

Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team continues its road trip in the MIAC on Wednesday night as it takes on Bethel University. The Gusties enter the contest with a 3-2 overall record and 1-1 mark in the league after a 79-70 setback at Augsburg College on Saturday night in Minneapolis, while the Royals have started the season with a perfect 6-0 record and 1-0 mark in the MIAC after beating Concordia College 75-66 on Saturday in Arden Hills. Brodv Ziegler is Gustavus's leading scorer, averaging 11.6 points per game, and Derek Magnuson leads the way for the Royals, averaging 15.5 points per game.

Last Time Out: The Gustavus men's basketball team got off to a quick start Saturday at Augsburg College with a 9-2 lead after the first three minutes of play, but the Auggies responded with a 14-2 run to take a lead they would not let go of the rest of the way resulting in a 79-70 final score. The loss is the first in MIAC play by the Gusties as they fall to 1-1 in the league and 3-2 overall.

Gustavus's hot start was sparked by consecutive three-pointers by Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) and Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) in the first two trips down the court. A layup by Narum put the Gusties ahead 9-2 at the 17:15 mark, but that's when the momentum shifted in favor of Augsburg as it made six of its next seven shots from the field for a 16-11 lead after seven minutes of play.

Narum sunk a three-point shot with 10:29 on the clock to cut the deficit to two points at 17-15, but the Auggies responded with a 9-2 run to gain a nine-point advantage with 7:44 to go. Once again, the Gusties battled back and came within three points at 30-27 after a layup by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.), but the Auggies fired back by outscoring the Gusties 9-1 in the final 4:31 of the first.

The Gusties trailed 39-28 at the half after shooting 37 percent (10-27) from the floor compared to a 65.4 percent clip (17-26) by Augsburg.

Gustavus came out of the break with a renewed energy and chipped away at the double-digit deficit, coming all the way back to within two points at 48-46 nearly eight minutes into the second half. The Auggies held on to a slim advantage over the ensuing five minutes, leading 54-52 with seven minutes to play, but from that point on it was all Augsburg as it went on a 10-2 run and never looked back.

Gustavus shot 16-for-36 (44.4 percent) in the second half and 41.3 percent (26-63) in the game, and went 11-for-30 from beyond the arc. Rebounding was close as the Auggies edged out the Gusties 35-33. A difference in the game proved to be points in the paint as Augsburg outscored Gustavus 39-26. The Auggies also took advantage of their trips to the free throw line, making 17-of-26.

Narum led the way for the Gustie offense with a career-high 20 points, shooting 7-of-14 from the field, including 5-of-11 from three-point range. Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) and Sergio Najera (Sr., New Prague, Minn.) also reached double figures with 11 and 10 points, respectively. Najera led the Gusties down low with nine rebounds and three blocks.

Series Snapshot: Wednesday's matchup between Gustavus and Bethel is the 83rd all-time meeting between the two teams. Gustavus leads the all-time series 58-24 and has split the season series in the past two years.

About The Royals: The Royals are the only MIAC team remaining with an undefeated record at 6-0 overall and 1-0 in the league. Bethel has already played five games at home, the most recent being a 75-66 win over Concordia College last Saturday. Trevor Hall led the way for the Royals with 21 points on 7-of-14 shooting from the floor. He also made 3-of-7 three-pointers and 4-of-5 free throws. Jared Nelson (15), Derek Magnuson (13) and Aden Casey (10) also reached double figure points. After six games this season, the Royals lead the MIAC in assists (17.3 per game) and steals (8.3 per game), and are second in both points (78.2 per game) and rebounds (39 per game).

Last Time They Met, Gusties vs. Royals: When it mattered most, the Gustavus men's basketball team was able to play its best basketball and earned a 77-67 victory over Bethel University on Feb. 16 at Gus Young Court.

Gustavus found itself in an early 12-6 hole at the 16:16 mark in the first half following nine combined points from Royal leading scorers Kyle Zimmerman and Kyle von Schmidt-Pauli. Less than one minute later, the Gusties had that lead down to one thanks to a Chad Poppen

(Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) three-pointer and Gary Cooper (Jr., Detroit, Mich.) steal and layup. The two teams continued to go back and forth for the next two minutes, until Bethel went on a 10-4 run to take a 27-19 lead with 9:45 remaining in the first half.

But Gustavus fought back and executed a 12-0 run of its own over the next five and a half minutes, keyed by points from six different Gusties, to take a 31-27 lead with 4:27 to play in the opening frame. Bethel clawed back though, and managed to take a slim 36-35 advantage into the half.

In the second half, Bethel maintained its slim advantage for approximately six minutes. The Royals led 46-43 with 15:35 to play before Gustavus went on an 11-0 run over the next 4:18 minutes to take a 54-46 advantage and a lead that would stick for the remainder of the game.

The Royals would not go away guietly though, and with 6:18 to play had cut the Gustie lead to 64-60. However, a Tapp three-pointer would spark a 7-0 Gustavus run over the next minute and a half to give Gustavus a 71-60 lead and seemingly give the Black and Gold the momentum it so needed to finish the game.

Bethel continued to remain resilient and cut the Gustie lead to 72-67 with 1:30 to play, but Gustavus would go on a 5-0 run by making 5-of-6 free-throws to close the game and secure the 10-point win.

For the second game in a row, Gustavus eclipsed the 70-point mark thanks to a 64 percent team field goal percentage. The team's percentage was the highest since it shot 65.9 percent against Northwestern University on Dec. 6, 2014 and was its second highest percentage of the season.

Poppen, who started his first career game on Monday, led the Gusties in scoring for the second game in a row with 14 on 5-of-8 shooting, including going 2-for-3 from downtown. Peter Kruize (Jr. St. Peter, Minn.) was next with 13 points and four rebounds and Cooper and Sergio Najera (Jr., New Prague, Minn.) rounded out Gustavus's double-digit scorers with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

von Schmidt-Paul led Bethel with 17 points on 5-of-7 shooting. Zimmerman was next with 15 points on 6-of-11 shooting and Bridgeport Tusler followed with 12 points by going 5-for-9 from the floor. As a whole, the Royals shot 46.2 percent from the field.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1440-975, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 934-568. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

The two players who hail from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes are senior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan, and sophomore AJ Hatchett, who comes from Powder Springs, Georgia. Cooper and Hatchett are just two of 11 players to come through the Gustavus men's basketball program who reside outside the state of Minnesota in the last 16 years.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 470 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program in 2015. After a guarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 471-217 overall record at Gustavus, including a 356-146 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
