GAME NOTES

GUSTAVUS EMBARKS ON 74TH SEASON OF MEN'S HOCKEY

The Gustavus men's hockey team is in its 74th season of existence. One of the storied programs in collegiate hockey, Gustavus has compiled an all-time record of 857-627-76 overall and 568-429-47 in the MIAC prior to the start of the 2015-16 season. The Gusties have won 14 MIAC Championships and earned a place in the NCAA Division III Tournament six times, which includes a runner-up finish in 2009.

Gustavus first recognized a men's hockey team in 1937 when then Director of Physical Education George Myrum became interested in the sport and raised the funds to sponsor a team. The Gusties fell to Carleton in their first ever intercollegiate game in 1936. It would take until 1939, the first year Gustavus played on natural ice in the on-campus fieldhouse, for Gustavus to record the first victory in the program's history.

GUSTAVUS COACHING STAFF

Head Coach Brett Petersen is in his 16th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's hockey program. Petersen has compiled a 211-167-42 overall record at Gustavus. His 211 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice in his tenure, once in 2001-02 and again in 2009-10.

Within MIAC play, Gustavus holds a record 133-90-27 during the Petersen era. The Gusties have earned a trip to the MIAC Playoffs 13 seasons and have advanced to the MIAC Playoff Championship a total of six times under Petersen. Since the turn of the century, Gustavus has qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament three times in 2009, 2010, and 2012. The Gusties advanced all the way to the NCAA Championship in 2009 where they fell to Neumann 4-1 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Petersen, a Roseville, Minn. native, received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State.

Former men's hockey player Rory Dynan is in his first season as the assistant men's hockey coach at Gustavus. A 2010 graduate of Gustavus, Dynan is a former forward for the Gusties and a native of Maple Plaine, Minn. During his three seasons wearing the three-crowned sweater, Dynan played in 72 games, recording 24 goals and 23 assists for 47 points. Dynan was a member of the 2008-09 team that made it all the way to the NCAA Division III championship game. During that remarkable season, Dynan was third on the team with 24 points (eight goals, 16 assists).

LAST SEASON AT A GLANCE

The Gustavus men's hockey team seemed to be stuck in neutral last season as it posted an 8-9-8 overall record and 5-5-6 mark in the MIAC. The eight ties broke the single season NCAA Division III tie record of seven, held by three different schools. The five wins in the MIAC were also the fewest since Head Coach Brett Petersen's first season at the helm in 2000-01. The Gusties snapped a string of 13 consecutive MIAC Playoff appearances as well as a streak of seven straight winning seasons.

Although no Gustie made the MIAC All-Conference Team, Jake Bushey (Duluth, Minn.) and Conor Deal (Anchorage, Alaska) were named to the All-Rookie Team, and goalie John McLean (Eagan, Minn.) earned Honorable Mention honors. Deal lead the team with 20 points on 10 goals and 10 assist - all team highs. McLean posted a 5-5-3 record between to posts with a 2.02 goals against average and a .929 save percentage. Erik Johnson (Sauk Rapids, Minn.) also saw time in goal with a 3-3-4 record, 2.80 goals against average and a .900 save percentage.

GAME NOTES

MINNESOTA GROWN

Gustavus' 2015-16 roster includes 26 players, 24 of which hail from the Land of 10,000 Lakes. Two come from out of state - Ross Kovacs (Jr., Dickinson, N.D.) and Van Sullivan (Fy., Brentwood, Tenn.).

PRIOR EXPERIENCE

Twenty-four of the 26 players on this season's roster previously played junior hockey before beginning their collegiate careers. Eight of this year's Gusties are alums of the North American Hockey League (NAHL), while four played in the Minnesota Junior Hockey League (MNJHL). The Superior International Junior Hockey League (SIJHL), Eastern Junior Hockey League (EJHL), North American Tier III Hockey League (NA3HL), and Western States Hockey League (WSHL) are each represented by two players. The British Columbia Hockey League (BCHL), Central Canada Hockey League (CCHL), and American West Hockey League (AWHL) were all home to one future Gustie. Two Gusties this season are transfers from other collegiate institutions.

