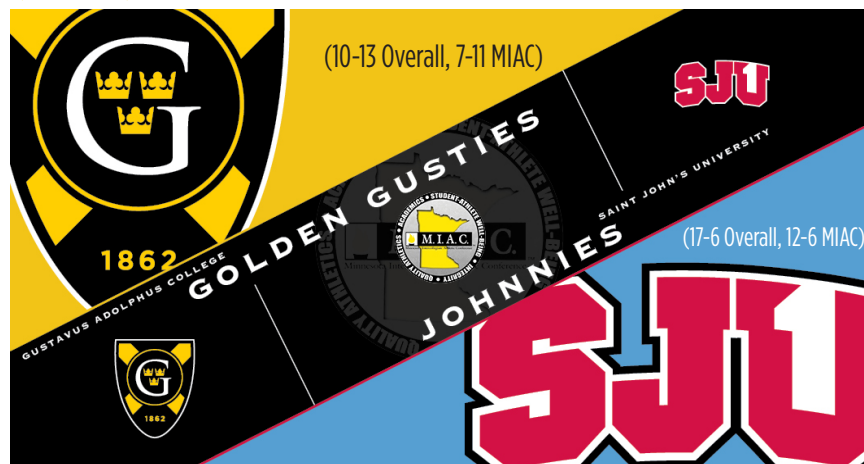

**Setting The Scene:** The Gustavus men's basketball team hosts its final weekday game of the season at 7 p.m. Wednesday for game two of the season series against Saint John's. The Johnnies won game one of the series 87-83 on Jan. 20 in Collegeville, Minn. The Gusties enter the matchup with a 10-13 overall record and 7-11 mark in the MIAC, while the Johnnies are 17-6 overall and 12-6 in the league. Gustavus is coming off a thrilling 101-91 overtime win over Hamline, while the Johnnies defeated Concordia 75-64 last Saturday.

**Last Time Out:** Saturday afternoon's MIAC men's basketball game against Hamline University didn't start well for Gustavus as the visiting Pipers raced to a double-digit advantage, leading by as much as 19 points in the first half. Hamline took a 20-point lead in the second, it's largest of the game, but the Gusties showed pride and determination to erase that deficit and tie the game 74-74 with 3:19 left in regulation. Trailing 83-80 after a timeout and eight seconds on the game clock, Chris Narum (Sr., Eagan, Minn.) played the role of the hero as he sunk an off-balance fade-away three to tie the game with just five seconds on the clock, sending it to overtime. Having lost their previous two overtime contests this season, the Gusties flipped the script and went on to claim a 101-91 victory to improve to 10-13 overall and 7-11 in the MIAC.

Narum finished with a career-high 26 points on 6-of-12 shooting from the field, including 10-of-12 for the free throw line. Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.) also posted a career-best 26 points on an impressive 11-of-13 shooting from the floor. Ziegler added six rebounds and went 4-for-7 from the charity stripe. Three other Gusties reached double figures – Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) with 18, Chad Poppen (Sr., St. Peter, Minn.) with 12, and Riley Sharbono (Fy., Marshall, Minn.) with 10. Alec Koster (Jr., Redwood Falls, Minn.) fought hard on every possession as the 6-2 wing hauled in a career-high eight rebounds.

"Our starters did great, but really, our whole bench did as well," Head Coach Mark Hanson said. "Once we started rolling they were all really into it and that's great. Whether you win or lose, you want it to be a team effort, and I think people lose sight of what happens with those guys that are sitting to my right. Their encouragement and effort was great, and if they get in for a minute, whatever, they are on each other's side and that's neat."

Hamline started the game on fire, making eight of its first 10 shots, resulting in a 19-10 advantage five minutes into the game. Hamline's Zach Smith was the driving force in the scoring outburst, as he scored 11 of his game-high 31 points in the first five minutes. The Pipers continued to shoot with the hot hand, cruising to a 43-24 lead at the 4:27 mark. The Gusties tried to chip away at their deficit, but Hamline held on to a comfortable 51-35 lead at halftime.

