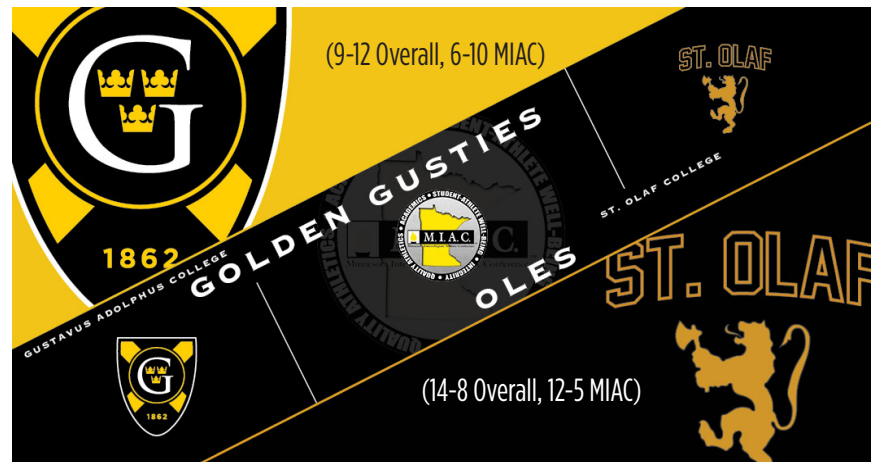

**Setting The Scene:** The Gustavus men's basketball team competes in its final road game of the regular season at 7 p.m. Wednesday for game two of the season series against St. Olaf. The Oles won game one of the series 65-60 on Jan. 11 in St. Peter. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 9-12 overall record and 6-10 mark in the MIAC, while the Oles are 14-8 overall and 12-5 in the league. Gustavus has lost its last two games, while St. Olaf is on a four-game winning streak.

**Last Time Out:** It was a historic Saturday afternoon for the Gustavus men's basketball team, but unfortunately for the Gusties, they came out on the short side of a 114-107 double overtime decision at Concordia College. It was the first double overtime game played by Gustavus since Feb. 1, 1989, and second overtime loss of the season. The Gusties fell to 9-12 overall and 6-10 in the MIAC, while the Cobbers improved to 14-7 overall and 11-5 in the league.

Gary Cooper (Sr. Detroit, Mich.) was the player of the game as he led all scorers with a career-high 39 points on 12-of-21 shooting from the field. The senior wing made 14-of-15 free throws and led the team in rebounds (6) and assists (4). Cooper's 39 points are the most scored by a Gustie since Seth Anderson's program record 45 points against Buena Vista on Nov. 15, 2011. The 39-point mark is the most in a MIAC game by a Gustie since D.L. Smith scored 41 against Minnesota-Duluth on Jan. 1, 1957.

The two squads tied the score three times and traded the lead twice in the opening six minutes of the game. Gustavus then scored seven unanswered points for a 17-10 advantage at the midway point of the first half. Concordia would cut its deficit to two points on three separate occasions, but the Gusties maintained their lead and went into halftime with a 34-27 advantage.

Gustavus increased its lead in the second frame by going on a 17-4 run, resulting in a 51-36 score at the 14:34 mark. During that stretch, the Gusties made seven straight shots, including three from beyond the arc. Concordia traded baskets with the Gusties over the next four minutes and then cut into the double-digit lead at the midway point of the half, 54-45. The Cobbers continued to slowly chip away at their deficit and made it a one-point game, 70-69, with 1:14 remaining in regulation. A pair of free throws by Cooper with 18 seconds left gave the Black and Gold a 77-73 lead, but Concordia answered with a three-pointer on the ensuing possession to bring it back to one point. Cooper was then fouled and sent to the line where he missed the first and made the second for a 78-76 lead with eight second on the clock. Concordia then raced the ball down the court where Brady Syverson missed a short jumper with two seconds, but got his own rebound and made the game-tying layup as time expired to send the game into overtime.