CAPTAIN'S LOG: 2015-16

The 2015-16 Gustavus men's hockey team is led by junior captains Sam Majka (Wayzata, Minn.), Drew Aspinwall (Maple Grove, Minn.) and Jared Docken (Northfield, Minn.). Majka wears the "C" on his Gustie sweater, while Aspinwall and Docken wear the "A." In the 74-year history of Gustavus men's hockey, Majka is the 89th student-athlete to earn the right of wearing a "C" on his Gustavus sweater.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

The Gusties have gone from eight seniors last season to just two this year. Darren Lapic (New Praugue, Minn.) and Gavin Tufte (Blaine, Minn.) enter their final season wearing the Black and Gold. Last season, Lapic played in 23 games with four goals and three assists, while Tufte played in 16 games with four goals and three assists as well.

LETTERWINNERS AND FRESH FACES

Brett Petersen returns 14 letterwinners from last year's team that went 8-9-8 overall and 5-5-6 in the MIAC. To go along with his 14 returning letterwinners, coach Petersen also welcomes 13 new players to the program. Seven of the fresh faces are freshman, five have come up from the junior varsity roster and one is a transfer from within the MIAC. This year's freshman class includes Chris Amsden (St. Peter, Minn.), Justin DeWitz (Oronoco, Minn.), Will Holtan (Rochester, Minn.), Evan Erickson (Woodbury, Minn.), Van Sullivan (Brentwood, Tenn.) and Austin Anderson (Rosemount, Minn.). Alex Koopmeiners (St. Cloud, Minn.) is a transfer from Concordia College.

THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD

To go along with the team's standard 16 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference contests, this season's long and winding schedule featured non-conference games against teams belonging to the MIAC, WIAC and NCHA. In addition to non-league games against conference foes Saint Mary's and Hamline to begin the season at the MIAC Showcase, Gustavus faced UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 6), UW-Stout (Nov. 7, Jan. 9), UW-Eau Claire (Jan. 8), UW-Superior (Jan. 15) and UW-River Falls (Jan. 16) of the WIAC, and St. Scholastica (Dec. 11) of the NCHA. The Gusties play 12 of its games at home at Don Roberts Ice Rink.

PUSHING IT TO OVERTIME

The Gusties are no strangers to playing the overtime period as they have gone into the extra period six times out of 19 games this season. Last season the Gusties played in 10 overtimes. This season Gustavus is unbeaten in overtime games with a record of 2-0-4. Most recently, Gutavus tied St. Olaf 3-3 in both games of the series on Jan. 22 and 23.

GET TO THREE GOALS

Goal scoring is always the main focus when trying to win games, but making it to three goals seems to be the mark for the Gusties as 11 of their 12 losses have come when scoring two or fewer goals.

GAME NOTES

SCOUTING THE ROYALS

Bethel enters the weekend with a 2-17-2 overall record and 1-11-0 mark in the MIAC. The Royals have lost seven straight with their last victory coming on Jan. 16 against UW-Superior, and are winless on the road at 0-11-0. Travis Payne leads the team with 18 points on 11 goals and seven assists. Jesse Garcia has been the regular starter between the pipes this season with a 2-10-2 record, 4.41 goals against average and .878 save percentage.

LAST TIME THEY MET - GUSTIES VS. ROYALS

In a Senior Day game with not a whole lot to play for but pride and love of the game, it was only fitting that seniors would be the ones doing the majority of the scoring for the Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team. After being eliminated from playoff contention with a 6-2 loss on Feb. 21 last year in Blaine, Gustavus bounced back and finished its 2014-15 campaign with a 4-2 victory over Bethel the following night at Don Roberts Ice Rink.