The Pipers took their largest lead of the game, 55-35, one minute into the second half, but from the 17:54 mark down to 13:32 Gustavus went on an 18-5 run to cut its deficit to seven points at 62-55. Hamline regained a double-digit advantage two possessions later, but once again the Gusties battled back with an 11-3 spree to make the score 71-68 at the 7:21 mark. The Black and Gold continued to dig deep and tilt the momentum in its favor, finally tying the game at 74-74 with 3:19 remaining. The Pipers were able to regain a six-point advantage over the next two minutes, but the Gusties didn't allow a field goal in the final 2:54, leading to Narum's game-tying three-point in the final seconds to send the game to overtime.

In the extra period, Hamline took back the lead on its first bucket, but that would be its last as the Gusties shot 6-of-7 from the field in the final five minutes, and went 4-of-6 from the free throw line to secure the 10-point victory.

**Series Snapshot:** Wednesday's matchup marks the 177th meeting between Gustavus and Saint John's in men's basketball. Gustavus leads the all-time series 110-66 and has won four of the last seven meetings, including two MIAC Playoff victories in the past two seasons. Saint John's Head Coach Pat McKenzie is in his first season at the helm, while Gustavus Head Coach Mark Hanson has a 35-23 all-time record against the Johnnies.

**Last Time They Met:** Despite leading midway through the second half, the Gustavus men's basketball team was unable to hold on to the advantage, while sending Saint John's to the free throw line 26 times in an 87-83 loss on Jan. 20 in Collegeville, Minn.

"In a lot of ways I thought we played pretty well the whole game," Head Coach Mark Hanson said. "We just put them at the free throw line too much. That's the stat that I expected to stand out."



Both teams shot well from the field as the Gusties posted a 53.1 percentage (34-64) to the Johnnies' 53.8 percent (28-52). The big difference was Saint John's ability to get to the charity stripe as it made 22-of-26 free throws compared to Gustavus's 6-for-9 clip.

The Gusties started the game on a good note, jumping ahead 18-11 in the first five minutes. Saint John's charged back into the contest with consecutive three-pointers, but Gustavus didn't lead go of its lead. The Gusties responded with a 7-2 run to take a 25-19 advantage at the 11:10 mark. The Johnnies once again fought back with six unanswered points to tie the game and eventually took a 31-29 lead at the 5:42 mark. From that point on, the Gusties controlled the pace of play for the remainder of the half, ending the first on a 15-7 run for a 44-38 lead at halftime.

Gustavus maintained its lead to start the second half until a three-pointer by Saint John's gave the home team a 49-48 advantage three minutes in. The two squads traded the lead three times over the next minute, but it was the Gusties that regained the lead with a 12-3 run for a 62-55 advantage at the 12:30 mark. Gustavus took its largest lead of the game at 66-57 on a jumper by Brody Ziegler (Sr., Mankato, Minn.). Over the next four minutes, the Johnnies were able to go on a 15-2 run to take an advantage they would not relinquish the rest of the way. Gustavus stayed within four points during the final three minutes, but wasn't able to get back on top.

For the second straight game, Gary Cooper (Sr., Detroit, Mich.) led the Gusties offense with 19 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the field and a game-high seven assists. Peter Kruize (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.) had a productive night off the bench, scoring a career-high 17 points on 6-of-7 shooting from the floor and 5-of-6 from the free throw line. Kruize and Cooper led the team with six rebounds apiece.

Mitchell Kuck of Saint John's led all scorers with 27 points.

**About The Johnnies:** Saint John's enters the game with a 17-6 overall record and 12-6 mark in the MIAC, which is good for third place in the standings. The Johnnies have won three of their last four games, most recently defeating Concordia 75-64 on Saturday in Collegeville, Minn. After 23 games this season, Alex Schmitt leads the Johnnies with 17.8 points per game, which also puts him third in the conference for points per game. Following closely is Mitchell Kuck who averages 16.3 points per game.

