Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team is set to take on Hamline University if its first road test of the New Year on Saturday in St. Paul. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 4-7 overall record and 1-5 mark in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference after a $71-53$ setback to No. 4 St. Thomas on Wednesday, while the Pipers are $3-7$ overall and $1-4$ in the league after a 80-77 loss at Augsburg on Wednesday.

Last Time Out: The Gustavus men's basketball team suffered its second loss of the New Year against No. 4 University of St. Thomas Wednesday night at Gus Young Court. The defeat moved the Gusties to 4-7 overall and 1-5 in the MIAC. St. Thomas improved to 9-1 overall and 4-1 in the conference.

The Gusties went back and forth with the Tommies in the first five minutes of the game, scoring seven points for a three-point advantage, but couldn't hold down the Tommies offense as they went on a $12-4$ run, leading the Gusties 28-15 with $2: 58$ remaining in the half. The Gusties fought back, narrowing the lead to 34-27 at halftime.

The Gusties cut the deficit to seven at the 10:53 mark in the second half on a jumper by Brian Jacobs (Sr., Lake Crystal, Minn.), but the Tommies responded with nine unanswered points and led by double digits for the remainder of the game. St. Thomas grabbed its largest lead of the game at 71-46 with 1:50 remaining en route to a 18-point victory.

Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) led the team offensively as he was the only Gustie to reach double-digit figures with 10 points on 4-of-6 shooting, and added two free throws. Alec Koster (Jr., Redwood Falls, Minn.) led the Black and Gold after the first half with seven points and four rebounds, followed by senior teammate Chris Narum (Eagan, Minn.) with eight points including two from long range.

Grant Shaeffer and Taylor Montero led the Tommies offense with 16 points each.
St. Thomas shot 55.3 percent opposed to the Gusties who were limited to 42.6 percent. The Tommies forced 20 turnovers compared to seven on the other end.

Series Snapshot: Saturday's matchup marks the 175th meeting between Gustavus and Hamline in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series 104-70 and have won the last eight meetings. The last meeting between the Gusties and the Pipers at Hutton Arena was Jan. 31, 2015 where Gustavus won 63-51.

Last Time They Met: After suffering two straight road losses, the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team was able to end its three-game road stand with a 63-51 victory over Hamline University on Jan. 31, 2015.

Gustavus got off to a slow start against the Pipers and trailed for the first 7:58. However, the Pipers' lead only got to four during that time, and with 11:14 remaining in the first half, a Gary Cooper (Jr., Detroit, Mich.) jumper gave the Gusties a 16-15 advantage and Gustavus never fell behind again. The Gusties continued to build their lead and over the first half's final $8: 04$, went on a 17-5 run that would give the visitors a 38 -25 lead going into the half.

In the second half, the Gustavus lead would never dip below eight, and with 15:35 to play, experienced its largest lead, 46-27. Hamline made small 6-0 and $5-0$ runs between $9: 55-8: 30$ and $5: 28-3: 54$, respectively, but the Gusties managed to build their lead back to double digits after each to secure the 12-point victory and their first win since Jan. 19 against Macalester.

Ironically, four Gusties scored in double digits for the first time since Dec. 13 in Gustavus's first game against the Pipers. Saturday, Cooper led the Gusties with 18 points on 8-of-11 shooting and three rebounds, while Brody Ziegler (Jr., Mankato, Minn.) was next in line with 11 points on 5-0f-6 shooting and seven boards. Chad Poppen (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) scored 10 of his 12 points in the first half and Sergio Najera (Jr., New Prague, Minn.) tallied 10 points on 4-of-9 shooting, his first double-digit scoring game since Jan. 10 against Saint Mary's.

Dior Ford and Austin Johnson led the Pipers with 18 and 13 points, on 5-of-12 and 4-8 shooting, respectively. Twelve of Ford's points came on threepointers, where he was 4 -for- 7 from beyond the arc.

Overall, the Gusties shot 51 percent (25-for-49) and out-rebounded Hamline, the MIAC's second leading rebounding team coming into the game, 28-26.

About The Pipers: Hamline enter's Saturday's game with a 3-7 overall record and 1-4 mark in the MIAC. The Pipers are currently on a five-game losing streak, most recently losing to Augsburg 80-77 on Wednesday in Minneapolis. After 10 games this season, Zach Smith and Quinton Garvis lead the Pipers offense, averaging 12.1 and 10.0 points per game, respectively. Dylan SeeRockers and Herbert Tarpeh are the team's best rebounders as both average 3.8 boards per game.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1401-973, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-572. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, four players are given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Chad Poppen, Gary Cooper, Chris Narum and Brian Jacobs as team captains.

Home Grown: The 2015-16 Gustavus men’s basketball roster features 16 players and all but two are natives of Minnesota. The two players who hail from outside the Land of 10,000 Lakes are senior Gary Cooper, who is a native of Detroit, Michigan, and sophomore AJ Hatchett, who comes from Powder

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 472 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an $89-78$ win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 472-222 overall record at Gustavus, including a $355-151$ record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