Concordia carried its momentum into overtime by taking a four-point lead after its first two possessions. With the Cobbers leading 84-80 with 3:12 to go, the Gusties fought back with seven unanswered points to take a three-point advantage. After a pair of free throws by Alec Koster (Jr., Redwood Falls, Minn.) gave Gustavus a 92-89 lead with 17 seconds remaining, Concordia once again answered with a three-pointer by Tom Frasse with eight seconds on the clock to tie the game. Cooper brought the ball up the court and pulled up at the top of the key for the game-winner, but his shot bounced off the rim and the game went to a second overtime.

The Cobbers started the second extra frame with the hot hand, making their first three shots for a six-point lead. Gustavus was able to cut the deficit to two (101-99) midway through the period, but Concordia responded with eight unanswered points en route to a seven-point victory.

Gustavus shot 52.2 percent (36-69) from the field, compared to 58.1 percent (36-62) by Concordia. Both teams shot well from the charity stripe – 25-30 by the Gusties and 31-39 by the Cobbers. Concordia won the battle of the boards 35-30 and forced 15 turnovers. The Gusties forced 16 turnovers and tallied eight steals.

Besides Cooper, three other Gusties reached double figure points – Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) with 11, and Brian Jacobs (Sr., Lake Crystal, Minn.) and Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) with 10 each.

**Series Snapshot:** Wednesday's matchup marks the 151st meeting between Gustavus and St. Olaf in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series 95-55, but the Oles have won the last seven meetings.

**Last Time They Met:** Despite a second half comeback, the Gustavus men's basketball team suffered a hard fought 65-60 loss to St. Olaf on Jan. 11 at Gus Young Court.



“We played 30 minutes of good basketball, unfortunately it’s a 40 minute game” said Head Coach Mark Hanson. “We played the way we needed to play in the first 10 minutes of the second half as we came out very strong. I thought the entire second half we were capable of coming back, and had several looks to get ahead. I am proud of what a lot of players did during the comeback, but we need to bottle that up and play for an entire 40 minutes next time.”

Despite a slow start and trailing 10-0 before three minutes ran off the clock to begin the game, the Gusties fought back from a 16-point deficit at the 12:35 mark, to a 44-33 score at halftime with five points to end the half from Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.).

With a strong start to the second frame, the Gusties were able to narrow the Oles lead to as little as one point in the opening seven minutes of the half, coming off 10 unanswered points with help from senior Brian Jacobs (Lake Crystal, Minn.) who sunk a three-pointer, followed by a pair of layups. Jacobs reached double-digit scoring with 11 points in the game, and added three rebounds.

The Gusties went back and forth for the remainder of the half, until the 4:44 mark when Gustavus took its first lead of the game at 55-54 with a jumper by Peter Kruize (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) followed by a free throw. However, the Oles responded with five unanswered points to put them ahead 59-55 with three minutes remaining in the game.

The Gusties continued to battle in the final seconds of the game, with a three-pointer by Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) at the 17-second mark, closing the Oles lead to 63-60. Seconds later, the Oles’ Justin Pahl finished a layup with 13 seconds left in the game, leaving the Gusties with not enough time on the clock to complete their comeback.

The Oles were led by Ben Figini with 24 points, and teammate Justin Pahl who was good for 14.

The Gusties shot 45 percent, compared to the Oles 43.1 percent, and out-rebounded the Oles 30-27. For the second time this season, the Gusties finished with double digit steals with 11. Gustavus also found quality production from the bench, outscoring St. Olaf’s reserves 39-12. Along with Jacobs’ 11 points off the bench, Sharbono also scored 11 off the bench.

**About The Oles:** St. Olaf enters Wednesday’s game with a 14-8 overall record and 12-5 mark in the MIAC, which is good for second place in the standings. The Oles have a stingy defense, allowing just 66.2 points per game, which is third best in the conference. They also rank second in the league with 6.7 steals per game. After 22 games this season, three Oles average double figure scoring - Ben Figini (17.6), Justin Pahl (15.2) and Riley Aekens (14.6). Figini and Aekens are the team’s leading rebounders as they both average 5.5 per game.

**Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season:** The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men’s basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men’s basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568, prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

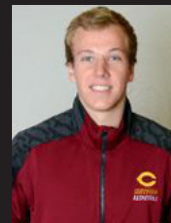

**Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff:** Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 477 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 477-227 overall record at Gustavus, including a 360-156 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