**Gusties Take To Hardwood For 107th Season:** The 2015-16 season represents the 107th season of men's basketball at Gustavus. Founded in 1904, the men's basketball program has mounted an overall record of 1411-970, and a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) mark of 935-568, prior to the 2015-16 season. Since the inception of the MIAC, the Gusties have amassed at least a share of 17 conference titles, the second most in league history. The program has made 24 MIAC Playoff appearances, and has also participated in the NCAA Tournament 13 times, most recently in the 2011-12 season.

**Captains Log:** As is tradition, captains are selected annually to serve as leaders of their team. This year, four players are given the honor of serving as captain, as the Gusties named seniors Chad Poppen, Gary Cooper, Chris Narum and Brian Jacobs as team captains.

**Meet The Gustavus Coaching Staff:** Head coach Mark Hanson is in his 26th season at the helm of the Gustavus men's basketball program. During his tenure, Hanson has directed the team to seven MIAC championships, 22 MIAC Playoff appearances, and 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season. With 478 career wins, Hanson is the all-time winningest coach in Gustavus men's basketball history.

Assistant coach Justin DeGroot is in his fourth season as the lead assistant for the Gustie men's basketball team. Primarily working with the defense, DeGroot returns to Gustavus after serving as an assistant coach at Bethel from 2010 to 2013. A 2007 Gustavus graduate, DeGroot played for head coach Mark Hanson during his tenure on the hill. Following his graduation, Justin made his way east, where he worked for Jostens and volunteered as a high school and college coach in Boston.

Primarily dealing with game preparation and recruiting, Jeff Fish is in his seventh season as an assistant coach for the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball team. Prior to joining the Gustavus staff, Fish was an assistant coach for Bethany Lutheran College from 2007-2009.

## Head Coach Mark Hanson

Mark Hanson is in his 26th season as the head coach of the Gustavus Adolphus men's basketball program for the 2015-16 campaign. After a quarter century of leading the Gusties, Hanson has directed the team to 11 NCAA Division III National Tournament appearances, including reaching the Final Four for the first time in school history and placing second in the nation during the 2002-03 season.

In the 2010-11 season, Hanson earned his 400th career victory with an 89-78 win over Saint Mary's on Gus Young Court. He became the 65th coach in NCAA Division III history, and 31st active coach, to reach the 400-win milestone. Research indicated that Hanson was the 14th fastest coach to reach 400 victories in Division III history, and became just the sixth coach from the MIAC to reach the 400-win plateau.

Hanson, who has compiled a 478-228 overall record at Gustavus, including a 361-157 record in the MIAC, has won seven MIAC Championships, and has been named MIAC Coach of the Year eight times. He has helped guide Gustavus to the MIAC Playoffs 21 times, reaching the finals 14 years and winning the MIAC Playoff Championship on seven occasions. His teams have reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament six times and the Elite Eight three times. Hanson has coached 29 players who have garnered 49 All-Conference honors, four MIAC Players of the Year, eight players who have received 13 all-region honors, and three All-Americans. In addition, Hanson has coached one Jostens' Award Finalist (Trevor Wittwer, 2008), which recognizes the top Division III men's basketball player in the nation based on academics, athletics, and community involvement.

Hanson is a 1983 Gustavus graduate and the basketball program's all-time leading scorer with 1,774 points. He was a two-time NAIA All-America and GTE Academic All-America selection, a three-time Gustie MVP and a four-time All-MIAC selection.

A long-time outdoor enthusiast, Hanson earned his master's degree in experiential education at Mankato State University and teaches outdoor education classes in the health and exercise science department. He is also the outdoor program director at the college.

Hanson, a native of Dodge Center, Minnesota, lives in St. Peter with his two children, Hans and Annika.
