Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team is set to take on Carleton College at 1 p.m. Saturday at West Gym in Northfield, Minn. The Gusties enter the MIAC matchup with a 5-8 overall record and 2-6 mark in the league after a $65-60$ loss to St. Olaf on Monday, while the Knights are $9-4$ overall and $6-2$ in the MIAC after an $81-69$ victory over Hamline on Wednesday. Gustavus currently sits in eighth place in the league standings and Carleton is in third place.

Last Time Out: Despite a second half comeback, the Gustavus men's basketball team suffered a hard fought $65-60$ loss to St. Olaf on Monday night at Gus Young Court. The defeat drops the Gusties to $5-8$ overall and $2-6$ in the MIAC, while the Oles improve to $8-5$ overall, and $6-2$ in the league.
"We played 30 minutes of good basketball, unfortunately it's a 40 minute game" said Head Coach Mark Hanson. "We played the way we needed to play in the first 10 minutes of the second half as we came out very strong. I thought the entire second half we were capable of coming back, and had several looks to get ahead. I am proud of what a lot of players did during the comeback, but we need to bottle that up and play for an entire 40 minutes next time."

Despite a slow start and trailing $10-0$ before three minutes ran off the clock to begin the game, the Gusties fought back from a 16-point deficit at the 12:35 mark, to a $44-33$ score at halftime with five points to end the half from Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.).

With a strong start to the second frame, the Gusties were able to narrow the Oles lead to as little as one point in the opening seven minutes of the half, coming off 10 unanswered points with help from senior Brian Jacobs (Lake Crystal, Minn.) who sunk a three-pointer, followed by a a pair of layups. Jacobs reached double-digit scoring with 11 points in the game, and added three rebounds.

The Gusties went back and forth for the remainder of the half, until the : :44 mark when Gustavus took its first lead of the game at $55-54$ with a jumper by Peter Kruize (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) followed by a free throw. However, the Oles responded with five unanswered points to put them ahead $59-55$ with three minutes remaining in the game.

The Gusties continued to battle in the final seconds of the game, with a three-pointer by Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) at the 17-second mark, closing the Oles lead to 63-60. Seconds later, the Oles' Justin Pahl finished a layup with 13 seconds left in the game, leaving the Gusties with not enough time on the clock to complete their comeback.

The Oles were led by Ben Figini with 24 points, and teammate Justin Pahl who was good for 14.

The Gusties shot 45 percent, compared to the Oles 43.1 percent, and out-rebounded the Oles 30-27. For the second time this season, the Gusties finished with double digit steals with 11 . Gustavus also found quality production from the bench, outscoring St. Olaf's reserves 39-12. Along with Jacobs' 11 points off the bench, Sharbono also scored 11 off the bench.

Series Snapshot: Tonight's matchup marks the 88th meeting between Gustavus and Carleton in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series $54-33$ and have won the past nine meetings. The last time the Knights defeated the Gusties was on Feb. 5, 2011 in a 67-49 decision in Northfield, Minn.

Last Time They Met: Despite giving up leads of 10 and 13 points early in the first half and late in the second half, respectively, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team was able to persevere and earn a down to the wire 57-55 victory over visiting Carleton College on Feb. 4, 2015 at Gus Young Court.
"I thought we got contributions from a lot of our guys, both offensively and defensively," said head coach Mark Hanson. "To win a game with only one player in double figures means a lot of guys are doing great things and l'm proud of our team effort tonight."

By the $10: 15$ mark, Gustavus had raced to an early $15-5$ lead thanks to points being scored by seven different Gustie players, including three non-starters. However, Carleton stormed back with a $9-2$ run to bring the Gustie lead to only one (17-16) with $5: 32$ remaining in the first half. The two teams continued to go back and forth for the remainder of the half, and by halftime, the score was knotted at 26-26.
"I thought our defensive intensity was really good for the first part of the first half and the entire second half", said Hanson. "They are a very difficult team to guard because of how well they run their patterns, and if you take something away, they always have a counter. I thought we stuck with them though and didn't quit when they made their comebacks. To me, that shows a good deal of maturity on our part."

Following halftime, neither team led by more than six for the first twelve minutes. After going down one (39-40) with 10:37 to play, Gustavus went on a 14-0 run over the next 5:02 to take its biggest lead of the game at 53-40. The run was highlighted by the Gusties' six points off of steals from Gary Cooper (Jr., Detroit, Mich.), Martin Feddersen (Sr., Winona, Minn.) and Coleman Sweeney (So., Lake City, Minn.). In all, Carleton had 15 turnovers compared to the Gustavus's five.
"I liked most of what we did offensively," said Hanson. "We didn't shoot well, but we did a nice job from the free throw line, had some key offensive rebounds that helped us finish off a few possessions and took advantage of some of their turnovers."

However, as they did in the first half, the Knights made another comeback with a 10-0 run to cut the Gustie lead to 53-50 with 25 seconds remaining in the game. Carleton's Mitchell Biewen and Peter Bakker-Arkema hit three-pointers during that stretch to help the Knights shoot a combined 47.1 percent ( 8 -for-17) from long range during the game.

Down three with 25 seconds to go, Carleton was forced to foul Cooper, who went to the charity stripe and sank both freebies to give Gustavus a $55-50$ lead with 20 seconds on the clock. The Knights weren't done yet though, as first-year big man Kevin Grow came back on the other end to tip in a put-back with five seconds remaining to bring Carleton's deficit to three. The Knights were again forced to foul however, and Isaac Tapp (Sr., Stewartville, Minn.) calmly drained both free-throws to put the Gusties up 57-52. Biewen came back and hit a heavily contested three-pointer for Carleton with 0.6 seconds remaining, but it was too little, too late and Gustavus held on for the 57-55 win.
"Those free-throws down the stretch were pretty important," said Hanson. "The way they were shooting it, you kind of expected everything to go in, so to have those extra couple of points at the end there was obviously big for us."

For the first time all season, Gustavus had just one player who tallied 10 or more points. However, all nine Gusties who played registered at least one point, with eight of those nine tallying six or more. Brody Ziegler (J., Mankato, Minn.) had 10 points on 4-of-6 shooting and six rebounds to lead the Gusties, while Feddersen was close behind with nine points on 4-of7 shooting and six boards. Carleton was led by Grow, who notched a double-double with 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting and 11 rebounds. Biewen scored 12 points on 4-of-11 shooting, with all his made shots being three-pointers.

Gustavus shot 41.5 percent from the floor, compared to Carleton's 41.3. Gustavus was also 10-of-11 from the charity stripe. The Knights did live up to their status as top rebounding team in the conference, as they out rebounded the Gusties 34-26, with 13 of those boards being offensive.

About The Knights: Carleton enters the game with a 9-4 overall record and 6-2 mark in the MIAC, which is good for third place in the standings. The Knights have won their last two games and seven of their last nine, most recently defeating Hamline 81-69 on Wednesday in St. Paul. Carleton has a stingy defense as it ranks second in the league with 64.2 points per game allowed. After 13 games this season, Tianen Chen leads the Knights with an average of 16 points per game. Kevin Grow has been a consistent forward as he averages 14.8 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. Mitchell Biewen is the third Knight to average double figures with 12 points per game.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1401-973, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-572. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 473 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an $89-78$ win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 473-223 overall record at Gustavus, including a 356-152 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
