**Setting The Scene:** The Gustavus men's basketball team is set to take on Saint Johns at 7 p.m. tonight at William D. Sexton Arena in Collegeville, Minn. The Gusties enter the MIAC matchup with a 5-9 overall record and 2-7 mark in the league after a 64-53 overtime loss to Carleton on Saturday, while the Johnnies are 11-3 overall and 6-3 in the MIAC after a 91-68 victory over Augsburg on Saturday. Gustavus currently sits in eighth place in the league standings and Saint John's is in fifth place.

**Last Time Out:** Despite erasing a seven-point halftime deficit and forcing the game into overtime, the Gustavus men's basketball team was unable to hold off Carleton in the final five minutes, losing 64-53. The Gusties fell to 5-9 overall and 2-7 in the MIAC, while the Knights improved to 10-4 overall and 7-2 in the league.

Carleton scored the first two points of the game and never relinquished the lead for the entire half. The Gusties kept the score close, though, as they played within seven points until a three-pointer by Carleton gave it a nine-point advantage with 1:10 remaining in the half. Playing in his first game since an injury on Dec. 2, Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) made a layup to close the first 20 minutes and the Gusties went into halftime with a 28-21 deficit. Cooper scored a team-high eight points in the first half.

Carleton maintained a four-to-nine-point lead for the first five minutes of the second, but Gustavus then scored 11 unanswered points to take a 39-35 advantage at the 9:08 mark. The scoring run was sparked by a pair of layups by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.), followed by a Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) layup, Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) three-pointer and finally a layup by Cooper.

The Gusties held on to their lead until the 5:20 mark when a three-pointer put the Knights ahead 44-43. From the point on, there were four ties and three lead changes for the remainder of regulation. Cooper sunk a jumper with 1:37 on the clock to give the Gusties a 51-50 lead, but a free throw by the Knights tied the game and the two squads went into overtime tied 51-51.

Gustavus simply had trouble making shots in the overtime period as it went 1-for-8 from the field, and was forced to foul, sending the Knights to the charity stripe 14 times. Carleton made 8-of-14 from the free throw line en route to an 11-point victory.

Carleton shot 44.2 percent (19-43) from the field throughout the game, while the Gusties shot 36.1 percent (22-61). Three-point shooting proved to be a problem for the Gusties as they shot 1-for-23 from beyond the arc. Rebounds were close as Carleton won the battle 36-32.

Cooper led the Gusties with 20 points in his first game back from a seven-week injury. Ziegler also reached double figures with 11 points and was one-rebound shy of a double-double with nine boards.

**Series Snapshot:** Wednesday's matchup marks the 176th meeting between Gustavus and Saint John's in men's basketball. Gustavus leads the all-time series 110-65 and has won four of the last six meetings, including two MIAC Playoff victories in the past two seasons. Saint John's Head Coach Pat McKenzie is in his first season at the helm, while Gustavus Head Coach Mark Hanson has a 35-22 all-time record against the Johnnies.

**Last Time They Met:** After falling to Saint John's University 50-47 to end the regular season, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team made it count when it mattered most, as it returned to Sexton Arena just four days later to defeat the Johnnies 64-54 in the MIAC Playoff Quarterfinals. Gustavus trailed by as many as seven in the second half, but shot 65 percent from the floor in the game's final half to make up the difference and earn a 10-point victory.

Saint John's got out to an early 7-4 lead, but Gustavus was able to go on an 8-0 run to take a 12-7 lead with 14:59 to play in the first half, thanks largely in part to six points from Isaac Tapp (Sr., Stewartville, Minn.) who went 3-for-3 from the floor during that stretch and also nabbed a steal. But the Johnnies would counter with a 12-3 run of their own to retake the lead (19-15) at the 8:46 mark in the first half.

The Gusties kept the game close though, and despite nine first half points from the MIAC's fourth leading scorer in the Johnnies' Mitchell Kuck, never trailed by more than six before halftime. A hard-fought Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) layup with 1:22 to play in the first half cut Saint John's lead to 25-23, but an unfortunate foul call on Ziegler in the half's final seconds allowed Kuck to shoot three free-throws and give the Johnnies a 28-23 halftime advantage.



The second half proved to be as big a battle as the first, as both teams traded baskets for the first nine minutes and Saint John's maintaining its slight advantage. Post play proved physical as well, as the two teams combined for 11 personal fouls in the first nine minutes of the second half.

"During the second half of the season, our biggest issue was lack of toughness and not being the most physical team," said Cooper. "I'm really proud at how our guys responded to the physical nature of the game tonight...I think that's been missing in prior games. Hopefully we can continue to respond like that and make a deep run."

After Alex Schmitt hit a long two pointer that bounced off the front iron, hit the backboard and rolled in, the Gusties' Chad Poppen (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) came back on the next possession and banked in a three-pointer to cut the Johnnie lead to 41-37 with 10:57 to play, which seemed to ignite the Gustie offense and give the defense the motivation it needed to clamp down. Two minutes later, Gustavus had erased the Johnnie lead to tie the game at 43-43 with 8:53 to go. Three minutes after that, a Cooper jumper from the left wing allowed the Gusties to take their first second half lead with a mere 5:44 remaining on the clock.

From that point, Gustavus would never look back, and it used an 11-3 run over the next four minutes to take its largest lead to that point (58-48) with just 1:56 to play. From there, the Gusties used six free-throws to keep the Johnnies at bay and maintain its healthy advantage. When the final buzzer sounded, Gustavus had earned a 64-54 victory.

Cooper led the Gustie scoring effort with 16 points on 6-of-12 shooting, with 10 of those points coming in the second half. Ziegler was next in line, as he scored 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting and pulled down a game-high eight boards to help the Gusties out-rebound Saint John's 31-30. Peter Kruize (So., St. Peter, Minn.) also had stong effort for Gustavus, as the big man rebounded from his scoreless outing this past Saturday to pour in nine points on 3-of-4 shooting.

Saint John's was led by the efforts of Kuck (13 points on 3-of-10 shooting) and Schmitt (14 points on 5-of-13 shooting). Big-man Tyler Weiss was also effective, as he tallied eight points and four rebounds, but fouled out with 5:18 to play, leaving the Johnnies with a lack of size in the post down the stretch. The Johnnies shot just 28 percent (7-for-25) in the second half compared to Gustavus's 65 percent (13-for 20).

**About The Johnnies:** Saint John's enters the game with an 11-3 overall record and 6-3 mark in the MIAC, which is good for fifth place in the standings. The Johnnies have won seven of their last nine games, most recently defeating Augsburg 91-68 on Saturday in Collegeville, Minn. After 14 games this season, Alex Schmitt leads the Johnnies with 18.6 points per game, which also puts him second in the conference for points per game. Following closely is Tyler Weiss who averages 12.3 points per game, and pulls down 8.1 rebounds per game, placing him third in the MIAC.

**Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season:** The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1401-973, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-572. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

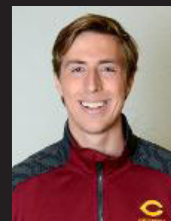

**Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff:** Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 473 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGroot is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGroot returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGroot played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 473-224 overall record at Gustavus, including a 356-153 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
