11 point, 10 rebound effort. The Auggies shot 51 percent from the floor compared to the Gusties 48.1 percent and also out rebounded Gustavus 31-26.

**Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season:** The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1414-977, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 934-568. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

**Home Grown:** The 2015-16 Gustavus men's basketball roster features 15 players and all but two are natives of Minnesota. The two players who hail from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes are senior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan, and sophomore AJ Hatchett, who comes from Powder Springs, Georgia. Cooper and Hatchett are just two of 11 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 16 years.

**Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff:** Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 470 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

# The Last Time It Happened

## Team

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is entering his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program in 2015. During that time, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, as becomes just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 471-216 overall record at Gustavus, including a 356-146 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
