Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team is back to the friendly confines of Gus Young Court at 1p.m. Saturday for game two of the season series against Augsburg College. Augsburg won game one of the season series 79-70 on Dec. 5 . The Gusties enter the matchup with a 5-10 overall record and 2-8 mark in the MIAC, while the Auggies are 10-5 overall and $5-5$ in the league. Gustavus is trying to end a three-game losing streak, while the Auggies have won six of their last eight games.

Last Time Out: Despite leading midway through the second half, the Gustavus men's basketball team was unable to hold on to the advantage, while sending Saint John's to the free throw line 26 times in an $87-83$ loss on Wednesday night.
"In a lot of ways I thought we played pretty well the whole game," Head Coach Mark Hanson said. "We just put them at the free throw line too much. That's the stat that I expected to stand out."

Both teams shot well from the field as the Gusties posted a 53.1 percentage ( $34-64$ ) to the Johnnies' 53.8 percent (28-52). The big difference was Saint John's ability to get to the charity stripe as it made 2z-of-26 free throws compared to Gustavus's 6 -for-9 clip.

The Gusties started the game on a good note, jumping ahead 18-11 in the first five minutes. Saint John's charged back into the contest with consecutive three-pointers, but Gustavus didn't let go of its lead. The Gusties responded with a $7-2$ run to take a $25-19$ advantage at the 11:10 mark. The Johnnies once again fought back with six unanswered points to tie the game and eventually took a 31-29 lead at the 5:42 mark. From that point on, the Gusties controlled the pace of play for the remainder of the half, ending the first on a $15-7$ run for a $44-38$ lead at halftime.

Gustavus maintained its lead to start the second half until a three-pointer by Saint John's gave the home team a 49-48 advantage three minutes in. The two squads traded the lead three times over the next minute, but it was the Gusties that regained the lead with a $12-3$ run for a $62-55$ advantage at the $12: 30$ mark. Gustavus took its largest lead of the game at $66-57$ on a jumper by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.). Over the next four minutes, the Johnnies were able to go on a 15 -2 run to take an advantage they would not relinquish the rest of the way. Gustavus stayed within four points during the final three minutes, but wasn't able to get back on top.

For the second straight game, Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) led the Gusties offense with 19 points on 9 -of-18 shooting from the field and a game-high seven assists. Peter Kruize (JI., St. Peter, Minn.) had a productive night off the bench, scoring a career-high 17 points on 6 -of-7 shooting from the floor and $5-0 \mathrm{f}-6$ from the free throw line. Kruize and Cooper led the team with six rebounds apiece.

Mitchell Kuck of Saint John's led all scorers with 27 points.
Series Snapshot: Today's matchup marks the 177th meeting between Gustavus and Augsburg in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series 105-71, but have lost the last four meetings. Augsburg won the first game of this season's series with a 79-70 decision in Minneapolis on Dec. 5 . Chris Narum led the Gusties with a career-high 20 points, shooting 7-0f-14 from the floor, including 5-of-11 from three-point range. Riley Sharbono and Sergio Najera also reached double figures with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

Last Time They Met: The Gustavus men's basketball team got off to a quick start on Dec. 5 at Augsburg College with a 9-2 lead after the first three minutes of play, but the Auggies responded with a 14-2 run to take a lead they would not let go of the rest of the way resulting in a $79-70$ final score.

Gustavus's hot start was sparked by consecutive three-pointers by Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) and Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) in the first two trips down the court. A layup by Narum put the Gusties ahead $9-2$ at the $17: 15$ mark, but that's when the momentum shifted in favor of Augsburg as it made six of its next seven shots from the field for a 16 -11 lead after seven minutes of play.

Narum sunk a three-point shot with 10:29 on the clock to cut the deficit to two points at 17-15, but the Auggies responded with a 9-2 run to gain a nine-point advantage with 7:44 to go. Once again, the Gusties battled back and came within three points at 30-27 after a layup by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.), but the Auggies fired back by outscoring the Gusties 9-1 in the final 4:31 of the first.

The Gusties trailed 39-28 at the half after shooting 37 percent (10-27) from the floor compared to a 65.4 percent clip (17-26) by Augsburg.

Gustavus came out of the break with a renewed energy and chipped away at the doubledigit deficit, coming all the way back to within two points at 48-46 nearly eight minutes into the second half. The Auggies held on to a slim advantage over the ensuing five minutes, leading 54-52 with seven minutes to play, but from that point on it was all Augsburg as it went on a 10-2 run and never looked back.

Gustavus shot 16-for-36 (44.4 percent) in the second half and 41.3 percent (26-63) in the game, and went 11-for-30 from beyond the arc. Rebounding was close as the Auggies edged out the Gusties 35-33. A difference in the game proved to be points in the paint as Augsburg outscored Gustavus 39-26. The Auggies also took advantage of their trips to the free throw line, making 17-of-26.

Narum led the way for the Gustie offense with a career-high 20 points, shooting 7-of-14 from the field, including 5-of-11 from three-point range. Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) and Sergio Najera (Sr., New Prague, Minn.) also reached double figures with 11 and 10 points, respectively. Najera led the Gusties down low with nine rebounds and three blocks.

About The Auggies: Augsburg enters the matchup with a 10-5 overall record and 5-5 mark in the MIAC, which is good for seventh place in the league standings. The Auggies have played well as of late, winning six of their last eight games, most recently defeating Macalester 94-70 on Wednesday in Minneapolis. Augsburg has had some trouble playing on the road with a 2-5 away record. After 15 games this season, Collin Olmscheid leads the team with an average of 16.6 points per game and 6.7 rebounds per game. Ben Glover (15.5), Brett Rasmussen (12.9) and Joe Zangel (12.4) also average double figure points.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568, prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 473 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013 . A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an $89-78$ win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 473-225 overall record at Gustavus, including a 356-154 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
