

Setting The Scene: The Gustavus men's basketball team begins a three-game home stand Saturday afternoon at 1 p.m. for game two of the season series against Hamline. The Gusties won game one of the series 85-70 on Jan. 9 in St. Paul. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 9-13 overall record and 6-11 mark in the MIAC, while the Pipers are 4-18 overall and 2-15 in the league. Gustavus has lost its last three games, while Hanline is on a six-game losing streak.

Last Time Out: Trailing St. Olaf by two points with six seconds remaining in the game, the Gustavus men's basketball team had possession of the ball as Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) advanced it up to Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.). Narum pump-faked and dribbled over for an open look at a three-pointer, but his shot at the last second was blocked in a controversial finish, as some argue a foul was committed on the shot. Nonetheless, the Gusties lost 82-80 in another heartbreaking defeat, dropping to 9-13 overall and 6-11 in the MIAC, and have been eliminated from playoff contention.

Four Gusties reached double figures, led by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) with 17 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the field. Cooper and Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) each had 16 points, while Sergio Najera (Sr., New Prague, Minn.) posted a season-high 13 points. Ziegler and Najera led the team with five rebounds apiece, and Cooper posted five assists.

The Gusties and Oles traded baskets for the first 5:34 of the game with three ties during that span, until the home squad scored eight unanswered points for an 18-10 lead at the 12:09 mark. Gustavus responded with six straight points to bring the score within two, but St. Olaf once again went on a spree, 12-4, to take a 30-20 advantage with 6:41 left in the half. The Black and Gold brought the score back within one possession at 35-32 with 3:29 on the clock, but the Oles padded their lead and went into halftime with a 44-37 advantage.

The second half started similar to the first with both teams going back and forth. The Oles led by as much as nine and as few as two during the first 15 minutes of the half. The Gusties finally were able to tie the game at 70-70 on a layup by Ziegler with 4:44 remaining. The rest of the contest featured four ties and two lead changes, but the Oles were on the right side of the final lead change. St. Olaf made a layup at the 1:45 mark to take an 80-78 lead, and Najera answered for the Gusties to tie the game at 80 on a jumper with 35 seconds left. But once again the Oles responded with a layup with just six seconds to take the final lead of the game.

Gustavus shot 53.8 percent (35-65) from the field, while St. Olaf shot 61.1 percent (33-54). The Gusties out-rebounded the Oles 31-26 and committed just eight turnovers.

Series Snapshot: Saturday's matchup marks the 176th meeting between Gustavus and Hamline in men's basketball. The Gusties lead the all-time series 105-70 and have won the last nine meetings.

Last Time They Met: The Gustavus Adolphus College men's basketball team was able to break its two-game losing streak, defeating Hamline University 85-70 on Jan. 9 at Hutton Arena.

"We haven't shot the ball well the past few games, but found a better flow and rhythm in this game and started shooting a lot better" said Coach Mark Hanson. "This is certainly an important win coming off of five straight conference losses. We needed it both mentally and in the standings."

The Pipers got off to a hot start, outscoring the Gusties 6-0 in the first five minutes of the half. However, the Gusties battled back quickly, grabbing the lead for the remainder of the half at the 13:55 mark. By halftime, the Black and Gold found itself with a 45-34 lead.

During the second half, Gustavus continued to pour on the points, and broadened its lead to 24 at the 6:49 mark. Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) aided in the Gusties success, as he scored seven of his career high 18 total points in the second half, including going 2-for-3 from beyond the arc in the final 20 minutes. Overall, the Marshall native went 7-of-10 from the floor, and 3-for-5 from long range.

"We played confidently and found the open players at the right times instead of holding the ball for too long, and played well in transition" said Sharbono after the victory.

Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) also reached double-digit scoring with 11 points, including going 3-for-4 from three. Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn) continued to be efficient offensively chipping in another 13 points, shooting 5-for-5, and adding three free throws.

The Pipers were led by Connor Knutson with 20 points, followed by teammate Herbert Tarpeh who added 16.

The Gusties finished the game shooting 57.4 percent (31-54), while the Pipers shot a similar 55.6 percent (25-45). The Gustavus bench played a large role in the victory, as it tallied 46 total points compared to the 22 from Hamline's reserves. The Gusties also out-rebounded the Pipers 31-17.

About The Pipers: Hamline enters Saturday's game with a 4-18 overall record and 2-15 mark in the MIAC. The Pipers average 70.8 points per game (8th/MIAC) and allow 79.2 per game (11th/MIAC). After 22 games this season, two Pipers average double figure scoring - Zach Smith (13.7) and Connor Knutson (12.4). Herbert Tarpeh is the team's leading rebounder with 4.0 per game.

Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season: The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568, prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

Fans can listen to the broadcasts on KNUJ Radio AM 860, KCHK 95.5 or online through the Gustavus Athletics website. In addition, Gustavus will once again stream nearly every home game for viewing on your computer and other portable internet devices through GameCentral by Stretch Internet. Captains Log: As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, four players are given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Chad Poppen, Gary Cooper, Chris Narum and Brian Jacobs as team captains.

Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff: Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 477 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGrood is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGrood returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGrood played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 477-228 overall record at Gustavus, including a 360-157 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