After senior Nate Paulsen (La Habra, Calif.) got things started with a goal just :14 seconds into the game, fellow senior Schyler Adams (New Prague, Minn.) followed suit later in the period with two goals at 14:02 and 18:20.

Bethel won the game's opening faceoff and after a mishandling of the puck in its defensive end thanks to the forecheck pressure applied Andy Pearson (Sr., Burnsville, Minn.) and Blake Schammel (Sr., Red Wing, Minn.), gave it away where it happened onto the stick of Nate Paulsen. Paulsen fired a slap shot from just inside the blue line and the low-lining puck made its way through traffic and eventually between the legs of goaltender Matt Rowe.

Later in the frame, the Bethel defense simply forgot about covering up the trailer as the Gusties entered the zone. Adams was the unchecked trailer who moved his way up the right wing. With possession at the left circle, Schammel recognized the streaking Adams and fed him a cross-ice pass where he was able to tap the one-timer into what was an empty net at the right goalpost.

Adams's goal with less than two minutes remaining in the frame was not as pretty as his one earlier. With Rowe scrambling to get back into position in front of the net after making a initial save on a Gustavus rush, Adams had the puck on his stick behind the goal with time to survey the scene. He then decided to throw the it in front of the net were it bounced off a Bethel player and into the back of the net.

Although Bethel got two goals back in the second period to cut the lead to 3-2, Gustavus won the third and added an insurance goal to bring the score to a final at 4-2. Conor Deal (Fr., Anchorage, Alaska) scored his team-leading 10th of the season on the power play, tapping in a Sam Majka (So., Wayzata, Minn.) centering pass from just outside the crease.

John McLean (Jr., Eagan, Minn.) earned the victory an improved to 5-5-3 after turning away 22-of 24 shots – 10 of which came in the third period. His counterpart, Matt Rowe, made 31 saves and finishes his season at 3-10-1.

The Gusties held a 35-24 shots advantage, and went 1-for-4 on the power play and killed off both of its penalties.

PLAYOFF PICTURE

With four games left in the regular season, the Gusties sit in eighth place with 14 points, which are five points behind the fifth and final playoff spot. To make the playoffs, the Gusties need to pass St. Olaf (16 points), Hamline (17 points) and Saint Mary's (19 points).

Brett Petersen is in his 16th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's hockey team in 2015.

In his 15-plus-year tenure behind the Gustavus bench, Petersen has compiled a 211-169-44 overall record. His 211 wins at Gustavus ranks second behind legendary coach Don Roberts. He has been named MIAC Coach of the Year twice, once in 2001-02 after helping the Gusties make the jump from ninth place the year before to a second place finish in the conference, and again in 2009-10 after leading the Gusties to their first MIAC Title since 1993. While at Gustavus, Petersen has worked with 18 All-Conference players, three MIAC Player of the Year recipients, eight AHCA All-Americans and one National Player of the Year (David Martinson, 2010).

He was named assistant coach at St. Cloud State University of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) in the spring of 1994. During his six years at St. Cloud State, he coordinated the recruiting process for head coach Craig Dahl, while also being closely involved with practice planning, player development and bench coaching.

In the classroom, Petersen received his Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Denver in 1992 and his Master of Science degree in athletic administration in 2000 from St. Cloud State. He was a four-year letter winner in hockey while at Denver and was named to the WCHA All-Academic team for three years. Petersen served as the team's assistant captain during his junior and senior seasons.

Petersen had the opportunity to represent USA Hockey on several difference occasions during his playing career including the U.S. Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City in 1990 and the World University Games in Sapporo, Japan in 1991. He was drafted by the Calgary Flames of the National Hockey League (NHL), but did not play professional hockey.

Along with this coaching duties at Gustavus, Petersen's responsibilities include managing Lund Arena, the College's multi-purpose facility that houses the ice sheet from October through March for team practices and games. The facility is then used for physical education classes, concerts and conventions the rest of the year.

Brett lives in St. Peter with his wife, Linda, and their daughters, Katherine and Natalie.
